MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4

Col. 1: 2 (2) 2 skeins of Candyfloss (45) **Col. 2:** 2 (2) 2 skeins of Hint of Pink (50) **Col. 3:** 2 (2) 2 skeins of Pastel Yellow (21)

Crochet hook 2.5 mm
Elastic band for the drawstring at the waist

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100% cotton / 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (174 yds)

GAUGE

 $10 \times 10 \text{ cm} (4'' \times 4'') = 24 \text{ hdc} \times 16 \text{ rows}$

ABBREVIATIONS

SI st = slip stitch
Ch = chain
Sc = single crochet
Hdc = half double crochet
Col = color
WS = wrong side
RS = right side

SIZE

3-6 months. (6-12 months.) 1-2 years

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 35 (41) 47 cm/13.8 (16.1) 18.5 inches Width: 23 (26) 28 cm/9 (10.2) 11 inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

Cornelius is a great pair of cotton pants worked in half double crochet making them comfortable to wear, whether you are lying, crawling, playing, or running. If the legs of the pants are too long, they can be folded, which will also give the legs space to grow, and the pants will still fit.

TIPS AND INFO

Cornelius Children's pants are worked side to side in two almost identical pieces, which are then joined.

Unless otherwise instructed, you will chain 1 to turn at the end of every row.

LEG₁

Chain 46 (53) 60 + 1

NOTE. You will change color after every third row. Start with col. 1, then col. 2 and col. 3.

Size 3-6 months

Row 1: 1 hdc in each st (46 sts) Row 2: 46 hdc, ch 45 (91 sts) Row 3-35: 1 hdc in each st (91 sts)

Row 36: 42 hdc, (2 hdc in one sts) 4 times, turn (50 sts)

Row 37: 1 hdc in each st

Size 6-12 months

Row 1-2: 1 hdc in each st (53 sts) Row 3: 53 hdc, ch 53 (106 sts) Row 4-38: 1 hdc in each st (106 sts)

Row 39: 49 hdc, (2 hdc in one sts) 4 times, turn (57 sts)

Row 40-41: 1 hdc in each st

Size 1-2 years:

Row 1-3: 1 hdc in each st (60 sts) Row 4: 60 hdc, ch 60 (120 sts) Row 5-41: 1 hdc in each st (120 sts)

Row 42: 56 hdc, (2 hdc in one sts) 4 times, turn (64 sts)

Row 43-45: 1 hdc in each st



LEG₂

Start with col. 3. Ch 46 (53) 60 + 1

NOTE. You will change color after every third row, the color sequence is col. 3, col. 1, col. 2.

Except for the color sequence, the second leg is worked identical to the first one as instructed for each size 3-6 months. (6-12 months.) 1-2 years.

First row is the middle front, while the last row is at the middle of the back.

JOINING

Place leg 1 and leg 2 laterally reversed next to each other. Crochet the pieces together with one row of single crochet down the middle front and then along the middle back. Then single crochet the inside of the legs together starting at the bottom of one leg going up the leg, along the crotch and down the other leg.

WAISTBAND

Along the waist of the pants, fold approx. 4 cm (1.6") down onto the WS of the pants. This will become the waistband. Working from the RS you will now slip stitch through both layers all around, creating a drawstring hem. Insert the elastic band and test that it fits (neither too loose nor too tight) before closing the gap using slip stitch.
