MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4 Col. 1: 2 (2) 2 skeins of Pastel Green (100) **Col. 2:** 2 (2) 2 skeins of Baby Blue (75) **Col. 3:** 1 (1) 1 skein of Pastel Yellow (21)

Crochet hook 2.5 mm 3 buttons (15 mm)

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100% cotton / 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (174 yds)

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 24 hdc x 16 rows

FORKORTELSER

SI st = slip stitch Ch = chain Sc = single crochet Hdc = half double crochet Col = color WS = wrong side RS = right side SIZE

3-6 months. (6-12 months.) 1-2 years

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 26 (29) 32 cm/10.2 (11.4) 12.6 inches Width: 26 (28) 30 cm/10.2 (11) 11.8 inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

Cornelius Children's Polo is an oversized t-shirt with a box fit. It is worked in half double crochet making it comfortable to wear, whether you are lying, crawling, playing, or running.

TIPS AND INFO

Cornelius Children's Polo is worked in multiple pieces, which are then assembled. Finally, the collar is crocheted directly onto the neckline.

Unless otherwise instructed, you will chain 1 to turn at the end of every row.

FRONT PANEL

Start with col. 2. Ch 64 (70) 76 + 1

You will work alternately 3 rows with col. 2 and 3 rows with col. 1

Work 21 (22) 24 rows with 1 hdc in each st (64 (70) 76 sts)

On the next row work 44 (50) 56 hdc and ch 20 (20) 20 + 1.

Work 20 (21) 23 rows with 1 hdc in each st (64 (70) 76 sts)

BUTTONBAND

Start at the opening at the top of the front panel, on the WS in row 21 (23) 25. Use the same color as the previous row.

Work 1 row with 20 (20) 20 hdc, one in each ch, creating a 'flap', which will overlap the opening from left to right, looking from the RS.

On the next row you will make buttonholes: 1 hdc, ch 1, skip 1, (7 hdc, ch 1, skip 1) twice, 2 hdc (20 sts).

Fasten off and sew the bottom edge in place.

BACK PANEL

Start with col. 1. CH 64 (70)76 + 1

You will work alternately 3 rows with col. 2 and 3 rows with col. 1



Work 12 (13) 14 rows with 1 hdc in each st (64 (70) 76 sts)

On the next row, hdc 62 (68) 74, turn (62 (68) 74 sts).

Then work 17 (17) 19 rows with 1 hdc in each st (62 (68) 74 sts)

Work 1 row with 1 hdc in each st, ch 2 + 1 (64 (70) 76 sts).

Work 11 (12) 13 rows with 1 hdc in each st (64 (70) 76 sts).

SLEEVES (MAKE 2)

Start with col. 2. Ch 20 (24) 28 + 1

You will work alternately 3 rows with col. 2 and 3 rows with col. 1

Work 27 (30) 33 rows with: 1 hdc in each st (20 (24) 28 sts). Fasten off and make one more sleeve the same way.

FINISHING

Sew/crochet front and back panel together along the shoulder seams working from the WS.

Working from the WS, sew/crochet the sleeves onto the body one by one with the middle row of the sleeve aligned with the shoulder seam.

Then crochet the sides together starting at the bottom of the body, working all the way down each sleeve.

Attach the 3 buttons aligned with the buttonholes.

COLLAR

Start with col. 3 in the top corner of the button band at the neckline and work 1 sc in each row all around to the opposite side.

The second row is worked with (1 hdc, 2 hdc in one st) repeat until end.

Work 4 (5) 5 rows with 1 hdc in each st.

Next row is worked with (1 hdc, 2 hdc in one st) repeat until end.

On the final row, work 1 hdc in each st. Break yarn.

Working from the WS at the bottom of the button band, behind the flap, you will now work an edge with 1 sc in each st along the button band until you reach the corner of the collar. In the corner work 3 sc in one st.



Continue along the collar with 1 sc in each st until you reach the corner. In the corner work 3 sc in one st. Continue down along the rest of the collar and fasten off before you reach the button band.
