## MATERIALS

Color A: 1 skein of Friends Extra Fine Merino, color Cognac (17)
Color B: 1 skein of Friends Extra Fine
Merino, color Lilac (63)
Circular needle 3.5 mm (US 4), 80 cm (31.5")

## YARN QUALITY

(220) Friends Extra Fine Merino, Hobbii

100\% Merino wool, superwash
$50 \mathrm{~g}(1.8 \mathrm{oz})=165 \mathrm{~m}(180 \mathrm{yds})$

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=24$ sts $\times 46$ rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

$K=$ knit
$k f \& b=k n i t$ in the front and back loop of the sts

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: $30 \mathrm{~cm} / 11.8^{\prime \prime}$
Length: 94 cm / 37"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Jazz is a super soft bandana knitted in garter sts. The stripes are made by knitting 2 rows of garter sts in each color of Extra Fine Merino. The bandana is finished off with an i-cord edge.

## INFO AND TIPS

Continue increasing every $4^{\text {th }}$ row until you have used 20 g of each color. The last 10 g are needed for the i-cord edge.

## BANDANA

CO 3 sts with color $A$ and knit 1 row.
Change to Color B and knit 2 rows evenly.

From here on, continue stripping every 2 rows and increasing at the end of the first row:
Row 1: $k$ across, with color $A$, until there is 1 st remaining, $k$ f\&b in the last st $=1$ st increased
Row 2: $k$ across all sts with color A
Row 3: $k$ across all sts with color $B$
Row 4: $k$ across all sts with color B

Repeat these 4 rows.

Continue increasing every $4^{\text {th }}$ row until you have used 20 g of each color.

Knit 2 extra rows of 1 color without increases to mark the center of the scarf.

From here on, begin decreasing on the same side of the increases in the previous section:
Row 1: k across, with color $A$, until there are 2 sts remaining, $k 2$ tog $=1$ st decreased
Row 2: $k$ across all sts with with color $A$
Row 3: $k$ across all sts with with color B
Row 4: $k$ across all sts with with color B

Repeat these 4 rows.

Decrease until there are 3 sts remaining. Knit 2 rows evenly. Bind off.

## I-cord edge

Slanting Side
With the circular needle, pick up sts from the right side with color B along the 2 slanted sides. Cut the yarn, move the sts to the other end of the circular needle and work from the right side.
CO 3 sts and *k 2, ssk ( 1 st from the right needle and 1 from the left needle), place 3 sts on the left needle*; repeat from * to * until all sts on the needle are worked. Place the remaining 3 sts aside.

Note: tighten the yarn slightly before working the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{st}$.

## Even side

With the circular needle, pick up sts from the right side with Color A along the even side. Cut the yarn, move the sts to the other end of the circular needle and work from the right side. Place the 3 sts in color $B$ from the previous section onto the left needle.
*k 2, k2tog, move 3 sts back to the left needle *; repeat from * to * until all sts on the needle are worked. Sew the i-cord together at the corner to finish.

## Finish

Wash the bandana gently and block or iron.
