Harper

Hat

MATERIALS

2 (2) 2 skein(s) of Friends Wool col 104

Circular needles 4 mm, 40 cm
And/or double pointed needles 4 mm
Stitch markers
Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii
100% wool, non superwash
50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

GAUGE

24 sts x 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm (4" x 4") in rib
stitch
22 sts x 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm (4" x 4") in
stockinette

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = cast on
K = knit
P = purl
St(s) = stitches
K2tog = knit 2 together.

SIZES

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Head circumference: 52-54 cm (54-56) 56-58
cm/20.5-21.3 (21.3-22.1) 22.1-22 inches
Width: 19 (22) 24,5 cm/7.5 (8.7) 9.7 inches
Length, Brim unfolded: 28 (29) 30 cm/11
(11.4) 11.8 inches
Length, Brim folded: 21 (22) 23 cm/7.9 (8.3)
9.0 inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

Comfy and beginner-friendly hat with a wide
folded brim. Matches the Harper gloves.

TIPS AND INFO

The hat is worked in the round on circular needles using the magic loop method or on double pointed needles. The hat will expand slightly when worn and used, so if you are between two sizes, choose the smaller one. You will start by working the brim in rib stitch: p2, k1 and then continue with the rest of the hat in stockinette sts.

Hat

CO 84 (96) 108 sts in circular needles 4 mm, 40 cm or on double pointed needles.

Brim

Work rib stitch in the round (p2, k1) until work measures 9 (10) 11 cm/3.5 (3.9) 4.3 inches

Continue in stockinette until work measures 24 (25) 26 cm / 9.5 (9.8) 10 inches from the CO-edge.

Place stitch markers as follows:

Size S: *Sm, 2 sts, Sm, 19 sts* repeat to end of round

Size M: *Sm, 2 sts, Sm, 22 sts* repeat to end of round

Size L: *Sm, 2 sts, Sm, 25 sts* repeat to end of round

Decrease as follows:

1. round: *k2, dec. left, k until 2 sts before next Sm. *Dec. right, k 2, dec. left, k until 2 sts before next Sm * repeat until 2 sts left, de. right = 8 decreases in total.

2. round: work in stockinette

Work round 1 and 2 a total of 7 (8) 9 times

You will now have 28 (32) 36 sts left on your needles.

K2tog across all sts until 7 (8) 9 sts remain.



Pull the yarn tail through the remaining sts and weave in ends.
Fold the brim of the hat.

Your hat is now ready to wear :)
