



KNITTING PATTERN

Bonbon

Hat

Design: Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

1 (1) 1 (2) skein(s) of Friends Extra Fine Merino col 31 1 skein of Friends Kid Silk col 31

Circular needles size 4 mm, 60 cm and / or double pointed needles size 4 mm Stitch markers Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Priends Extra Fine Merino, Hobbii 100% merino wool/ 50 g (1.75 oz) = 165 m (180 yds)

Friends Kid Silk, Hobbii 72% Kid Mohair, 3% wool, 25% Silk/ 25 g (0.9 oz) = 200 meter (218 yds)

GAUGE

27 sts x 30 rows = $10 \times 10 (4'' \times 4'')$ cm in ribbing

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es) CO = cast on k2tog = knit 2 sts together

SIZES

XS (S) M (L)

MEASUREMENTS

Head circumference: 52-54 cm (54-56) 56-58 (58-60) cm/ 20.5-21.6 (21.6-22) 22-22.8 (22.8 - 23.6) inches

Width: 18 (19) 20,5 (22) cm/7.1 (7.5) 8 (8.7)

inches

Length, unfolded: 26 (28) 30 (32) cm/10 (11)

11.8 (12.6) inches

Length, folded: 19 (21) 23 (25) cm/7.5 (8.3) 9

(9.8) inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

Super soft and beginner friendly hat in rib stitch with a wide, folded brim. The hat is worked in the round using circular needles and magic loop or double pointed needles. If you are between two sizes, choose the smaller size – the hat will expand when worn and used.

The hat is knit with 2 strands held together.

Pattern







HAT

Using circular needles size 4 mm, 60 cm or double pointed needles, CO 96 (104) 112 (120) sts. Join to work in the round.

Work in rib stitch (knit 1, purl 1) until work measures 20 (22) 24 (26) cm/7.9 (8.7) 9.4 (10) inches from the CO edge.

Place a stitch marker in the following knit sts:

Size XS: 1., 25., 49., 73. stitch Size S: 1., 27., 53., 79. stitch Size M: 1., 29., 57., 85. stitch Size L: 1., 31., 61., 91. stitch

Now you will start decreasing. Decrease before and after each marked stitch like this:

1. round: Knit the marked st, k2tog. *Work in rib stitch until 2 sts before next marked st, slip 1, knit 1, pass slipped st over, knit the marked st, k2tog, * continue until 2 sts remain, slip 1, knit 1, pass slipped st over = a total of 8 decreases

2. round: work in ribbing

Work round 1 and 2 a total of 8 (9) 10 (11) times

You will now have 32 (32) 32 (32) sts on your needles K2tog across all sts until 8 (8) 8 (8)sts remain.

Pull the yarn through and weave in the ends. Fold the edge of the hat to make approx. 6 (7) 7 (7) cm of folded brim.

Your hat is now ready to wear \odot
