## Mittens

## MATERIALS

1 skein of Kind Feather col Dusty Green (19)
1 skein of Peacock col Chocolate Brown (11)

Double pointed needles size 4 mm
Cable needle
Stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

(63) Kind Feather, Hobbii

100\% Acrylic
$100 \mathrm{~g}(3.5 \mathrm{oz})=235 \mathrm{~m}(257 \mathrm{yds})$
(a43) Peacock, Hobbii
100\% Polyester
$50 \mathrm{~g}(1.75 \mathrm{oz})=27 \mathrm{~m}(29 \mathrm{yds})$

## GAUGE

18 sts $\times 28 \mathrm{r}=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)$
In stockinette stitch

## SIZES

S/M (L/XL)

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: approx. 9 (11) cm/ 3.5 (4.3) inches
Length: ca. 24 (26) cm/ 9.5 (10.2) inches

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Lovely mittens with a simple seersucker pattern. The mittens have wide, soft cuffs ensuring warmth as well as a good fit around the wrist.

## ABBREVIATIONS

CO = cast on
St(s) = stitch(es)
P = purl
K = knit
beg = beginning
K2tog = knit 2 sts together
Ssk = slip slip knit
M = stitch marker
$\mathrm{m} 1 \mathrm{r}=$ right-leaning increase
m1l = left-leaning increase

## TIPS AND INFO

## Make one right (M1R) - right-leaning increase

Pick up the vertical bar between two sts by inserting the left-hand needle from back to front, under the bar between the stitches. Knit this bar through the front loop.

Make one left (M1L) - left-leaning increase
Pick up the vertical bar between two sts by inserting the left-hand needle from front to back, under the bar between the stitches. Knit this bar through the back loop.

## MITTENS

With double pointed needles 4 mm and 2 threads of Kind Feather CO 32 (40) sts

Place a marker at the beg of round and one after half the stitches, giving you 16 (20) sts on front and back of the mitten.

## Starting - identical for left and right mitten

Work 4 rounds of rib stitch (k1, p1)

From here on you will work the front of the mitten in a pattern across 8 rounds.
Work pattern once:

## Pattern

Round 1: *k1, p1, k1, p1*, repeat *_* 4 (5) times, $M$, $k$ until end
Round 2: *k1, p1, k1, p1*, repeat *_* 4 (5) times, M, k until end
Round 3: *p1, k3*, repeat *_* 4 (5) times, M, k until end
Round 4: *p1, k3*, repeat *_* 4 (5) times, M, k until end
Round 5: *k1, p1, k1, p1*, repeat *_* 4 (5) times, $M$, $k$ until end
Round 6: *k1, p1, k1, p1*, repeat *_* 4 (5) times, M , k until end
Round 7: *k2, p1, k1*, repeat *-* 4 (5) times, $M$, $k$ until end
Round 8: *k2, p1, k1*, repeat *-* 4 (5) times, $M$, k until end

## Increasing for thumb, right mitten

Continue in pattern while increasing for the thumb every 2 . round.

Round 1: *k1, p1, k1, p1*, repeat *_* 4 (5) times, $M, m 11, k 1, m 1 r, k$ until end $=3$ sts for the thumb
Round 2: Work in pattern
Round 3: *p1, k3*, repeat *_* 4 (5) times, M, m1l, k3, m1r, k until end = 5 sts for the thumb
Round 4: Work in pattern
Round 5:*k1, p1, k1, p1*, repeat *_* 4 (5) times, M, m1l, k5, m1r, k until end $=7$ sts for the thumb
Round 6: Work in pattern
Round 7: *k2, p1, k1*, repeat *-* 4 (5) times, $M, m 11, k 7, m 1 r, k$ until end $=9$ sts for the thumb
Round 8: Work in pattern
Round 9: *k1, p1, k1, p1*, repeat *-* 4 (5) times, M, m1l, k9, m1r, k until end = 11 sts for the thumb
Round 10: Work in pattern
Round 11:*p1, k3*, repeat *_* 4 (5) times, M, m1l, k11, m1r, k until end = 13 sts for the thumb
Round 12: Work in pattern

Continue in pattern (round 5 of the pattern repeat) until you reach the stitches for the thumb. Place the thumb sts on a piece of scrap yarn or similar. CO 1 new stitch. Knit until end $=32$ (40) sts around.

Finish the pattern repeat (round 6-8) and work the pattern 2 (3) more times

## Increasing for thumb, left mitten

Continue in pattern while increasing for the thumb every 2 . round.

Round 1: work in pattern until 1 st remains, m1r, k1, m1l = 3 sts for the thumb
Round 2: work in pattern
Round 3: work in pattern until 3 sts remain, m1r, k3, m1I = 5 sts for the thumb
Round 4: work in pattern
Round 5: work in pattern until 5 sts remain, m1r, k5, m1I = 7 sts for the thumb
Round 6: work in pattern
Round 7: work in pattern until 7 sts remain, m1r, k7, m1l = 9 sts for the thumb
Round 8: work in pattern
Round 9: work in pattern until 9 sts remain, $\mathrm{m} 1 \mathrm{r}, \mathrm{k} 9, \mathrm{~m} 1 \mathrm{l}=11$ sts for the thumb
Round 10: work in pattern
Round 11: work in pattern until 11 sts remain, $m 1 r, k 11, m 1 I=13$ sts for the thumb
Round 12: work in pattern

Continue in pattern (round 5 of the pattern repeat) until you reach the stitches for the thumb. Place the thumb sts on a piece of scrap yarn or similar. CO 1 new stitch $=32(40)$ sts around.

Finish the pattern repeat (round 6-8) and work the pattern repeat 2 (3) more times

## Decreasing for the fingertips (the same for left- and right-hand mitten)

Continue in pattern while decreasing for the fingertips on every 2. round.

## All Sizes:

Round 1: ssk, k1, p1, *k1, p1, k1, p1*, repeat *_* 2 (3) times, k1, p1, k2tog, M, ssk, k until 2 sts before next M , k2tog
Round 2: p1, k1, p1, *k1, p1, k1, p1*, repeat *-* 2 (3) times, k1, p1, k1, M, k until end Round 3: ssk, k1, *p1, k3*, repeat *_* 1 (2) times, p1, k2tog, M, ssk, k until 2 sts before next M, k2tog
Round 4: k2, *p1, k3*, repeat *-* 1 (2) times, p1, k1, M, k until end
Round 5: ssk, *k1, p1, k1, p1*, repeat *_* 1 (2) times, k2tog, M, ssk, k until 2 sts before next M, k2tog
Round 6: p1, *k1, p1, k1, p1*, repeat *_* 1 (2) times, k1, $\mathrm{M}, \mathrm{k}$ until end

## S/M ONLY

Round 7: ssk, k1, p1, k3, p1, k2tog, M, ssk, k until 2 sts before next M, k2tog
Round 8: *k2, p1, k3, p1, k1, M, k until end

## L/XL ONLY

Round 7: ssk, k1, p1, k3, p1, k3, p1, k2tog, M, ssk, k until 2 sts before next M, k2tog
Round 8: *k2, p1, k1* repeat *-* repeat 2 times, $k$ until end
Round 9: ssk, *k1, p1* repeat *-* 3 times, k2tog, M, ssk, k until 2 sts before next M, k2tog
Round 10: *p1, k1* repeat *-* 4 times, M , k until end
$=16$ (20) sts on the needle

Remove stitch markers and work k2tog until 8 (10) sts remain on needles.
Break yarn and pull tail through the stitches. Pull tight and secure. Weave in the end on the wrong side of work.

## Thumb (the same for right- and left-hand mitten)

Place the 13 sts on needles and knit 1 sts on the mitten = 14 sts for the thumb.

Work around in stockinette stitch, approx. 5 (6) cm /2 (2.4) inches or the length that fits you. Try the mitten on along the way.

Remove stitch marker and k2tog until 7 sts remain. Break yarn and pull the tail through the stitches.
Pull tight and weave in securely.

## Cuff Manchet (the same for right- and left-hand mitten)

Pick up and knit 20 (26) sts along the cast-on edge using Peacock. Work $12 \mathrm{~cm} / 4.7$ inches of stockinette stitch in the round and bind off (be careful not to bind off too tightly). Fold the cuff to cover the rounds of rib stitch.
