# Wandering Star

## Decoration

Design: Melu Crochet | Hobbii Design

## MATERIALS

1 skein of Honey Bunny col. Gold Dust (27)

Crochet hook 7 mm

Stuffing

Yarn needle

4 stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

 **Honey Bunny**, Hobbii

100% Polyester

100 g = 120 m

## GAUGE

8 sts x 9 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sts = stitches

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

hdc = half double crochet

tr = treble crochet

sc3tog = single crochet 3 together

2dc = two dcs in the same st

3dc = three dcs in the same st

5dc = five dcs in the same st

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 17 cm

Length: 17 cm

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This cozy star would make a lovely gift for a kid's room, new baby, housewarming gift or on the Christmas tree! As it works up quickly it would also be the perfect piece in your winter market inventory.

It uses super chunky yarn, and looks so soft and squishy that everyone will want one! Pattern is beginner-friendly and contains a step-by-step photoguide. One skein of Honey Bunny is enough for approx. 4 stars.

# Pattern









## INFO AND TIPS

Turning chain does not count as a stitch throughout.  
Start each round in same st as turning ch

## Wandering Star

<p><b>Round 1:</b> Ch3, working into 3rd ch from hook,</p>	
<p>dc into ch,</p>	
<p>sc into ch,</p>	
<p>*dc, sc into ch repeat from * four more times</p>	

<p>sl stitch to join to the first dc of the round (10st)</p>	
<p><b>Round 2:</b> Ch2, 3dc</p>	
<p>sc in next st,</p>	
<p>*5dc in next st,</p>	
<p>sc in next st,</p>	
<p>Repeat from * three more times</p>	

2dc into same st as the first dc of the round,



sl st to join into the first dc of the round. (30st total)



Round 3: Ch3, tr











2dc in same st,



hdc in next st,



<p>*sc3tog,</p>	
<p>hdc in next st,</p>	
<p>(2dc, tr, 2dc) in next st,</p>	
<p>hdc in next st,</p>	
<p>Repeat from * three more times</p>	
<p>sc3tog, hdc in next st,</p>	
<p>2dc into same st as the first tr of the round,</p>	
<p>sl st to join into the first tr of the round, (40st total)</p>	

Cut yarn and fasten off



Make another star, this time do not cut yarn, but continue to 'joining'.









**Joining:** With Right Side facing out on both stars, rotate the first star so that the starting chain is not in the same position as the second star:



place stars together Ch1,



<p>Add stitch markers to the top of each tr stitch to hold the stars in place so that the stitches on each star line up</p>	
<p>sc through both sides of the star in each stitch around, until you reach the 5th point,</p>	
<p>Hide your ends as you go by tucking them inside the star,</p>	
<p>Stuff the star with small amounts of filling at a time, gently pushing it into the points of the star.</p>	
<p>Continue to sc in each st to close,</p>	
<p>sl st to join into the first st of the round,</p>	



Ch10,



sl st to join into the first ch to make a hanging loop



Fasten off and cut yarn and sew in the end, that's it, you're finished!
