



CROCHET PATTERN

Sweetheart

Purse

MATERIALS

1 skein of Ribbon color 33
2 skeins of Ribbon color 17

Crochet hook 8 mm (US 11)
Magnetic snap buttons
A needle and thread (yellow)

YARN QUALITY

 **Ribbon**, Hobbii
100% Cotton
250 g = 125 m

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 17 sts x 6 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

sl st = slip stitch
ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
tc = treble crochet
shell st = shell stitch (5 dc in the same stitch)

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 26 cm / 10"
Length: 18 cm / 7"
Strap: 28 cm / 11"

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Sweetheart purse is made in a mix of a classic shell stitch pattern and crocheted hearts. The shell stitches are tight enough that you don't need to line the purse. The pattern includes a photoguide and it is suitable for the intermediate crocheter.

INFO AND TIPS

The number of sts is a multiple of 6+2

MAIN PATTERN (SHELL STITCH)

Row 1: ch-26, sc in the 2nd ch from the hook, * skip next 2 chs, shell st in next ch, skip next 2 chs, sc in next ch **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the row (photos #1-2)

Row 2: ch-3 (counts as the 1st dc), turn, 2 dc in the 1st sc, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc, * shell st in next sc, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the row, 3 dc in the last sc (photo #3)

Row 3: ch-1 (does not count as a stitch), turn, sc in the 1st dc, * shell st in next sc, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc, skip next 2 dc ** repeat from * to ** to the end of the row, finish with sc in the top of ch-3



Repeat Rows 2-3 until you reach 28 rows in total or desired length. Finish with Row 2.

RIGHT AND LEFT SIDES

Make a row of sc around the rectangle except the last row of the shells. Work 3 sc in each corner and 1 sc through each shell sc of the 1st row (photo below).



Top from left to bottom right:


1. Connect the yellow yarn to the corner and crochet a row of dc in each sc in the back loops only - 31 dc - Don't cut the yarn.
NOTE: the back loops - close to the inner side of the purse, the front loops - close to the outer side of the purse
2. Fold the rectangle so that the outer sides are facing each other and start joining the yellow row from the wrong side in the front loops only. Repeat the same steps for the second side.

4. Photo showing the right side of the work

HEARTS

* ch-7 it is a base of the heart,
3 tc in the 4th ch from the hook,
2 dc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch, sl st in the last ch,
turn your heart and start working through the second loop of the ch-7 base
2 sc in next loop, 2 dc in next loop, 3 tc in next loop, ch-3, sl st in the same loop **,
rep from * to ** until you reach the desired length

Crochet 2 stripes of 6 hearts



SC STRIP

Row 1: ch-66, sc in the 2nd ch from the hook, sc in each ch to the end of the row

Row 2: ch-1 (does not count as a stitch), turn, sc in each sc to the end of the row

Sew sc-strip and heart-strip together and sew it on the purse to the yellow sides. Place a magnetic snap button. Crochet a heart and sew it on the purse.
