## MATERIALS

1 skein of Kind Feather in the following colors: 02, 11, 12, 09

Knitting needles 4 mm (US 6)
Tapestry needle

## YARN QUALITY

## (a33) Kind Feather, Hobbii

100\% Premium acrylic
$100 \mathrm{~g}(3.5 \mathrm{oz})=235 \mathrm{~m}(257 \mathrm{yds})$

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=24$ sts $\times 30$ rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

st/s = stitch/es
$k=k n i t$
p = purl
k2tog = knit 2 sts together
CO = Cast On
BO = Bind Off

Head circumference: 40-58(44-62) 50-67cm
/ 15.7-22.8 (17.3-24.4) 19.6-22.3"
Height: 24 (28) 32 cm / 9.4 (11) 12.5"

Cute, warm beanie with adorable hearts.
Perfect for Valentine's Day!
The beanie is knit flat with hearts in intarsia.
After decreasing for the top the beanie is sewn together. Suitable for the intermediate knitter.

## INFO AND TIPS

The beanie is worked straight and sewn at the end.
When doing the intarsia hearts carefully cross the strands of the inserted colors on the wrong side of the beanie.

## Stitches used in the pattern

Stockinette stitch: purl on the wrong side, knit on the right side;
Rib stitch: knit 2, purl 2.

## BODY

With color 02 CO 112 (122) 136 sts. Work 26 (40) 50 rows in rib stitch (k2, p 2). Then continue in stockinette stitch.

Work 4 rows in stockinette. In the $5^{\text {th }}$ row start introducing the colors of the hearts motifs according to the chart, as follows:
Row 1 of the hearts: $\mathbf{k} \mathbf{1 0 ( 1 0 )} \mathbf{1 2}$ in $\mathbf{0 2}$, k 1 in $09, \mathbf{k} \mathbf{1 7}$ (19) $\mathbf{2 1}$ in $\mathbf{0 2 , k} 1$ in $12, \mathbf{k} 17$ (19) $\mathbf{2 1}$ in
 in 11, k 11 (11) 13 in 02.
Row 2 of the hearts: p 10 (10) 11 in 02, p 3 in 11, p 15 (17) 19 in 02, p 3 in 12, p 15 (17) 19 in 02, p 3 in 09, p 15 (17) 19 in 02, p 3 in 11, p 15 (17) 19 in 02, p 3 in 12, p 15 (17) 19 in 02, p 3 in 09, p 9 (9) 11 in 02.

Continue knitting heart motifs according to the diagram attached below keeping in mind that it is worked on the right and purl side.

Fasten off all the colors.
Now work 10 (10) 10 rows in 02, from here on, the beanie will be made only with this color, and start to decrease:

Row 11: K 13 (15) 16, k2tog, *k 12 (13) 15, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, k the rest of the row.

Row 12: P all sts.
Row 13: K 12 (14) 15, k2tog, *k 11 (12) 14, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, k the rest of the row.
Row 14: $P$ all sts.
Row 15: K 11 (13) 14, k2tog, *k 10 (11) 13, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, k the rest of the row.
Row 16: P all sts.
Row 17: K 10 (12) 13, k2tog, *k 9 (10) 12, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, k the rest of the row.
Row 18: P all sts.
Row 19: K 9 (11) 12, k2tog, *k 8 (9) 11, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, k the rest of the row.
Row 20: P all sts.
Row 21: K 8 (10) 11, k2tog, *k 7 (8) 10, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, $k$ the rest of the row.
Row 22: P all sts.
Row 23: K 7 (9) 10, k2tog, *k 6 (7) 9, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, $k$ the rest of the row. Row 24: P all sts.
Row 25: K 6 (8) 9, k2tog, *k 5 (6) 8, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, $k$ the rest of the row. Row 26: P all sts.
Row 27: K 5 (7) 8, k2tog, *k 4 (5) 7, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, $k$ the rest of the row.
Row 28: P all sts.
Row 29: K 4 (6) 7, k2tog, *k 3 (4) 6, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, k the rest of the row.
Row 30: P all sts.
Row 31: K 3 (5) 6, k2tog, *k 2 (3) 5, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, k the rest of the row.
Row 32: P all sts.
Row 33: K 2 (4) 5, k2tog, *k 1 (2) 4, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, k the rest of the row. Row 34: P all sts.

## Size $S$ ends here

Row 35: $\mathrm{K}(3) 4, \mathrm{k} 2$ tog, ${ }^{*} \mathrm{k}$ (1) 3, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, $k$ the rest of the row.
Row 36: P all sts.

## Size M ends here

Row 37: K 3, k2tog, *k 2, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, $k$ the rest of the row.
Row 38: P all sts.
Row 39: K 2, k2tog, *k 1, k2tog*, repeat from * to * 6 times, $k$ the rest of the row.
Row 40: P all sts.

Cut a piece of the thread in color 02, pull it through the remaining sts and tighten.

## Finishing

Sew the beanie with an invisible seam so that the place of stitching is as invisible as possible on the folded ribbing.

Cut off all the ends.
