



CROCHET PATTERN



Design: The Rainbow Pumpkin | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

3 skeins of Kind Feather col. 10 1 skein of Peacock col. 06

Crochet hook 6mm Scissors Tapestry needle Tape measure

YARN QUALITY

Kind Feather, Hobbii 100% Acrylic/Polyacryl 100 g (3.5 oz) = 235 m (257 yds)

Peacock, Hobbii 100% Polyester 100 g (3.5 oz) = 65 m (71 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 11 dc sts x 6 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
st = stitch
dc = double crochet

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 23cm / 9 inches Length: 150cm / 59 inches (does not include length of tassels as they are customisable)

PATTERN INFORMATION

This sweet scarf design will keep you warm and snuggly. The soft fluffy hearts feel dreamy and look gorgeous too. The scarf is made in DC with 2 strands of Kind Feather for the base using intarsia technique to create the hearts with 1 strand of Peacock. Skill-level: intermediate.

INFO AND TIPS

This scarf is made using 2 strands of yarn together, and is worked from one end of the scarf first adding hearts as you go. The tassels are added at the end! To make the scarf reversible (i.e there is no 'wrong' side) instead of carrying your pink yarn across you will need to cut and weave in each time, or work from 2 separate balls of pink (remember you need to use 2 strands so you will need to make 2 separate balls of 2 strands each). Below is a photo of how the wrong side looks if you do choose to carry your yarn across. Ch2 does not count as a st.



SCARF

Row 1: Using 2 strands of your main color chain 26 then dc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch along, turn.

Row 2: Ch2, dc in each st across until you reach the end, turn. (24)

Row 3: Rep Row 2 then move on to the hearts section

Hearts

MC = main color and H = heart color All sts are DC St count is always 24



Row 4: Ch2, 11MC, 2H, 11MC, turn Row 5: Ch2, 10MC, 4H, 10MC, turn Row 6: Ch2, 9MC, 6H, 9MC, turn Row 7: Ch2, 8MC, 8H, 8MC, turn Row 8: Ch2, 7MC, 10H, 7MC, turn Row 9: Ch2, 6MC, 12H, 6MC, turn Row 10: Ch2, 6MC, 5H, 2MC, 5H, 6MC, turn Row 11: Ch2, 7MC, 3H, 4MC, 3H, 7MC, turn

Row 12-19: Repeat Row 2 using main color only

Rows 20-27: Repeat Rows 4-11 Rows 28-35: Repeat Row 2 Rows 36-43: Repeat Rows 4-11 Rows 44-51: Repeat Row 2

You are now going to work your hearts from top to bottom instead of bottom to top so that they sit the right way when the scarf is being worn.

Row 52: Ch2, 7MC, 3H, 4MC, 3H, 7MC, turn Row 53: Ch2, 6MC, 5H, 2MC, 5H, 6MC, turn Row 54: Ch2, 6MC, 12H, 6MC, turn Row 55: Ch2, 7MC, 10H, 7MC, turn Row 56: Ch2, 8MC, 8H, 8MC, turn Row 57: Ch2, 9MC, 6H, 9MC, turn Row 58: Ch2, 10MC, 4H, 10MC, turn Row 59: Ch2, 11MC, 2H, 11MC, turn

Rows 60-67: Repeat Row 2 Rows 68-75: Repeat Rows 52-59 Rows 76-83: Repeat Row 2 Rows 84-91: Repeat Rows 52-59 Rows 92-94: Repeat Row 2 then fasten off.

Weave in ends and move on to tassels.

TASSELS (optional)

Take your chosen color for the tassels - you can make them in any length and size that you prefer.

Use your 6mm hook to pull the top loop part of all strands through (images 2 and 3) then pull the loop up (image 4) and pass the ends through the loop, it should look like image 5.

Tighten to look like image 6 and repeat 4 more times. Do the same for the other end of the scarf.
