MATERIALS

1 skein of Sweet Tweed col Denim (07)
1 skein of Sweet Tweed col Purple (06)
1 skein of Friends Kid Silk col Misty Violet (67)
1 skein of Friends Kid Silk col Purple Rain (70)

Circular needles 4 mm, 40 cm
and / or double pointed needles 4 mm
Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Kid Silk**, Hobbii

72% Kid Mohair, 3% wool, 25% Silk/
25 g (0.9 oz) = 200 m (218 yds)

 **Sweet Tweed**, Hobbii

40% Polyacrylic, 21% Polyamide, 13%
Mohair, 13% Wool, 9% Cotton, 4% Polyester
25 g (0.9 oz) = 165 meter (180 yds)

GAUGE

20 stitches x 22 rows = 10 x 10 cm in rib
stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = cast on
St(s) = stitch(es)
K = knit
P = purl
Pm = place marker

SIZE

S/M (L/XL)

MEASUREMENTS

Head circumference: 52-56 (54-58) cm
Width: 20 (22) cm
Length, unfolded: 28 (30) cm
Length, folded: 20 (22) cm

PATTERN INFORMATION

Comfy and soft hat in rib stitch with a wide
folded brim.

Worked on circular needles using 2 strands
of Friends Kid Silk and 2 strands of Sweet
Tweed held together. The hat is elastic and
will expand slightly when used.

Techniques used for this hat: decreasing in
rib stitch. Suitable for advanced knitters.

TIPS AND INFO

You will work around using circular needles and the magic loop method using double pointed needles. The hat will expand slightly when worn, so choose the smaller size if you are between two sizes.

Right decrease (on the right-hand side of the marker)

If the second to last stitch before the marker is a knit stitch: slip 1 knitwise, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over.

If the second to last stitch before marker is a purl stitch: purl 2 stitches together through the back loops.

Left decrease (on the left-hand side of the marker)

If the second to last stitch before the marker is a knit stitch: knit 2 stitches together

If the second to last stitch before marker is a purl stitch: purl 2 stitches together

Hat

CO 80 (88) stitches using circular needles 4 mm, 40 cm, or double pointed needles and all 4 strands held together. Place marker to mark the beginning of round.

Work rib stitch (k2, p2) in the round until work measures 21 (23) cm measures from the CO-edge.

Place stitch markers like this (first marker marks the beginning of round):

Size S/M: *pm, 2 sts, pm, 18 sts* repeat until end of round

Size L/XL: *pm, 2 sts, pm, 20 sts* repeat until end of round

Decrease like this:

1st round: k2, left decrease, work sts as they appear until 2 sts before next marker. *right decrease, work sts as they appear, left decrease, work sts as they appear until 2 sts before next marked stitch* Repeat *-* until 2 sts remain on round. Right decrease.

= 8 sts decreases

2nd round: Work sts as they appear

Work rounds 1 and 2 a total of 7 (8) times.

You will now have 24 (24) sts on your needles.

Knit 2 sts together across all stitches = 12 sts left.

Pull the yarn tail through the remaining sts and weave in ends.

Fold the brim of the hat (approx. 7 cm).
