



CROCHET PATTERN

Froggy Friend

Bag

MATERIALS

Honey Bunny

2 skeins of color 104 (Shamrock, A)

1 skein of color 01 (White, B)

1 skein of color 124 (Black, C)

1 skein of color 45 (Candyfloss, D)

Crochet hook 6 mm (US L/11) A small amount of toy stuffing

YARN QUALITY

Honey Bunny, Hobbii 100 % Polyester 100 g / 3.5 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

GAUGE

Gauge is not too important for this project, mine measured approx. 5 rounds to 10 cm/4"

ABBREVIATIONS

BLO = back loop only

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

Fdc = foundation double crochet

FO = fasten off

sc = single crochet

ss = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

RS / WS = right side / wrong side

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Approx. 28 cm / 11" in diameter.

PATTERN INFORMATION

A cute and cuddly pal to keep you company. Take your froggy friend along for all your adventures and stuff him full of snacks! The Froggy Friend Bag is crocheted in the round with double crochet stitches. The eyes, cheeks and mouth are made separately and sewn on the bag in the end. Make the strap as long as you feel like and customise the bag for your specific needs. This crochet pattern is beginner friendly.

INFO AND TIPS

Your turning ch does not count as a st throughout.

The body of your bag is worked in joined rounds but not turned.

When changing colour remember to do so during the final yarn over of the stitch **before** the colour change.

BODY

Make Two

Round 1: With A, ch3, 12 dc in third ch from hook, ss to join. 12 sts.

Round 2: ch1, 2 dc in each st from the previous round, ss to join. 24 sts.

Round 3: ch1, *1 dc, 2 dc in the next st* around, ss to join. 36 sts.

Round 4: ch1, *2 dc, 2 dc in the next st* around, ss to join. 48 sts.

Round 5: ch1, *3 dc, 2 dc in the next st* around, ss to join. 60 sts.

Round 6: ch1, 2 dc, *2 dc in the next st, 4 dc* until 3 sts remain, 2 dc in the next st, 2 dc, ss to join. 72 sts.

Round 7 (RS): ch1, BLO dc in each st from the previous round. FO here for your first panel but continue to Round 8 for your second.

Round 8: ch1, with WS of both pieces together, ss through the next 60 sts on both pieces to join, leaving 12 sts open at the top for your bag opening. You can join more or fewer sts here to alter the width of your opening. When joined, ch1 and sc in each st around the opening, ss to join and FO. Weave in your ends.

FRONT EYES

Make Two

Round 1: With C, ch3, 5 dc in third ch from hook, change to B, 1 dc in the same space, ss to join. 6 sts.

Round 2: ch1, 2 BLO dc in each st from the previous round, ss to join, FO. 12 sts.

Round 3: Join A in any st around and ch1, *1 dc, 2 dc in the next st* around, ss to join. FO leaving a long tail for sewing. 18 sts.



BACK EYES

Make Two

Round 1: With A, ch3, 6 dc in third ch from hook, ss to join. 6 sts.

Round 2: ch1, 2 dc in each st from the previous round, ss to join. 12 sts.

Round 3: ch1, *1 dc, 2 dc in the next st* around, ss to join. FO leaving a long tail for sewing. 18 sts.

Sew your Front Eyes to the front of your bag joining 6 eye sts with 6 sts from Round 7 of the body, then leave the rest unjoined. Sew your Back Eyes to the back of the bag joining 6 sts with Round 7 of the back body as before, then sew the Front and Back eye edges together. Use your yarn tails and a little toy stuffing to pad the eyes.

MOUTH

I made my mouth using surface slip stitch, but you could work a chain and sew it onto the front of your bag if you prefer, or embroidery. Use the photo as a guide, but remember that all frogs are different, and that their smiles are all beautiful in their own way! Make yours completely unique to show off their personality.



CHEEKS

Make two

Round 1: With D, ch3, 6 dc in third ch from hook, ss to join, FO leaving a long tail for sewing. 6 sts.

Sew your cheeks to your bag at either end of your smile.

STRAP

Either use foundation dc to work a strap as long as you would like, then sew each end to your bag either side of your opening, **OR** work a ch the length you would like, dc in the third ch from the hook and each ch along, then sew each end to your bag either side of your opening. Weave in your ends.
