## MATERIALS

### Kind Feather

1 skein of each colour:

- 02 (Off White, A),
- 04 (Light Yellow, B)
- 10 (Light Pink, C)
- 12 (Lavender, D)
- 14 (Light Blue, E)
- 25 (Light Brown, F)

Crochet hook 4 mm (US G/6)

## YARN QUALITY

 **Kind Feather**, Hobbii

100 % Acrylic

100 g / 3.5 oz = 235 m / 257 yds

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 13 sts x 8 rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

### US terms

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

fo = fasten off

ss = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 23 cm / 9"

Length: 145 cm / 57"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

A simple but super cute make, this pastel patchwork infinity scarf is perfect for bringing some fun colour to the colder months.

The scarf is crocheted back and forth in double crochet stitches making the pattern very beginner friendly. You can shift the colours as described in the pattern below or you can play with your own colour shifts and add your own personal style to your work.

You can sew the ends of the scarf together making it into a round or leave it as it is as a long scarf.

## INFO AND TIPS

Your turning ch2 counts as a st throughout. Skip the st at the base of your ch, your st count will remain the same throughout.

When carrying your colours from one row to the next, crochet over the ends so they're hidden within your work. You will see slight raised bumps at the back of your scarf but no loose ends.

When changing colours, always do so during the final yarn over the stitch **before** the colour change.

Instructions are given to make your scarf exactly as shown in the photos, but feel free to use the colours in a different order to make yours completely unique!

## Scarf

With D, CH 34.

**Row 1:** dc in fourth ch from hook and each ch along, turn. 32 sts.

**Row 2:** ch2, 31 dc with D, turn.

**Rows 3-6:** Repeat Row 2.

**Row 7:** ch2, 15 dc with D, 16 dc with A, turn.

**Row 8:** ch2, 15 dc with A, 16 dc with D, turn.

**Rows 9-14:** Repeat rows 7 & 8.

FO D and join B.

**Row 15:** ch2, 15 dc with B, 16 dc with A, turn.

**Row 16:** ch2, 15 dc with A, 16 dc with B, turn.

**Rows 17-20:** Repeat rows 15 & 16.

FO A.

**Row 21:** ch2, 23 dc with B, 8 dc with F, turn.

**Row 22:** ch2, 7 dc with F, 24 dc with B, turn.

**Rows 23-29:** Repeat rows 21 & 22 ending on a row 21 repeat.

FO B.

**Row 30:** ch2, 15 dc with F, 16 dc with C, turn.

**Row 31:** ch2, 15 dc with C, 16 dc F, turn.

**Rows 32-36:** Repeat rows 30 & 31, ending on a row 30 repeat.

FO F.

**Row 37:** ch2, 15 dc with C, 16 dc with E, turn.

**Row 38:** ch2, 15 dc with E, 16 dc with C, turn.

**Rows 39-41:** Repeat rows 37 & 38 ending on a row 37 repeat.

FO C.

**Row 42:** ch2, 19 dc with E, 12 dc with A, turn.

**Row 43:** ch2, 11 dc with A, 20 dc with E, turn.

**Rows 44-50:** Repeat rows 42 & 43 ending on a row 42 repeat.

FO E.

**Rows 51-56:** ch2, 31 dc with A, turn.

FO A.

**Row 57:** ch2, 15 dc with B, 16 dc with F, turn.,

**Row 58:** ch2, 15 dc with F, 16 dc with B, turn.

**Rows 59-61:** Repeat rows 57 & 58 ending on a row 57 repeat.

**Row 62:** ch2, 9 dc with F, 12 dc with E, 10 dc with B, turn.

**Row 63:** ch2, 9 dc with B, 12 dc with E, 10 dc with F, turn.

**Rows 64-67:** Repeat rows 62 & 63.

FO B and F.

**Row 68:** ch2, 9 dc with A, 12 dc with E, 10 dc with D, turn.

**Row 69:** ch2, 9 dc with D, 12 dc with E, 10 dc with A, turn.

**Rows 70-73:** Repeat rows 68 & 69.

FO E.

**Row 74:** ch2, 15 dc with A, 16 dc with D, turn.

**Row 75:** ch2, 15 dc with D, 16 dc with A, turn.

**Rows 76-78:** Repeat rows 74 & 75 ending on a row 74 repeat.

FO A and D.

**Row 79:** ch2, 7 dc with F, 24 dc with C, turn.

**Row 80:** ch2, 23 dc with C, 8 dc with F, turn.

**Rows 81-87:** Repeat rows 79 & 80 ending on a row 79 repeat.

FO F.

**Row 88:** ch2, 15 dc with C, 16 dc with B, turn.

**Row 89:** ch2, 15 dc with B, 16 dc with C, turn.

**Rows 90-96:** Repeat rows 88 & 89 ending on a row 88 repeat.

FO C.

**Row 97:** ch2, 19 dc with B, 12 dc with A, turn.

**Row 98:** ch2, 11 dc with A, 20 dc with B, turn.

**Rows 99-105:** Repeat rows 97 & 98 ending on a row 97 repeat.

FO B.

**Row 106:** ch2, 19 dc with A, 12 dc with D, turn.

**Row 107:** ch2, 11 dc with D, 20 dc with A, turn.

**Rows 108-112:** Repeat rows 106 & 107 ending on a row 106 repeat.

FO A.

**Row 113:** ch2, 31 dc with D, turn.

With wrong sides of both ends of your scarf touching, join your scarf into a loop by working a ss through each st on both ends to seam. FO and weave in your ends.  
You can also leave the scarf as it is as one long scarf.
