

KNITTING PATTERN

MATERIALS

1 skein of Woody Tweed, col 03 1 skein of Woody Tweed, col 06

Circular needle 5 mm (US 8) – 40 cm (16") and/or DPN 5 mm (US 8) Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

Woody Tweed, Hobbii

70% Recycled wool, 30% Recycled viscose 100 g (3.5 oz) = 350 m (382 yds)

GAUGE

19 sts x 24 rows = 10×10 cm in rib stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = cast on

St(s) = stitch(es)

K = knit

P = purl

Pm = place marker

SIZE

XS/S, (M/L)

MEASUREMENTS

Head circumference: 52-56 cm (56-60) cm /

20.5-22 (22-23.6")

Width: 21 (24) cm / 8.3 (9.5)"

Length with unfolded brim: 28 (30) cm / 11

(11.8)

Length with folded brim: 20 (22) cm / 7.9

(8.7)''

ABOUT THE PATTERN

Lovely and comfy hat in rib stitch with a wide folded brim.

Worked on circular needles using 2 strands of Woody Tweed held together.

Techniques used for this hat: decreasing in rib stitch. Suitable for intermediate knitters.

INFORMATION AND TIPS

The hat is worked in the round with the magic loop technique or with DPN. The hat stretches a bit when in use. Therefore, if you are in between sizes, you should choose the smaller size.

Right decrease (on the right-hand side of the marker)

If the second to last stitch before the marker is a knit stitch: slip 1 knitwise, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over.

If the second to last stitch before marker is a purl stitch: purl 2 stitches together through the back loops.

Left decrease (on the left-hand side of the marker)

If the second to last stitch before the marker is a knit stitch: knit 2 stitches together If the second to last stitch before marker is a purl stitch: purl 2 stitches together

Hat

Using circular needle 5 mm or DPN 5 mm (US 8), co 84 (96) sts using 2 strands of Woody Tweed held together. Place marker to mark the beginning of the round.

Work rib stitch in the round (k2, p1) until the work measures 21 (23) cm / 8.3 (9.1)'' measured from the cast on edge.

Place stitch markers like this (first marker marks the beginning of round): Size XS/S: *pm, 2 sts, pm, 19 sts* repeat until end of round Size M/L: *pm, 2 sts, pm, 22 sts* repeat until end of round

Decrease like this:

1 round: k2, left decrease, work sts as they appear until 2 sts before next marker. *right decrease, 2 r, left decrease, work sts as they appear until 2 sts before next marked stitch* Repeat *-* until 2 sts remain on round. Right decrease.

= 8 sts decreases



2 round: Work sts as they appear

Work rounds 1 and 2 a total of 7 (8) times.

You will now have 28 (32) sts on your needles.

Knit 2 sts together across all stitches = 14 (16) sts left. Pull the yarn tail through the remaining sts and weave in ends.

Fold the brim of the hat (approx. 7 cm).

The hat is now ready to be used!
