MATERIALER

1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4 col Lemon Curd (22)

1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4 col Olive (109)

1 skein of Diablo col Primrose (51)

1 skein of Diablo col Olive (20)

NOTE! You will be working with one strand of Friends Cotton 8/4 and two of the same color Diablo, meaning you will be working from both ends of the same skein of Diablo at the same time.

Crochet hook 5.5 mm

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100% cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (174 yds)

Diablo, Hobbii 40% acrylic, 30% mohair, 30% polyamide 25 g (0.8 oz) = 225 m (246 yds)

GAUGE

 $10 \times 10 \text{ cm} (4'' \times 4'') = 16 \text{ sl st} \times 17 \text{ rows}$

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch = chain
Sl st = slip stitch
Sc = single crochet
Dc = double crochet
Hdc = half double crochet

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 34 cm / 13.4 inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Bonnie Bandana is worked with 1 strand of Friends Cotton 8/4 and 2 strands of Diablo, giving it a thick yet soft feeling.

Unlike the traditional bandanas, this one is designed to be worn during the cold season.

The chequered pattern invites you to really play with the colors. The pattern is intended for intermediate crocheters.

TIPS AND INFO

The Bonnie Bandana is worked in one piece after which the waved edging and tie strings are crocheted directly onto the bandana.

Yellow: One strand of Friends Cotton 8/4 col Lemon Curd (22) and two strands of Diablo col Primrose (51).

Green: One strand of Friends Cotton 8/4 col Olive (109) and two strands of Diablo col Olive (20).

BANDANA

Start with Yellow. Ch 55 1 turning chain (55).

NOTE! When starting each row, you will skip the first stitch, thus decreasing the stitch count with 1 stitch for every row.

Row 1: Work alternately 5 sc yellow and 5 sc green until end of row.

Row 2-5: Skip first st, and work alternately yellow over yellow and green over green (54, 53, 52, 51).

Row 6: Skip first st, and now work over yellow and yellow over green, to create the chequered pattern (50).

Row 7-10: Skip first st, and work alternately green over green and yellow over yellow.

Continue like this, changing the colors every 5 rows until 1 st remains. Fasten off.

WAVED EDGING

With Yellow. With right side of work facing, join yarn in the side of row 1. Work 1 sc, (3 dc in one row, 2 sc) repeat along the side until you reach the tip at the final row, then continue along the other side. Finish with one sc in the first row, in the opposite side of where you started.



TIE STRINGS

With Yellow. Ch 80, continue along the wrong side of your bandana and work 1 sc in each st along the opposite side of row 1, ch 80, turn. Now work 1 hdc in each st (80+55+80 = 215). Fasten off and weave in ends.
