Midi dress

MATERIALS

2 (2) 2 skeins of Twister color 21
1 (1) 1 skein of Twister Solid matching color, here col. 110

Crochet hook 3.5 mm (US E-4)
Stitch markers
Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Twister**, Hobbii
55% cotton, 45% acrylic
250 g (8.8 oz) = 1000 m (1,094 yds)

 **Twister Solid**, Hobbii
55% cotton, 45% acrylic
100 g (3.5 oz) = 400 m (437 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 18 sts x 21 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
sl st = slip stitch
inc = 2 sts in the same st

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width.: 50 (54) 58 cm / 19.6" (21.2") 22.8"
Length: 103 cm or depends on you/ 40.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Mia dress is a super comfortable dress, perfect for the beach as well as a night out. It is very easy to make and beginner friendly. It's made from top to bottom, making the straps as separate parts and joining them under the arms. From here you crochet in the round.

Use the color changing Twister yarn alone, in combination with Twister solid or the whole dress in one color. Only your imagination sets the limits.

INFO AND TIPS

The dress is made from top to bottom, first making four straps separated, and from then on, it is worked in a round, without joining the rows.

The dress is easy to adjust to your size and desired length.

I chose a color combination of Twister 21 and Twister Solid 110 but you can mix the colors however you want!

SHOULDER STRAPS

With Twister Solid 110, ch 14 (17) 17.

Row 1: 1 hdc in 4th ch from the hook, hdc to the end of row, ch 2 (counts as the first dc), turn = 12 (15) 15 sts.

Rows 2-6: hdc to the end, ch 2, turn = 12 (15) 15 sts.

Now you will start forming the neckline by increasing every single row.

Remember ALWAYS to increase on the same side!

Row 7: inc, hdc to the end, ch 2, turn = 13 (16) 16 sts.

Row 8: hdc to the end, ch 2, turn = 13 (16) 16 sts.

Row 9: inc, hdc to the end, ch 2, turn = 14 (17) 17 sts.

Row 10: hdc to the end, ch 2, turn = 14 (17) 17 sts.

Rows 11-53: repeat rows 9-10 = 36 (39) 39 sts at the end.

Make a total of 4 shoulder straps, by making 2 with Twister Solid 110, and two starting with threads from the inside of a skein of Twister 21.

BODY

The colors go from one to the other naturally, but since you have two skeins, when you finish one color from one skein, cut the thread and attach more or less the same color from the other skein.

Now you are going to join the shoulder straps, so join them with melange thread (if you've already gotten there), work until the color starts to change, and attach the melange color from the second skein, then work the light pink from one skein, and when it starts to change, attach the same color from the second skein. Keep going like this with all colors.

To join the shoulder straps, attach the yarn to the st on the armpit side of one of the straps. Ch 10 (armpits) and join to the same st of the next strap. Work hdc along the edge of the strap, when you finish the row, take another strap, join it with hdc into the first st from the neckline side, and continue to work hdc along the edge.

When you get to the end of the row, from the armpit side, ch 10, join with the next strap on the armpit side, work hdc along the edge, then, join with 1 hdc the next strap from the neckline side, and work hdc along the edge.

Now you have all the straps connected and you are right before the 10 ch sts you made first.

Now you will start to work hdc in rounds.

Place the stitch marker in the last hdc before the 10 ch sts to know where the round ends.

Continue working hdc in rounds until the dress is 103 cm or the desired length.

To complete the round, instead of one hdc, work a sc in the penultimate st, and a sl st in the last st.

FINISHING

Sew the shoulders on the wrong side with sl st.

Weave all ends.
