# Pearly Top

# **MATERIALS**

3 (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) skeins of Pearly Haze, col Peach (33)

Circular needles 7 mm, 80 cm (32") Circular needles 5,5 mm (US 9), 40 cm (15.7") and 80 cm (32") Stitch markers

# YARN QUALITY

**Pearly Haze**, Hobbii 73 % viscose, 27 % wool 50 g = 110 m

#### **GAUGE**

 $10 \times 10 \text{ cm} (4" \times 4") = 15 \text{ s} \times 20 \text{ r}$ 

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

St(s) = stitch(es)
K = knit
P = purl
K2tog = knit 2 stitches together
CO = cast on
BO = bind off

#### SIZE

XS (S) M (L) XL (2XL)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Length: 44 (46) 48 (50) 52 (54) cm / 17.3 (18.1) 18.9 (19.6) 20.5 (21.2)"
Circumference: 75 (82) 90 (98) 106 (112) cm / 29.5 (31.2) 35.4 (38.4) 41.7 (44)"
Arrmhole, height: 20 (21) 23 (24) 25 (26) cm / 7.9 (8.3) 9 (9.4) 9.8 (10.2)"

#### PATTERN INFORMATION

A simple, beginner friendly top knitted with Pearly Haze for a soft and shiny look. The top is worked from the bottom up on circular needles.

Pearly Top has a negative easy approx. 5-10 cm. If you want a looser fit choose the size that matches your bust circumference.

# **TIPS AND INFO**

The top is worked from the bottom up in stockinette stitch on circular needles. You will split work at the armholes and finish the front and back panels separately. You will pick up and knit stitches along the neckline and armholes to work the ribbing.

#### **BODY**

CO140 (156) 170 (186) 200 (216) sts with circular needles 5,5 mm (US 9), 80 cm (32 $^{\prime\prime}$ ). Place a st marker to mark the beginning of the round. Work 5 rounds of ribbing (k1, p1).

Change to circular needles 7 mm, 80 cm (32") and knit 1 round, while decreasing as follows:

XS, M, XL: \*k3, k2tog\*, repeat \*-\* until end S, L, 2XL: k1, k2tog, k1, k2tog, \*k3, k2tog\*, repeat \*-\* until end

You will now have 112 (124) 136 (148) 160 (172) sts on your needles

Continue around in stockinette stitch until work measures 23 (24) 24 (24) 25 (25) cm / 9 (9.4) 9.4 (9.4) 9.8 (9.8)"

Now you will bind off stitches for the armholes and divide work into front and back panels: BO 4 (5) 6 (6) 6 (6) sts, knit 52 (57) 62 (68) 74 (80) sts (back panel), BO4 (5) 6 (6) 6 (6) sts, knit 52 (57) 62 (68) 74 (80) sts (front panel)

Let the stitches for the back panel rest.

# Front panel

Purl one row

Decrease for armhole on the next 8 (9)10 (11) 12 (13) knit rows: k1, k2tog, knit until 3 sts remain, k2tog, k1

= 36 (39) 42 (46) 50 (54) sts on your needles.



Continue in stockinette stitch until work measures 38 (40) 41 (42) 44 (46) cm / 15 (15.7) 16.1 (16.5) 17.3 (18.1)"

# **BO** of for neckline

From the right side of work:

knit 12 (13) 14 (15) 16 (18) sts, BO 12 (13) 14 (16) 18 (18) sts for the neck, knit12 (13) 14 (15) 16 (18) sts

Finish the shoulders separately.

Right shoulder

Purl 1 row

On the following 5 knit rows you will decrease 1 st along the neckline as follows: k1, k2tog, knit until end

= 7 (8) 9 (10) 11 (13) sts on your needles

Continue in stockinette stitch until work measures: 46 (48) 50 (52) 54 (56) cm / 18.1 (18.9) 19.7 (20.5) 21.3 (21.7)"

Let stitches rest

# Left shoulder

Join yarn. Start with a purl row

On the following 5 knit rows you will decrease 1 st along the neckline as follows: Knit until 3 sts before the neckline. K2tog, k1.

= 7 (8) 9 (10) 11 (13) sts on your needles

Continue in stockinette stitch until work measures: 46 (48) 50 (52) 54 (56) cm / 18.1 (18.9) 19.7 (20.5) 21.3 (21.7)"

Let stitches rest

# **Back panel**

Purl 1 row

Work decreases for the armholes the same way as the front panel.

Continue in stockinette stitch until work measures 40 (42) 44 (46) 48 (50) cm / 15.7 (16.5) 17.3 (18.1) 18.9 (19.7)"

Make sure you end with a purl row.

# **BO** for neck

Knit 8 (9) 10 (11) 12 (14) sts, BO 20 (21) 22 (24) 26 (26) sts for neck, knit 8 (8) 9 (9) sts 8 (9) 10 (11) 12 (14)

Finish the shoulders separately.

# Left shoulder

Purl 1 row

K2tog towards the neckline, knit 6 (7) 8 (9) 10 (12) sts

= 7 (8) 9 (10) 11 (13) sts on your needles

Purl 1 row



Knit 1 row

Let stitches rest

# Right shoulder

Purl 1 row
Knit 6 (7) 8 (9) 10 (12) sts, k2tog towards the neckline
= 7 (8) 9 (10) 11 (13) sts on your needles
Purl 1 row
Knit 1 row

Knit the shoulders together with 3 needles like this: hold work with right sides facing. Using a third needle, knit 1 stitch from each needle together, knit 2 more sts together, and pass the first st over the second. Continue knitting 2 sts together for every st you bind off.

# Ribbing, armholes

Pick up and knit 80 (84) 88 (92) 96 (100) sts along the armhole using circular needles size 5,5 mm (US 9), 40 cm (15.7″). Your round will begin in the middle under the sleeve. Knit 5 rounds of ribbing (k1, p1) and BO.

# Ribbing, neckline

Pick up and knit 68 (72) 76 (80) 84 (90) sts along the neckline using circular needles size 5,5 mm (US 9), 40 cm (15.7″). Your round will begin at the back neck. Knit 5 rounds of ribbing (k1, p1) and BO loosely.

#### **Finishing**

Weave in all loose ends. Your top is now finished:)
