MATERIALS

Denim Breeze

1, (1, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3) skein(s) of color Off-White (01)

1, (1, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3) skein(s) of color Sand (02) 1, (1, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3) skein(s) of color Light Yellow

(03)

1, (1, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3) skein(s) of color Warm Yellow (04)

Crochet hook 3,5 mm (US E/4) A needle and thread

YARN QUALITY

Denim Breeze, Hobbii
80% Recycled cotton, 15% Cotton, 5%
Other fibers
50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 23 sts x 12 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

sl st = slip stitch ch = chain sc = single crochet hdc = half double crochet dc = double crochet

SIZE

XS, (S, M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 37 (41, 45, 49, 53, 57) cm / 14 ½", (16", 17 ¾", 19 ¼, 21", 22 ½", 24") Length: 32 (36, 38, 40, 42, 44) cm / 12 ½, (13 ½", 14 ½", 15", 15 ¾", 16 ½", 17 ¼")

PATTERN INFORMATION

Granny style designs are always popular. This granny stitch top is the perfect choice for summer. The pattern will show you how to crochet a granny triangle, and how to adjust the pattern to any size you need by increasing the number of rows and granny stitches.

INFO AND TIPS

How to find your size

Measure the fullest part of your chest and divide your measurement by 2 (front and back parts). After that, divide the front part by 2 - the width of triangles. For example my measurement is 88 cm.

88 cm / 2 = 44 cm. The front and the back parts - 44 cm 44 cm / 2 = 22 cm. The bottom of each triangle - 22 cm

NOTE: If you are between sizes, please size down

TRIANGLE PATTERN (2 DETAILS)

With col. 01, ch-5, join with sl st to the 1st ch

Row 1 (col. 01): ch-3 (count as a dc), 3 dc into the circle, ch-2, 4 dc into the circle

Row 2 (col. 01): ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 4 dc in the place between the 2 last sts, cut the yarn

Row 3 (col. 02): connect the yarn to the last dc of the previous row, ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next space (space between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next space (space between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 4 dc in the place between the 2 lasts sts

Row 4 (col. 02): ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next 2 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 2 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 4 dc in the place between the 2 lasts sts, cut the yarn

Row 5 (col. 03): connect the yarn to the last dc of the previous row, ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next 3 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 3 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 4 dc in the place between the 2 lasts sts

Row 6 (col. 03): ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next 4 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 4 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 4 dc in the place between the 2 lasts sts, cut the yarn

Row 7 (col. 04): connect the yarn to the last dc of the previous row, ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next 5 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 4 dc in the place between the 2 lasts sts

Row 8 (col. 04): ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next 6 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 6 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 4 dc in the place between the 2 lasts sts, cut the yarn

S proceed to front part

Row 9 (col. 01): connect the yarn to the last dc of the previous row, ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next 7 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 7 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 4 dc in the place between the 2 lasts sts

M proceed to front part

Row 10 (col. 01): ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next 8 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in



the same space, 3 dc in next 8 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 4 dc in the place between the 2 lasts sts, cut the yarn

L proceed to front part

Row 11 (col. 02): connect the yarn to the last dc of the previous row, ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next 9 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 9 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 4 dc in the place between the 2 lasts sts

XL proceed to front part

Row 12 (col. 02): ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next 10 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 10 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 4 dc in the place between the 2 lasts sts, cut the yarn

2XL proceed to front part

Row 13 (col. 03): connect the yarn to the last dc of the previous row, ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next 11 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 11 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 4 dc in the place between the 2 lasts sts

3XL proceed to front part

Row 14 (col. 03): ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 3 dc into the space between the 2 firsts dc, 3 dc in next 12 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 12 spaces (spaces between the 2 groups of 3 dc), 4 dc in the place between the 2 lasts sts, cut the yarn

FRONT PART

Size XS starts with color 04 Size S-M start with color 01 Size L-XL start with color 02 Size 2XL-3XL start with color 03

Connect the yarn to marked place (see the photo below) and crochet a row of granny stitches across the bottom of triangles:





Row 1: ch-3 (counts as a dc), 2 dc in the same place, * skip next row of a triangle, 3 dc in next row of a triangle ** repeat from * to ** across triangles

Row 2: ch-3, turn, 3 dc in in each space to the last space, 3 dc in the last space, dc in the last dc

Row 3: ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 2 dc in the 1st space, 3 dc in each space to the end of the row

Repeat Row 2-3 until you reach the desired length. Don't forget to change the color of the yarn every 2 rows. I crocheted 22 rows.

BACK PART

NOTE: the color of the yarn depends on the color of the last row of the triangle. For example I finished my triangles with color 01, so I'm going to start crocheting the back part with color 01

Size XS starts with color 04
Size S-M start with color 01
Size L-XL start with color 02
Size 2XL-3XL start with color 03

Row 1: ch-78, (82, 86, 90, 94, 98, 102) 3 dc in the 7th ch from the hook, * skip next 3 chs, 3 dc in next ch **, repeat from * to ** to the last 3 chs, ch-1, skip next 2 chs, dc in the last ch

Row 2: ch-3 (counts as a dc), turn, 2 dc in the 1st space, 3 dc in each space to the end of the row

Row 3: ch-3, turn, 3 dc in in each space to the last space, 3 dc in the last space, dc in the last dc

Repeat Row 2-3 until you reach the desired length. Don't forget to change the color of the yarn every 2 rows.



JOINING

Sew the front and the back part with a needle and thread. Make side seams.

The bottom

Make a row of sc and a row of sl st around the bottom.

The upper part

NOTE: the color of the yarn depends on the color of the last row of the triangle.

Size XS-S start with color 01 Size M-L start with color 02 Size XL-2XL start with color 03 Size 3XL starts with the color 04

Connect the yarn to the armhole (see the photo below)



Round 1: ch-3, (counts as a dc), 2 dc in in the same space, 3 dc in each space to the first ch-2 space (top of the triangle), 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc to the next ch-2 space, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in the same space, 3dc in each space to the back part, 3 dc in each ch-3 space of the back part, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 2: crochet a row of granny sts around the upper part, except the tops of triangles (ch-2 spaces), work (3 dc, ch-2, 3 dc) in each ch-2 space (tops of triangles), cut the yarn

Round 3: connect the yarn to any dc of the armhole, ch-1, sc in each dc and ch-2 space around, join with sl st to the 1st sc

Round 4: ch-1, sl st in each sc, to the top of the triangle, ch-70, hdc in the 3rd ch from the hook, hdc in each ch, sl st in each sc to the 2nd top of the triangle, ch-70, hdc in the 3rd ch from the hook, hdc in each ch, sl st in each sc to the end of the round, join with sl st to the 1st ch, cut the yarn
