Tulip

Applique

MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4

- 1 skein of Shamrock (104) for stem
- 1 skein of Lapis Blue (93)
- 1 skein of Sunflower (24)
- 1 skein of Pink (47)

Crochet 2.5 mm / US C/2

Scissors

YARN QUALITY

 Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii

100 % cotton

50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

st(s) = stitch(es)

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

... = repeat instructions between asterisks as many times as instructed

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 2,5" (6,5 cm)

Width at the largest point: 2" (5 cm)

PATTERN INFORMATION

This tulip will embellish your accessories and garments. It's also an awesome little project to use your leftovers of yarn.

You can use appliques in many ways. You can crochet and sew them wherever you want to bring some joy. Have fun matching different appliques to create your own landscape or life scene. And sew them on your blankets, cushions, bags, scarf, hat, you can make a garland... the possibilities are endless. For children you can use them as a toy, add a scratch behind the applique and provide a support and they will have fun changing the decor all day long.

The pattern is beginner-friendly, and has pictures to guide you.

INFO AND TIPS

The tulip is made in two separate pieces that are sewn at the end. First we will work the petals and then the leaves and the stem in one piece. Finally, we will sew them together at the end.

If you planned to sew your appliques on a crocheted or knitted support don't forget to leave a long tail to sew them on your project. If you planned to sew them on another support weave in ends and use sewing thread in the same color as the applique.

Ch2 at the beginning of the round doesn't count as 1 st.

PETALS

With yarn of the color of your choice

Round 1: leaving a long tail to sew to the stem later, ch6.

Work 1 dc in the 3rd ch from the hook. 1 dc in next ch, 1 hdc in next ch and 5 hdc in the last ch. Now we will work on the other side of the chain. Work 1 hdc in next ch, 1 dc in next 2 chs. DO NOT join in round. (Image 1)

*Ch3, 1 sc in 2nd ch, 1 hdc in next ch. ** Sl st in the ch in the centre top*. Repeat from * to * once. Repeat from * to **. Join in round with sl st to top of the first st (image 2)

Round 2: Work 1 sl st in the next 13 sts. You must stop on top of the first picot you made, but just before the top ch. (image 3)

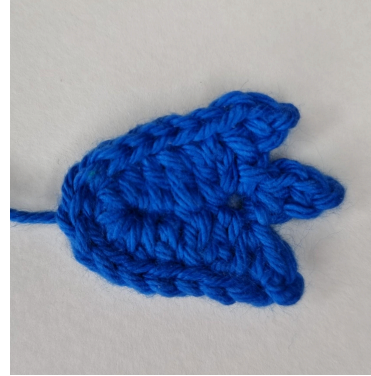

LEAVES AND STEM

With color Shamrock (104)

We will work the leaves and the stem in one piece.

Leaf 1: Ch16,

Work 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next 2 ch, 1 hdc in next 2 ch, 1 dc in next 7 ch, 1 hdc in next ch, 1 sc in next ch and 1 sl st in last chain. Turn and work on the other side of the chain, 1sc in the same ch, 1 sc in the next 3 ch. (Image 1)

Leaf 2: Ch12,

Work 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next 2 ch, 1 hdc in next ch, 1 dc in next 4 ch, 1 hdc in next ch, 1 sc in next 2 ch.

Stem:

Now work on the foundation ch from leaf 1.

Work 1 sl st in leaf 1's foundation ch where you worked the last sc in leaf 1. Work 1 sc in next st. (Image 2) Ch6, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next 4 ch. Sl st in leaf 1's foundation ch where you worked the last sc. Fasten off and weave in ends.

With the petals' yarn tail, sew the petals to the stem on the wrong side of the petal.

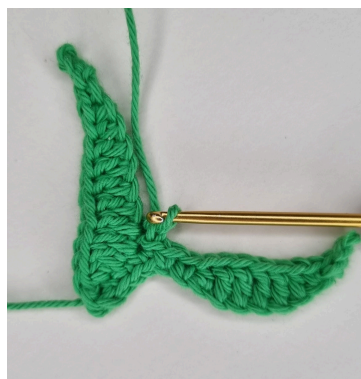
