Clouds with rain drops

MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4

1 skein color White (01) 1 skein color Icy blue (76)

Crochet 2.5 mm / US C/2 Scissors

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100 % cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

st(s) = stitch(es)

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

htc = half treble crochet

tc = treble crochet

beg = beginning

... = repeat instructions between asterisks as many times as instructed (...) = instructions between brackets are work in the same st

SIZE

Small and big

MEASUREMENTS

Little cloud: height: 1,6" (4 cm) length: 2,4" (6 cm)

Little raindrop: height: 0,6" (1,5 cm)

Big cloud: height: 2,5" (6,5 cm) length: 3,7" (9,5 cm)

Big raindrop: height: 0,8" (2 cm)

PATTERN INFORMATION

This cloud with its raindrops will embellish your accessories and garments. It's also an awesome little project to use your leftovers of yarn. Clouds and raindrops are available in two sizes.

You can use appliques in many ways. You can crochet and sew them wherever you want to bring some joy. Have fun matching different appliques to create your own landscape or life scene. And sew them on your blankets, cushions, bags, scarf, hat, you can make a garland... the possibilities are endless. For children you can use them as a toy, add a scratch behind the applique and provide a support and they will have fun changing the decor all day long.

The pattern is beginner-friendly, and has a lot of pictures to guide you.

INFO AND TIPS

Ch1 doesn't count as 1 st.

Ch2 or ch3 at the beginning of the round counts as 1 st.

Each piece is finished with an invisible join, some pictures and explanations are available to show you how to do it.

If you planned to sew your appliques on a crocheted or knitted support don't forget to leave a long tail to sew them on your project. If you planned to sew them on another support weave in ends and use sewing thread in the same color as the applique.

SPECIAL STITCHES

How to half treble crochet:

Yarn over twice around hook. Insert hook in the stitch, yarn over and pull through (4 loops on hook). Yarn over, pull through 2 loops (3 loops on hook). Yarn over and pull through all loops on hook.

How to treble crochet:

Yarn over twice around hook. Insert hook in the stitch, yarn over and pull through (4 loops on hook). Yarn over, pull through 2 loops (3 loops on hook). Yarn over and pull through 2 loops (2 loops on hook). Yarn over and pull through all loops on hook.

BIG CLOUD

With color White (01)

CH 15 + 3 (the last ch3 count as 1 st)

Round 1: 2 dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 13 ch, (Image 1) 5 dc in the last ch. (Image 2) Now we will work on the other side of ch. Dc in next 13 ch. Work 2 dc in the last ch. SI st in top of ch3. (Image 3)

Round 2: Ch3 (count as 1 dc), dc in the same st. 2 dc in next 2 sts. (Image 4) Work 1 dc in next 13 sts. 2 dc in next 5 sts (Image 5). Now we will work on the other side of the work. Work 1 dc in next 13 sts, 2 dc in next 2 sts. SI st in top of ch3. (Image 6)

Round 3: ch1 (doesn't count as 1 st), 1 sc in same st. Work 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, skip next st, 6 dc in next st, skip next st, 1 sc in next 2 st. (Image 7) *skip 2 sts, (2 htc, 3tc, 2 htc) in next st, skip 2 sts, 1 sl st in next st* (Image 8). Repeat * from * once. Sl st in next st. (Image 9)

Turn. Work in the first st from the cluster (Image 10) *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* \times 3 times, sc in next st, skip 1 st, sl st in next st (first st of the next cluster), (Image 11). Turn Work. *2 hdc in next st, 1 hdc in next st* \times 4 times, hdc in next st. Sl st in dc from Round 2. (Image 12)

Skip 1 st, 6 dc in next st, skip 1 st, sl st in next st. Work 5 sc in next st, 1 sl st in next st. (Image 13)

Skip 2 sts, (2 htc, 3 tc, 2 htc) in next st, skip 2 sts, 1 sl st in next st. Work Sl st in next st. Sc in next st, hdc in next st, (dc, htc) in next st, 2 htc in next st, (Image 14)

SI st in next st. Sc in next st, hdc in next st, (dc, htc) in next st, 2 htc in next st, (htc, dc) in next st, hdc in next st, 1 sc in next st. Work 5 sc in next st. SI st in next 2 st. (Image 15). Make an invisible join (see how to invisible join below)

BIG RAINDROPS (make 3 or how much you want)

With color Icy blue (76)

Round 1: Make a mr. Ch 1 (doesn't count as 1 st), 6 sc in the ring. Sl st in first st.

Round 2: Ch 1(doesn't count as 1 st), 2 sc in the next 5 sts. Ch 4, (Image 1) work 1 sc in 2nd ch from the hook, 1 hdc in next ch, 1 dc in last ch. (Image 2) Make an invisible join with the first sc and weave in ends. (Image 3)

LITTLE CLOUD

With color White (01)

Ch 12 +3 (the last ch3 counts as 1 st)

Round 1:

Work 1 dc in 4th ch, 1 dc in next 10 ch. 5 dc in last ch. (image 1)

Now we will work on the other side of the work,



1 dc in next 10 sts. Work 3 dc in the last ch, sl st in top of beg ch3. (image 2)

Round 2:

Work 1 sl st in next st. Skip 1 st. Work 5 dc in the same st, skip 1 st, 1 sc in next st. (Image 3)

Work 1 sl st, skip 2 sts. (2htc, 3 tc, 2htc) in next st, skip 2 sts, 1 sc in next st. (Image 4)

Work 1 sl st in next st, 1 sc in next st, 4 sc in same st, 1 sc in next st. (Image 5)

Skip 1 st, 5 dc in the next st, skip 1 st, 1 sc in next st. (Image 6)

Work 1 sl st in next 2 sts, 4 sc in same st, 1 sl st in next st. (Image 7)

Work 1 sl st in next st, *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* x 2. Work 1 sl st blo in next 2 sts. Work 1 sl st in first st. (Image 8)

Round 3:

Work 1 sc in next st. 2 sc in the next 3 sts, 1 sc in next st, 1 sl st in next st. (Image 9)

Work 1 sl st in next st, *1 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st* x twice. 1 sc in next st, 1 sl st in next st. (Image 10)

Make an invisible join and weave in ends. (Image 11)

LITTLE DROPS (make 3 or how much you want)

With color Icy blue (76)

Round 1: Make a mr. Ch1. Work 6 sc in the ring, 1 sl st in first sc.

Round 2: Ch2, (image 1) work 1 sc in 2nd ch. (Image 2) SI st in next st. Make an invisible join and weave in ends.(image 3)

HOW TO MAKE AN INVISIBLE JOIN

Cut the yarn and pull the yarn through the last st. Insert your crochet in the first st, from back to front (Image 1) and pull the yarn through. Then insert the crochet into the last st from back to front BUT in the back loop only (Image 2) and pull through the yarn. Your join will be invisible and you will have a neat finish and weave in ends. (Image 3)
