MATERIALS

Friends Wool: 2 skeins of color 70 (Purple Rain)

Friends Cotton 8/4:

skein color 01 (White)
 skein color 30 (Orange)
 skein color 40 (Tomato)
 skein color 124 (Black)

Crochet hook 4.5 mm / US 7 Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2 Scissors 2 stitch markers Darning needle Sewing pins

YARN QUALITY

Friends Wool, Hobbii
 100% wool
 50 gr (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100 % cotton

50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

In dc, worked in rounds with Friends Wool and crochet hook 4.5 mm (US7) 14 dc x 11 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm **SIZE** 2-4 years (4-6 years) 6-9 years

MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 19,5" (20,5") 21,25" / 50 cm (52cm) 54 cm Length (from neck to forehead): 13,4" (14") 15" / 34 cm (36 cm) 38 cm

PATTERN INFORMATION

Transform your little one into a funny monster for Halloween or for all the winter season!

Globi Hat is made with Friends Wool, a thick, soft and very elastic yarn which makes it perfect for a hat. The details are worked with friends cotton 8/4 yarn. And the little plus that does it all, both are available in a wide range of colours! Ask your kid and have fun with him choosing the colors for his monster hat.

The pattern is beginner-friendly, it uses the basic stitches and there are some step-by-step pictures for details.

The pattern of the matching cowl is also available.

ABBREVIATIONS

st = stitch ch = chain sl st = slip stitch sc = single crochet hdc = half double crochet dc = double crochet inc = crochet 2 st in the same st mr = magic ring beg = beginning

INFO AND TIPS

The first part of the hat is worked in rounds, then we will add the earflaps in rows with some decreases and finish with a round of sc to have a neat border.

Then the mouth and teeth are worked in front of the hat. The mouth is worked in front loops only and the teeth on the back loops.

Finally, all the details are crochet and sewn on the hat.

Some pictures are available to show you some steps and how to make an invisible join. Ch3 and ch2 at the beginning of the row count as 1 st. Ch1 does not count as a st.

HAT

With Friends Wool yarn and 4 mm hook (US7) Start with a mr

Round 1: Ch3, work 11 dc in the ring, join with sl st to top of ch3. Pull to close the ring and secure it. (12 sts)

Round 2: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, inc in each sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (24 sts)



Round 3: Ch3, *inc, 1 dc in the next st* repeat from * to * until 1 st left, inc in the last st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (36 sts)

Round 4: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in the next 2 sts, inc in the next st* repeat from * to * until 2 sts left, 1 dc in the next 2 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (48 sts)

Round 5: Ch3, 1 dc in the next 2 sts *inc, 1 dc in the next 3 sts* repeat from * to * until 1 st left, inc in the last st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (60 sts)

Size 2-4 years only:

Round 6: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in next 5 sts, (inc, 1 dc in next 6 sts) x 2, inc * Repeat twice. Work 1 dc in next 5 sts, (inc, 1 dc in next 6 sts) x 2. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (69 sts)

Round 7: Ch3, 1 dc in each sts around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (69 sts)

Size 4-6 years only:

Round 6: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in the next 4 sts, inc in the next st* repeat from * to * until 4 sts left, 1 dc in the next 4 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (72 sts)

Round 7: Ch3, inc in the next st, 1 dc in each sts around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (73 sts)

Size 6-9 years only:

Round 6: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in the next 4 sts, inc in the next st* repeat from * to * until 4 sts left, 1 dc in the next 4 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (72 sts)

Round 7: Ch3, 1 dc in next 7 sts, inc, 1 dc in next 8 sts, inc, *1 dc in next 17 sts, inc* Repeat 3 times. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (77 sts)

For all sizes:

Rounds 8 to 15 (17) 19: Ch3, 1 dc in each sts around. Fasten off. (69 (73) 77 sts, 7 (9) 11 rounds in total)

Try the hat on your child to check the circumference and the length, 2 rows will be added on the neck.

EARFLAPS

First earflap:

From the end of the round, count 22 (24) 26 sts to the right. The first st counted is the st at the right of the ch3. And join Friends Wool yarn on the 22th (24th) 26th st.

Tip: Work over the yarn ends, here and at the end of the hat to avoid weaving ends.

From here you'll work back and forth in rows and ch2 instead of 3 to have a neat edge.

Row 1: Ch2, work 1 dc in the next 43 (47) 51 sts. Turn (44 (48) 52 sts)



Row 2: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in each st until 3 sts left. Work 1 dec and 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn (46 sts)

Row 3: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in the next 6 sts, 1 dec, 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn. (10 sts)

Row 4: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in the next 4 sts, 1 dec, 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn. (8 sts)

Row 5: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in the next 2 sts, 1 dec, 1dc on top of ch2. Turn. (6 sts)

Row 6: Ch2, work 2 dec, 1dc on top of ch2. Fasten off. (4 sts) Weave in ends.

Second earflap:

Go to the start of Row 2, count 12 to the right and insert crochet in the 12th st.

Repeat Rows 3 to 6. But DO NOT fasten off at the end of Row 6.

To have a neat edge you'll work a border as follow.

Border

Ch1 (does not count as 1st), work 2 sc in the same st. Work 1 sc in the next 2 dc, 2 sc on top of ch2. (6 sts)

Work on the ends of the earflap rows. Crochet 2 sc around each dc and each ch2. (12 sc in total)

Work 1 sc in the next st and place a st marker in that st (the first st of the front part). It is important for the next step. Work 1 sc in the next 23 sts. And place another stitch marker in the last st of the front part. (25 sts in total, 1 marker in the first and 25th st of this part)

Work on the ends of the earflap rows. Crochet 2 sc around each dc and each ch2. (12 sc in total)

Work 2 sc in top of dc. Work 1 sc in the next 2 dc, 2 sc on top of ch2. (6 sts)

Work on the ends of the earflap rows. Crochet 2 sc around each dc and each ch2. (8 sc in total)

Work 1 sc in the next 21 sts. (17 (21) 25 sts)

Work on the ends of the earflap rows. Crochet 2 sc around each dc and each ch2. (8 sc in total)

Join with sl st in the first st. (total: 94 (98) 102 sts) Weave in ends.

MOUTH

With Friends cotton color Tomato, two strands held together, and hook 4.5 mm (US 7). Lay your hat with the right side facing you with the bottom up. Start at the top left corner of the ear flap (see arrow in the picture below). Join and work the mouth with two strands held together of Friends cotton yarn like this:



<u>NOTE:</u> All of the instructions below are worked in the front loops, it is important as you'll work the teeth in the back loops. Don't remove the st markers.

<u>Work all in front loops only</u>: Ch2, count as 1 st here. *Work 1 hdc in each st until there is 1 st left before the next marker. Crochet 2 hdc together in this st and the marked st.* Repeat from * to * one last time. Work 1 hdc in each st until 1 st left before the first ear flap corner. Ch2, sl st in the corner. Fasten off and weave in ends.



Teeth

With Friends cotton color White and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2).

Work with the right side front of you with the bottom up.

NOTE: All of the instructions below are worked in the back loops.

<u>Work all in back loops only</u>: Join yarn in the back loop in the right marked st and ch1. Work 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc in the next st. *Ch6, 1 sc in the second st from the hook, 1 hdc in next st, 1dc in next st, 1 half treble crochet in next st, 1 treble crochet in the last st of the ch. Skip the next st from the hat. ** Work 2 sc in the next 3 st* Repeat from * to * 1 more time, and repeat from * to ** one last time. Work 2 sc in next st and 1 sc in next st. Fasten off, so you have 3 teeth. (Image 1)

Turn your work and work on the wrong side. Now you will work in the front loops, front of the mouth.

<u>Work all in back loops only</u>: Go to the right, join yarn in the front loop in the marked st and ch1. Work 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc in the next st. Repeat from * to * twice, and repeat from * to ** one last time. Work 2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st. sl st in the last st of first part. Fasten off. Weave in ends. (Images 2 and 3)

HORNS (make 6)

With Friends cotton yarn, color Orange and Tomato and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2).

Cut 15 strands approx. 5 cm (2") of yarn color Tomato and leave them on hold.

With Orange yarn, make a mr,

Round 1: Ch3 (count as 1dc), crochet 2 dc, *take a strand color Tomato and fold it in half. Insert the loop under the mr (image 1), and pull both the ends through the loop you just created (image 2) but not too much, it must slips on the mr. The strands must stay at the front of the work (image 3). Crochet 3 dc into the mr (image 4).*. Repeat from * to * once. Insert one last strand like you did before. Be aware to keep the strands on the front of the work before pulling to close the mr. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. Pull to close the ring and secure it. (image 5) (9 dc, 6 strands)

Rounds 2 and 3: Ch3, work dc in each st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3 (9 dc). Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a long tail to sew.

Optional: insert your yarn needle in the strands to unravel them and make them fuzzy (images 7 & 8)

SMALL EYES (make 2)

With Friends cotton yarn, color Black and White and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2).

With Black yarn, make a mr

Round 1: ch1 (does not count as a st), 6 sc in mr. With White yarn, join with sl st in first st. Cut black yarn. (6 sts)

Round 2: ch1, inc in the same st, inc in each st around. Join with sl st in first st. (12 sts)

Round 3: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, *inc, 1 sc in the next st*. Repeat from * to * until there is 1st left. Inc in the last st. Instead sl st to join, cut the yarn leaving a long tail to sew and work an invisible join (see below for a step by step) (18 sts)

LARGE EYES (make 3)

With Friends cotton yarn, color Black and White and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2).

With Black yarn, make a mr **Round 1:** ch1 (does not count as a st), 6 sc in mr. Join with sl st in first st. (6 sts)



Round 2: ch1, inc in the same st, inc in each st around. With White yarn, join with sl st in first st. Cut black yarn. (12 sts)

Round 3: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, *inc, 1 sc in the next st*. Repeat from * to * until there is 1st left. Inc in the last st. Join with sl st in first st (18 sts)

Round 4: ch1, inc in the same st, *1 sc in the next 2 sts, inc*. Repeat from * to * until there are 2 sts left. Work 1 sc in the next 2 sts and join with sl st in first st. (24 sts)

Round 5: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in the next 2 sts *inc, 1 sc in the next 3 sts*. Repeat from * to * until there is 1 st left. Inc in the last st. Instead of working the last sl st, cut the yarn leaving a long tail to sew and work an invisible join (see below for a step by step) (30 sts)

How to work an invisible join:

After the last st, cut the yarn leaving a long tail to sew. And pull the yarn through the last st to just have your tail (images 1 and 2). Insert your crochet in the first st, from back to front (image 3) and pull the yarn through (image 4). Then insert the crochet into the last st from back to front BUT in the back loop only (image 5) and pull through the yarn. Your join will be invisible and you will have a neat finish. (image 6)

ASSEMBLY

With the right side facing you. Fold the right ear flap in two. It will create a line from the earflap bottom to the magic ring (image 1). We will sew the three horns in this line (image 2). Place the first horn on top of Round 2. Place the third horn on top of Round 7. And the second horn in the middle. Pin them to keep them in place and sew them with their yarn tails. Or place them where you want, let your imagination speak!

Pin the eyes where you want to place them. I recommend to stay under round 7, and stay above the 25 stitches of the teeth, do not go further on the sides. Sew them with their yarn tails.
