Cowl

MATERIALS

Friends Wool:

2 (2) 3 skeins color 70 (Purple Rain)

Friends Cotton 8/4:

1 skein color 01 (White)

1 skein color 40 (Tomato)

Crochet hook 4.5 mm / US 7

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2

Scissors

Optional: stitch marker

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii

100% wool

50 gr (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii

100 % cotton

50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

With hook 4.5 mm (US 7)

One pattern repetition:

5 cm x 2,5 cm

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Your work will stretch a lot to allow the head to pass

Circumference: 46 (51) 56 cm / 18" (20") 22"

Height: 8 (10) 15 cm / 3.15" (4") 2"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Combine Globi Cowl with Globi Hat to transform your little one into a monster and keep your kid warm with fun. Or choose to not add the details and make a classic cowl for you!

The Cowl is available in sizes S (toddler), M (child) and L (adult).

It's a quick project with a four row repetition. The pattern is perfect for beginners who want to increase their skill. A step-by-step with pictures is available to learn front and double post stitches and foundation double crochet.

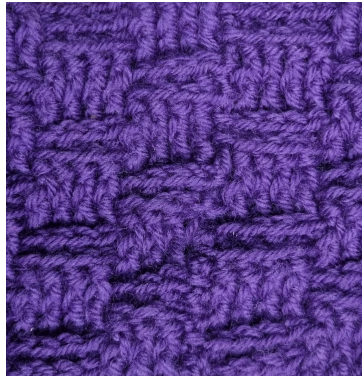

ABBREVIATIONS

st = stitch
ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
fdc = foundation double crochet
fpdc = front post double crochet
bpdc = back post double crochet
yo = yarn over

INFO AND TIPS

The cowl is worked in rounds. The pattern has a count st multiple of 8.

Ch2 at the beginning of each round does not count as 1st. Join in round with slip stitch in the first stitch and work the first pdc around the first pdc of the previous round. Place a marker in the first pdc of the round can help to find it.

Starting with fdc is important to keep elasticity. Instead of crochet fdc you can work a foundation chain and crochet a round of dc but I don't recommend it as you are losing elasticity at the base of the cowl.

The mouth is worked on the front loops of some sts, with Friend Cotton double strands, and the teeth are worked with one strand of Friend cotton in the back loops of the same stitches.

Step-by-steps with pictures are available at the end of the pattern to learn how to work fdc, fpdc and bpdc.

BODY

With Friends Wool yarn and hook 4.5 mm (US 7)

Leaving a tail before to start, make 72 (80) 88 fdc and join in round with sl st in the first st. Use the yarn tail to close the gap at the bottom edge.

Alternative: ch 72 (80) 82 very loosely or use a bigger hook, join with sl st in first st. Ch2, 1 dc in the same ch and 1 dc in each ch around, sl st in first st to join (72 (80) 82 sts)

Round 1: Ch2. Work *fpdc in the next 4 sts, bpdc in the next 4 sts*. Repeat from * to * around. Sl st in the first fpdc to join in round.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Ch 2 does not count as 1dc so work the first pdc around the first pdc of the previous round. NOT around the Ch 2. Place a marker in the first pdc of the round can help.

Round 2: Repeat Round 1

Round 3: Ch2. Work *bpdc in the next 4 sts, fpdc in the next 4 sts*. Repeat from * to * around. Sl st in the first bpdc.

Round 4: Repeat Round 3.

Rounds 5 to 12: Repeat Rounds 1 to 4.

Size Toddler:

Fasten off, and go to **MOUTH AND TEETH**.

Size M / Child only:

Rounds 13 and 14: Repeat Rounds 1 and 2, one last time, fasten off and go to **MOUTH AND TEETH**.

Size L / Adult only:

Rounds 13 to 20: Repeat Rounds 1 to 4.

Rounds 21 and 22: Repeat Rounds 1 and 2, one last time, fasten off

If you work the monster cowl, go to **MOUTH AND TEETH**.

If you want to stop here, the cowl is complete! Well done!

MOUTH AND TEETH

Mouth

With two strands held together of Friends cotton yarn color Tomato and hook 4.5 mm (US 7)



Count 28 sts to the left from the end of the previous row and attach the yarn in the front loop of the next st.

Ch1, count as 1 st here. Work 1 hdc in the front loop only in the next 23 sts. Ch1 and sl st in front loop in next st. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Teeth

With Friends cotton yarn color White and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2).

Work with the right side front of you. All of this is work in the back loop, behind the mouth.

Work all in back loops only: Join yarn and ch1 in the same first st of the mouth BUT in the back loop (Image 1). Work 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc in the next st. *Ch6, 1 sc in the second st from the hook, 1 hdc in next st, 1 dc in next st, 1 half treble crochet in next st, 1 treble crochet in the last st of the ch. Skip the next st from the cowl. ** Work 2 sc in the next 3 sts* Repeat from * to * 1 more time, and repeat from * to ** one last time. Work 2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st. Fasten off, so you have 3 teeth. Fasten off. (Image 2)

Turn your work and work on the wrong side. Now you will work in the front loops, front of the mouth.

Work all in back loops only: Go to the right, join yarn and ch1 in the first st of the mouth BUT in the front loop (Image 3). Work 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc in the next st. Repeat from * to *

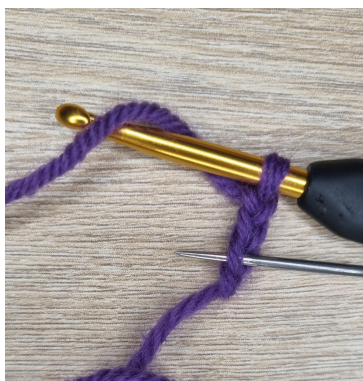
twice, and repeat from * to ** one last time. Work 2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st. Sl st in the last st of first part. Fasten off. Weave in ends.



How to crochet Foundation Double Crochet:



Ch3, leaving a long tail to join in round later.



Yo. You will work in the first chain (mark with the needle)



Insert your hook in the first chain and yo.



Pull through the st and yo.



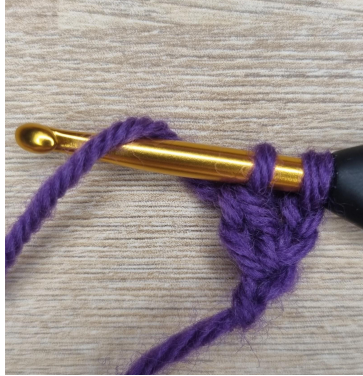
Pull the yo through the first loop on the hook. You now have work one chain (see needle).



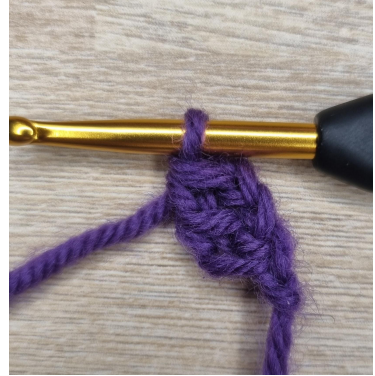
Yo again.



And pull through two loops on your hook. You now have 2 loops on hook.



Yo one last time.



And pull through two last loops. You complete a chain + a double crochet



Yo. Next you will work in the chain at the base of dc. (see needle)



You must insert the hook here, through the two loops.



Like this. And yo. Pull through the st, yo, and pull through one loop.



You created a chain where you will work the next dc.



Yo, pull through two loops.



Yo, and pull through the last two loops.



You now have made 2 fdc.



Continue like this to the end.

How to crochet Front Post Double Crochet:



Yo.



Insert your hook on the right of the stitch you want to work. From front to back.



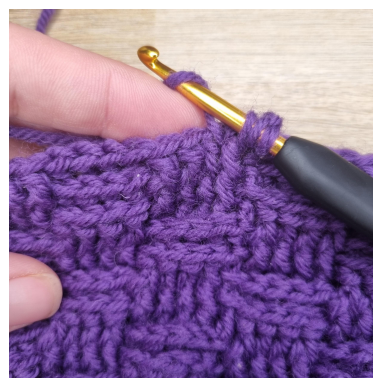
Insert your hook on the left of the stitch you want to work. From back to front.



Yo.



Pull the yo through the stitch. You now have 3 loops on hook.



Yo again.



And pull through two loops on your hook. You now have 2 loops on hook.



Yo one last time.



And pull through two last loops. You complete a Post Double Crochet.

How to crochet Back Post Dc:



Yo.



Insert your hook on the right of the stitch you want to work. From back to front.



Insert your hook on the left of the stitch you want to work. From front to back.



Yo.



Pull the yo through the stitch. You now have 3 loops on hook



Yo again.



And pull through two loops on your hook. You now have 2 loops on hook.



Yo one last time.



And pull through two last loops. You complete a Back Post Dc.

Dare and release your stitches!
