

CROCHET PATTERN Easter Egg

## MATERIALS

1 skein Honey Bunny Shine col 63, Lilac
1 skein Honey Bunny Shine col 22, Lemon Curd

Crochet hook 6 mm (US J/10)
Filling
Tapestry needle

## YARN QUALITY

(60) Honey Bunny Shine, Hobbii

100\% Polyester
$100 \mathrm{~g}(3.5 \mathrm{oz})=120 \mathrm{~m}(131 \mathrm{yds})$

## ABBREVIATIONS

$m r=m a g i c$ ring
sc $=$ single crochet
inc = increase ( 2 stitches in the same stitch)
dec $=$ decrease ( 2 stitches together)
(...) = repeat
$[$ [...] = number of sts in the round

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Small Egg - height: ca. $10 \mathrm{~cm} /$ approx. 4 inches
Large Egg - height: ca. $14 \mathrm{~cm} /$ approx. 5.5 inches

## PATTERN INFORMATION

These cute, soft Easter eggs are fun and quick to make. In the pattern you will find two sizes of eggs. Here they are made in the lovely Honey Bunny Shine yarn, which puts the finishing touch to your work with its stunning glitter effect.
The eggs can be made in whichever yarn, color, pattern and color changes you want. Limited only by your imagination.

## TIPS

Make sure your work is tight so that the filling is not visible. You might want to go down a crochet hook size if you think your work seems too loose with crochet hook $6 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{J} / 10$.

## LARGE EASTER EGG

With color 63, Lilac

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr [6]
Rnd 2: inc $x 6$ [12]
Rnd 3: $(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6$ [18]
Rnd 4: (5 sc, inc) $\times 3$ [21]
Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc, 3 sc ) $\times 3$ [24]
Rnd 6: (7 sc, inc) x 3 [27]
Rnd 7: $(4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}) \times 3$ [30]
Rnd 8: $(9 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 3$ [33]

Change to color 22, Lemon Curd

Rnd 9: (5 sc, inc, 5 sc ) $\times 3$ [36]
Rnd 10: (11 sc, inc) $\times 3$ [39]
Rnd 11: 1 sc in each st [39]

Change to color 63, Lilac

Rnd 12-13: 1 sc in each st [39]

Change to color 22, Lemon Curd

Rnd 14-16: 1 sc in each st [39]

Change to color 63, Lilac

Rnd 17: (11 sc, dec) $\times 3$ [36]
Rnd 18: (4 sc, dec) x 6 [30]
Start to add the filling and continue to stuff as you go.
Rnd 19: (3 sc, dec) x 6 [24]
Rnd 20: $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}) \times 6$ [18]
Rnd 21: (1 sc, dec) x 6 [12]
Rnd 22: dec x 6 [6]
Close by sewing through the front loops of the last 6 stitches, pull the yarn to close the hole, fasten off, and weave in the ends.

## SMALL EASTER EGG

Rnd 1: 6 sc ia a mr [6]
Rnd 2: inc x 6 [12]
Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 [18]
Rnd 4: 1 sc in each st [18]
Rnd 5: (2 sc, inc) x 6 [24]
Rnd 6-11: 1 sc in each st [24]
Rnd 12: (2 sc, dec) x 6 [18]
Rnd 13: (1 sc, dec) $\times 6$ [12]
Stuff the egg.
Rnd 14: dec x 6 [6]
Close by sewing through the front loops of the last 6 stitches, pull the yarn to close the hole, fasten off, and weave in the ends.
