



CROCHET PATTERN

Damask Rose

Skirt

Design: Jane Green - Beautiful Crochet Stuff | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 10) skeins of Rainbow, color Rose (044)

Crochet hook 2,5 mm

YARN QUALITY

Rainbow Lace, Hobbii 100% Cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 280 m (306 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") of grid = 14 dc x 18 rows

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") of shells = 4 shells x 5 rows of shells.

ABBREVIATIONS

sl st = slip stitch
ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
picot = 3 chs, insert your hook in the 3rd ch
from the hook, yarn over, draw the yarn
through the stitch and the loop on the
hook

SIZE

XS (S, M, L, XL, XXL, XXXL)

MEASUREMENTS

Hips: 38 cm / 15 " ($40 \text{ cm} / 15 \frac{3}{4}$ ", ($46 \text{ cm} / 18 \frac{1}{4}$ "), $52 \text{ cm} / 20 \frac{1}{2}$ ", $58 \text{ cm} / 22 \frac{3}{4}$ ", $64 \text{ cm} / 25 \frac{1}{4}$ ", $72 \text{ cm} / 28 \frac{1}{2}$ ") Length: $40 \text{ cm} / 15 \frac{3}{4}$

PATTERN INFORMATION

Damask rose is a beautiful layered lace skirt - Great for a summer party or to spice up your everyday look. To make the skirt a bit stretchy and breathable you should use a bigger crochet hook than the yarn label recommends.

INFO AND TIPS

When doing the grid the number of rounds must me a multiple of 3

How to find your size

Measure the fullest part of your hips and chain according to your measurement.

Size	Number of chs	Hips
XS	224 ch	38 cm / 15 "
S	232 ch	40 cm / 15 ³ / ₄ "
М	240 ch	46 cm / 18 ¼ "
L	248 ch	52 cm / 20 ½ "
XL	256 ch	58 cm / 22 ¾ "
XXL	262 ch	64 cm / 25 ¼ "
XXXL	270 ch	72 cm / 28 ½ "

GRID

With col. 044, ch-224 (232, 240, 248, 256, 262, 270), join with sl st to the 1st ch

Round 1: ch-4, skip 1 ch, dc in next ch, ch-1,* skip 1 ch, dc in next ch, ch-1 **, repeat from * to ** around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 2: ch-4, skip 1 st, dc in next dc, ch-1, * skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch-1 **, repeat from * to ** around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Repeat Round 2 until you reach the desired length. I crocheted 60 rounds = 40 cm.



NOTE: the number of rounds must me a multiple of 3

LACE PATTERN

Round 1: skip the firsts 2 rounds of the grid, connect the yarn to any ch-1 of the 3rd round of the grid, ch-1, sc in the same ch, * (ch-3, sc in next ch-1 space) repeat once, ch-7, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next ch-1 space **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to the 1st sc

Round 2: sl st in the 1st ch-3 space, ch-1, sc in next sc, * dc in next ch-7 space, ch-1, (dc in same space, picot, ch-1) repeat 4 times, dc in same space, skip next ch-3 space, sc in next sc (the place between 2 ch-3 spaces) **, repeat from * to ** around, join with sl st to the 1st sc

Repeat Rounds 1-2 until you fill your grid

CORD

Ch-300, dc in the 3rd ch from the hook, dc in each ch to the end of the row. Slip the cord through the 1st round of the grid.

NOTE: the length of the cord depends on your waist measurement. 300 chs - 133 cm / 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
