## Skirt

## MATERIALS

$5(6,6,7,8,8,9)$ skeins of Friends Cotton
8/4 Mercerized, color Lilac (63)

Crochet hook 3 mm (US 3)

## YARN QUALITY

(12) Friends Cotton 8/4 Mercerized, Hobbii

100\% cotton
$50 \mathrm{~g}=160 \mathrm{~m}$

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=20$ sts $\times 9$ rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

sl st = slip stitch
ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
picot $=3$ chs, insert your hook in the 3rd ch from the hook, yarn over, draw the yarn through the stitch and the loop on the hook

## SIZE

XS (S, M, L, XL, XXL, XXXL)

## MEASUREMENTS

The measurements are in width Waist: $30 \mathrm{~cm} / 11$ 3/4 " (33 cm / 12", $35 \mathrm{~cm} / 13$ $3 / 4$ ", $37 \mathrm{~cm} / 14 ½$ ", $39 \mathrm{~cm} / 15$ ½", $41 \mathrm{~cm} /$ 16", 43 cm / $163 / 4$ ) Hips: $44 \mathrm{~cm} / 17$ ¼ ", ( $49 \mathrm{~cm} / 19$ 1/4", $49 \mathrm{~cm} /$ 19 1/4", $54 \mathrm{~cm} / 21 \frac{1 ⁄ 4}{\prime \prime}, 53 \mathrm{~cm} / 21^{\prime \prime}, 66 \mathrm{~cm} / 25$ ", 66 cm / 25 ")

Length: $85 \mathrm{~cm} / 33$ ½" Can be adjusted

Crochet a beautiful lace skirt for this summer. Wear it on top of your bikini, a tight dress or even jeans to give it an edgy look. You can easily adjust the length or the width to your size by just making more or less rows or rapports. Skill-level: intermediate.

## INFO AND TIPS

Lace pattern - the number of stitches must be a multiple of 7

## How to find your size

Measure your waist and start crocheting a foundation dc row. The number of dc stitches is a multiple of 2 .

| Size | Number of dc | Waist |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| XS | 126 dc | $30 \mathrm{~cm} / 11^{3 / 4}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ |
| S | 132 dc | $33 \mathrm{~cm} / 12^{\prime \prime}$ |
| M | 140 dc | $35 \mathrm{~cm} / 13^{3 / 4}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ |
| L | 148 dc | $37 \mathrm{~cm} / 14^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ |
| XL | 154 dc | $39 \mathrm{~cm} / 15^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ |
| XXL | 162 dc | $41 \mathrm{~cm} / 16^{\prime \prime}$ |
| XXXL | 168 dc | $43 \mathrm{~cm} / 16^{3 / 4}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ |

## WAIST

With col. 63, crochet a foundation dc row (see the table above), join with sl st to the first dc

Round 1: ch-4 (counts as a dc + ch-1), skip next dc, dc in next dc, ch-1, * skip next dc, dc in next dc, ch- 1 **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 2: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in each ch-1 space and each dc to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3

XS proceed to Lace Pattern

126 dc

Round 3: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next $7 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ dc in next dc, * dc in next $8 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next $\mathrm{dc} * *$, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3 (+ $14 \mathrm{dc}=140$ dc)

Round 4: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next 8 dc, 2 dc in next dc, * dc in next 9 dc, 2 dc in next dc **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3 (+ $14 \mathrm{dc}=154$ dc)

## S proceed to Lace Pattern

132 dc

Round 3: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ dc in next dc, * dc in next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next $\mathrm{dc} * *$, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3 (+ $22 \mathrm{dc}=154$ dc)

Round 4: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next 9 dc, 2 dc in next dc, * dc in next 10 dc, 2 dc in next $\mathrm{dc} * *$, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3 (+ $14 \mathrm{dc}=168$ dc)

M proceed to Lace Pattern

140 dc

Round 3: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next 8 dc, 2 dc in next dc, * dc in next 9 dc, 2 dc in next $\mathrm{dc} * *$, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3 (+ $14 \mathrm{dc}=154$ dc)

Round 4: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next $9 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, * dc in next 10 dc , 2 dc in next $\mathrm{dc} * *$, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3 (+ $14 \mathrm{dc}=168$ dc)

L proceed to Lace Pattern

148 dc

Round 3: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next 8 dc, 2 dc in next dc, * dc in next 9 dc, 2 dc in next dc **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the last 8 dc , dc in the last 8 dc , join with sl st to top of ch-3 (170 dc)

Round 4: ch-3 (count as a dc), 2 dc in the 1 st st , dc in next $8 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, * dc in next 9 $\mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the last $8 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{dc}$ in the last 8 dc , join with sl st to top of ch-3 (189 dc)

XL proceed to Lace Pattern

154 dc

Round 3: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next $9 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, * dc in next 10 dc , 2 dc in next dc **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3 (+ $14 \mathrm{dc}=168$ dc)

Round 4: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next $10 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, * dc in next $11 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3 (+ 14 dc $=182 \mathrm{dc}$ )

## XXL proceed to Lace Pattern

162 dc

Round 3: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, * dc in next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next $\mathrm{dc} * *$, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3 (+ $27 \mathrm{dc}=189$ dc)

Round 4: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next $25 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, * dc in next $26 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3 (+ $7 \mathrm{dc}=$ 196 dc)

XXXL proceed to Lace Pattern

168 dc

Round 3: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next 9 dc, 2 dc in next dc, * dc in next 10 dc, 2 dc in next dc **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3 (+ $14 \mathrm{dc}=182$ dc)

Round 4: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in next $11 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, * dc in next $12 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3 (+ 14 dc $=196 \mathrm{dc}$ )

## LACE PATTERN

NOTE: the number of stitches must be a multiple of 7
Round 5: ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in same place, ch-2, 2 dc in same place, * ch-3, skip next 6 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch-2, 2 dc in same place **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, at the end of the round ch-3, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 6: sl st in next dc, sl st in next ch-2 space, ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in same space, ch-2, 2 dc in same space, ch-2, sc in next ch-3 space, ch-2, * 2 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 2 dc in same space, ch-2, sc in next ch-3 space, ch-2 **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 7: sl st in next dc, sl st in next ch-2 space, ch-3 (count as a dc), dc in same space, ch-2, 2 dc in same space, ch-3, skip next 2 ch-2 spaces, * 2 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 2 dc in same space, ch-3, skip next 2 ch-2 spaces **, repeat from * to ** around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Repeat Round 6-7 until you reach 12 rounds (finish with Round 6)
Start increasing the skirt this way:
Round 1: sl st in next dc, sl st in next ch-2 space, ch-3 (count as a dc), 2 dc in same space, ch-3, 3 dc in same space, ch-4, skip next 2 ch-2 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-3, 3 dc in same space, ch-4, skip next 2 ch-2 spaces **, repeat from * to ** around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 2: sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-3 space, ch-3 (count as a dc), 2 dc in same space, ch-3, 3 dc in same space, ch-2, sc in next ch-4 space, ch-2, * 3 dc in next ch- 2 space, ch-3, 3 dc in same space, ch-2, sc in next ch-3 space, ch-2 **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 3: sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-3 space, ch-3 (count as a dc), 2 dc in same space, ch-3, 3 dc in same space, ch-4, skip next 2 ch-2 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch-3 space, ch-3, 3 dc in same space, ch-4, skip next 2 ch-2 spaces **, repeat from * to ** around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Repeat Rounds 2-3 until you reach the desired length. I crocheted 47 rounds. (finish with Round 3)

## SHELL EDGE

Round 1: sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-3 space, ch-3 (count as a dc), 7 dc in same space, ch-3, sc in next ch-4 space, ch-3, * 8 dc in next ch-3 space, ch-3, sc in next ch-4 space, ch-3 **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 2: ch-6, (counts as the 1st dc and picot), sl st in the 4th ch from the hook, (dc in next dc, picot) repeat 6 times, sc in next ch-3 space, ch-1, sc in next ch-3 space, * (dc in next dc, picot) repeat 7 times, sc in next ch-3 space, ch-1, sc in next ch-3 space **, repeat from * to ** around, join with sl st to the 1st st

## CORD

Crochet a foundation sc. I crocheted $310 \mathrm{sc}=142 \mathrm{~cm}$. The length depends on your waist measurement. Slip the cord through the 2 nd round.
