MATERIALS

Friends cotton 8/4 in each color:

skein color Black (124)
skein color Dark Magenta (48)
skein color Icy Blue (76)
skein color Orange (30)
skein color Rose (44)
skein color Shamrock (104)

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2 Scissors Yarn needle to weave in ends

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii
100 % cotton
50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

Gauge is not important here

ABBREVIATIONS

mr = magic ring ch = chain st(s) = stitch(es) sl st = slip stitch hdc = half double crochet dc = double crochet blo = back loop only (...) = instructions between brackets are worked in the same stitch

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Small butterfly: 1,2" x 0,8" (3 cm x 2 cm) Big Butterfly: 2,1" x 1,4" (5,5 cm x 3,5 cm)

PATTERN INFORMATION

Diane the butterfly will add a touch of spring and embellish your accessories and garments. It's also an awesome little project to use your leftovers of yarn. Diane is available in two sizes.

You can use appliques in many ways. You can crochet and sew them wherever you want to bring some joy. Have fun matching different appliques to create your own landscape or life scene. And sew them on your blankets, cushions, bags, scarf, hat, pants... the possibilities are endless. For children you can use them as a toy, add a velcro behind the applique and provide a support and they will have fun changing the decor all day long.

INFO AND TIPS

You will first crochet 2 tinies hearts and join them with slip stitches to create a small butterfly.

If you planned to sew your appliques on a crocheted or knitted support don't forget to leave a long tail to sew them on your project. If you planned to sew them on another support weave in ends and use sewing thread in the same color as the applique.

Small Butterfly

Wings (make 2)

With the yarn of your choice and 2.5 mm (US C/2) hook.

Make a mr. Work all these sts in mr: ch 2, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 1 dc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, ch2, 1 sl st. Tight to close the mr. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Make a second wing with the same process.

Body

With the black yarn and 2.5 mm (US C/2) hook.

Now we will sl st the wings together.

Lay the wings with points downwards. With a slip knot on the hook, insert the hook through BOTH wings, into the back loop of the hdc just before the middle dc and make a sl st through the two wings. Work 1 sl st blo in next 3 sts upwards, working throughout both wings to join them. (4 sl sts in total) Fasten off and weave in end. BUT keep the first tail to create the antennas. Cut it short enough and separate the yarn in two parts.





Big Butterfly

Wings (make 2)

With the yarn of your choice and 2.5 mm (US C/2) hook.

Round 1: Make a mr. Work all these sts in mr: ch2, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 1 dc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, ch2, 1 sl st. Tight to close the mr, but not too much because we need to work a last st in it later.

Round 2: Ch1, sl st on 2nd ch from the beginning of round 1. Ch2, 3 dc in the next st, 2 dc in next st, 1 hdc in next 2 sts. Work (hdc, dc, hdc) in the next st, 1 hdc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, 3 dc in the last dc. Ch2, sl st in the last ch1 from round 1, ch1 and 1 sl st in the mr where you worked all the sts in round 1. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Make a second wing with the same process.

Body

With the black yarn and 2.5 mm (US C/2) hook.

Now we will sl st the wings together.

Row 1: Lay the wings with points downwards. With a slip knot on the hook, insert the hook through BOTH wings, into the back loop of the hdc just before the middle dc and make a sl st through the two wings. Work 1 sl st blo in next 4 sts upwards, working throughout both wings to join them. (5 sl sts in total)

Row 2: Turn and work sl st in each front loop of the body (5 sl sts in total). Cut yarn and keep the tails to create the antennas.



Well done! Have fun mixing and matching your appliques.
