MATERIALS

Friends cotton 8/4 1 skein of color Lapis Blue (93) 1 skein of color Sunflower (24) 1 skein of color Orange (30)

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2 Scissors Yarn needle A scrap black yarn

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii
100 % cotton
50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

mr = magic ring ch = chain st(s) = stitch(es) sl st = slip stitch sc = single crochet hdc = half double crochet dc = double crochet tc = treble crochet *...* = repeat instructions between asterisks as many times as instructed

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 3.15" (8 cm) Width (at the largest point): 2" (5 cm)

PATTERN INFORMATION

Pipite the Bird will embellish your accessories and garments. It's also an awesome little project to use your leftovers of yarn.

You can use appliques in many ways. You can crochet and sew them wherever you want to bring some joy. Have fun matching different appliques to create your own landscape or life scene. And sew them on your blankets, cushions, bags, scarf, hat, pants... the possibilities are endless. For children you can use them as a toy, add a velcro behind the applique and provide a support and they will have fun changing the decor all day long.

INFO AND TIPS

You will crochet the body, the tail and the head in one piece, then the beak and the legs on the body. Finally you will crochet the wing and sew it on the body and create an eye.

Ch 3 at the beginning of a round count as a st. Ch1 at the beginning of a round doesn't count as 1 st.

If you planned to sew your appliques on a crocheted or knitted support don't forget to leave a long tail to sew them on your project. If you planned to sew them on another support weave in ends and use sewing thread in the same color as the applique.

How to work an invisible join:

After the last st, cut the yarn and pull the yarn to just have your tail and close the loop. Insert your crochet in the indicated st, from back to front and pull the yarn through. Then insert the crochet into the last st made from back to front BUT in the back loop only and pull through the yarn. Your join will be invisible and you will have a neat finish.

BODY

With Friends cotton color Lapis Blue (93), and 2.5 mm (US C/2) hook

Make a mr **Round 1:** Ch3, work 11 dc in the mr. Join with sl st on top of ch3. (12 sts)

Round 2: Ch3, work 1 dc in the same st. work 2 dc in each st around. Join with sl st on top of ch3. (24 sts)

Round 3 (tail, back and head): Ch6, 1 sc in the 2nd ch from the hook, 1 hdc in next ch, 1 dc in the next 2 ch, 1 tc in the last ch. Skip 1 st from the body and sl st in the next st, *2 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the next st*. Repeat from * to * 3 times in total. 1 sc in the next st. Skip 1 st and work 8 dc in the next st. Skip 1 st and sl st in the next st.



Round 4: Ch 1 and turn. Work on top of the head. Work 1 sc in the next st (around the last sl st of round 3), *2 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the next st*. Repeat from * to * 3 times in total. Work 2 sc in the next st, fasten off and make an invisible join with the next st.

Beak and legs

With Friends cotton color Orange (30), and 2.5 mm (US C/2) hook

Beak: With the right side in front of you, from the first st on the bottom of the head, count up 5 sts and join yarn in the 5th st. Ch2, 1 dc in the same st. Ch 1 and sl st in the same st. Cut and weave in ends, be careful to be invisible on the right side.

First leg: With the right side in front of you, from the bottom of the tail, count 5 sts on the body, to the left. Join yarn in the 5th st. *Ch 4, sl st in the 2nd ch from hook, sl st in the next st, ch 2, sl st in the 2nd ch from hook and sl st in the next st (where you already work your 2nd sl st). Sl st in the next ch, sl st in the body's st where you joined the yarn. Fasten off and weave in ends*

Second leg: skip the st to the left of the first leg and join yarn in the next st. Repeat from * to * once. Be careful to be invisible on the right side when weaving in ends.

WING

With Friends cotton color Sunflower (24), and 2.5 mm (US C/2) hook

Make a mr

Work all of these sts in the mr: ch 2, 2 hdc, 2 dc, ch 1, 1 tc, ch 1, 2 dc, 3 hdc. Tighten to close the mr but not too much because we will work a last st in it later.

Now you need to turn your work to crochet on the side of the last and first sts. Ch1, work 1 sc around the last dc post, 1 sc in the mr, 1 sc around the ch2 of the beginning. Cut the yarn and work in invisible join with the 2nd ch at the beginning of the round. Close the mr.

Sew the wing on the body, on top of the first round of the body, with the point on the right, slightly leaning down.

With a black scrap yarn. Sew an eye, with the needle pass the yarn through the 3rd st above the beak. Make two knots and go back. Be careful to not go through the same place, insert the needle just next to it. Secure and weave in ends so that it's invisible on the right side.

Have fun mixing and matching your appliques!
