

## **KNITTING PATTERN**



Design: The Knitted Dingo | Hobbii Design



### **MATERIALS**

1 skein of Silly Socks Flower Pop col. 5, Thunbergia

Circular needle 2.5mm (US 1.5), 80 cm (31.5")
Stitch markers
Darning needle

## YARN QUALITY

**Silly Socks Flower Pop**, Hobbii 75% Wool, 25% Polyamide 100 g (3.5 oz) = 400 m (437 yds)

### **GAUGE**

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 36 sts x 44 rows

### SIZE

EU 36/37 (38/39, 40/41, 42/43)

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Foot Circumference: 7" (8", 9", 10") / 18 (20, 23, 25,5) cm

Socks should be worn with 1-2 inches / 2-4 cm of negative ease. Take your foot measurement at its widest point and select the size that fits best. If there is stitch count that doesn't give the required fit you can always go up or down a needle size if you prefer socks more snug.

### PATTERN INFORMATION

This is the perfect sock pattern to get you into sock knitting. This pattern is easily customisable to fit your feet. You can adjust the foot length and the leg length to get the best fit. With Hobbii's range of colours there are endless possibilities. The sock is knitted from top to toe with a small rib at the top.

# **Pattern**







## **ABBREVIATIONS**

K = knit

P = Purl

**SSK** = Slip two stitches and knit together

**K2TOG** = Knit two stitches together

**TSK** = stitch will sit on left needle, from here with your right needle pick up the leg of the right side of the stitch below and lift onto needle, place right needle into lifted stitch as if to knit. Knit and turn work, do not slip the original stitch that was above. Slip knit stitch back onto right needle and continue to purl row. You should see on the RS of knit you will have two stitch loops/legs coming out of one.

**TSP** = working stitch will sit on left needle, from here with your right needle pick up the back loop of the purl stitch below and slide onto left needle. Purl into this loop and turn work. Slip worked stitch back to right needle and continue to knit row. You will see you have two stitch loops/legs coming out of one.

## **INFO AND TIPS**

This pattern is knit from the top down so you can try the socks on as you go to get the perfect fit.

## **CUFF**

### Rib edge

Cast on (48) 56 (64) 72 sts on circular needle in the magic loop method, place a stitch marker to mark the beginning of the round. Arrange stitches so you have (24) 28 (32) 36 on each needle.

Knit in 1x1 rib until the piece measures 1 inch or 2.5cm from cast on. If you would prefer a longer edge knit as many rounds as desired.

Continue to knit until desired length or 2 inches/5 cm less of leg length as the heel will measure 2 inches/5 cm when complete.



## HEEL

You will begin working across (24) 28 (32) 36 stitches, leaving the other stitches on scrap yarn or the thread of the magic loop.

Knit across (22) 26 (30) 34 stitches, you will be left with two stitches on the needle. In the next stitch work a TSK and turn.

Purl to 2 stitches from end TSP, turn.

**Row 1:** Knit to 1 stitch from end TSK, turn **Row 2:** Purl to 1 stitch from end TSP, turn

Repeat until there are 10 plain stitches between all the TSP and TSK stitches. You will finish on a Row 2.

As you turn and knit, knit the 10 plain stitches and then place a marker. Continue to knit across row knitting each TSK as you come to them. At the end of the row you will have the original stitch left from the set up rows. TSK in that stitch and turn.

Purl to marker, slip marker and then purl the 10 stitches. Place the second marker and then purl each TSP as you come to it. When you reach the last stitch, TSP and turn.

Knit until the first marker, slip stitch marker and knit to the next marker. Remove this marker and TSK in the next stitch, turn.

Purl until next marker, remove marker and TSP in the next stitch.

**Row 1:** Knit until TSK, knit TSK and work a TSK in next stitch, turn.

**Row 2:** Purl until TSP, purl TSP and work a TSP in next stitch, turn.

Continue until you have two TSK at the left end of the needle and two TSP on the right needle from the final row 2 turn. Knit until end of row but then continue to knit in round back to the BOR marker. Slip marker and knit the two remaining TSP stitches as you come to them. Continue and knit the rest of the round.

Now all TSK and TSP stitches have been knit, continue to knit in the round until the piece measures 2 inches/5 cm less than desired foot length. Before starting your toe ensure that your stitches are still set out as (24) 28 (32) 36 stitches per needle.

#### TOE

Round 1: Knit

**Round 2:** \*K1, SSK knit to 3 sts before end of needle K2TOG, K1\* repeat from \* to \* on other needle

Repeat rounds 1-2 until (8) 10 (10) 10 stitches remain on each needle. Close toe with Kitchener stitch and weave in ends.



## **FINISHING**

Make sure to weave in all ends and gently block socks. This will remove any ridge that has appeared from knitting magic loop.
