Legwarmers

Design: The Rainbow Pumpkin | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

1 skein of Horizon (Color 11)

Crochet hook 4mm (US 6) Scissors Tapestry needle Tape measure

YARN QUALITY

Horizon, Hobbii
100% Premium Acrylic
200g / 7 oz = 550m / 501 yds

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 16dc sts and 10 rows

SIZE

The calf measurement is the circumference of the widest part of your calf. S - calf measurement up to 37cm / 14.6" M - calf measurement up to 39cm / 15.4" L - calf measurement up to 41cm / 16.1"

You can make yours smaller or larger than these sizes if needed, please see the pattern for details.

MEASUREMENTS

S - 34cm / 13.4" circumference x 30cm / 11.8" length M - 36cm / 14.2" circumference x 30cm / 11.8" length L - 38cm / 16" circumference x 30cm / 11.8" length

PATTERN INFORMATION

These snazzy legwarmers are sure to keep you nice and cosy and brighten up any outfit. You can use any color of Hobbii Horizon - the brighter the better!

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain st = stitch sl st = slip stitch dc = double crochet Dc2tog = double crochet 2 stitches together (decrease) fpdc/bpdc = front post double crochet/back post double crochet fo = fasten off ws = wrong side rs = right side rep = repeat

INFO AND TIPS

These legwarmers can be made in one of three sizes based on the widest part of your calf. However if you need to make yours smaller than size S or larger than size L you can adjust the st count accordingly. To do this your leg warmer circumference needs to measure 3 cm / 1.2 inches less than your calf and you can work out your st count based on 16 dc sts = 10 cm / 4 inches. The length is the same for all sizes but again you can adjust this by adding or removing rows in the main section (before the decreases begin).

Ch2 does not count as a st.

TOP RIBBING

Row 1: Leaving a tail to sew up the gap later, ch 57/60/64 then dc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch along to the end, sl st to the other end of the ch to create a ring. Turn. (55/58/62) Row 2: Ch2, fpdc in the first st, bpdc in the second st, alternate these until you reach the last 2 sts, fpdc in the second to last then dc in the last, sl st to ch2 to join, turn. (55/58/62) Row 3: Ch2, bpdc in the first st and fpdc in the second, continue until the end, dc in last st, sl st to ch2, turn. (55/58/62)



MAIN PART

Row 4: Ch2, dc in each st, sl st to ch2 to join turn. (55/58/62) Rows 5 - 25: Rep row 4 Row 26: Ch2, *dc2tog across the next 2 stitches*, then rep * to '* one more time, dc in each st until 4 remain, rep * to * twice, sl st to ch2 to join, turn (51/54/58) Row 27: Rep row 26 (47/50/54) Row 28: Ch2, dc in each st, sl st to ch2 to join, turn (47/50/54) Row 29: Rep row 28 Row 30: Rep row 26 (43/46/50)

BOTTOM RIBBING

Row 31: Ch2, fpdc in the first st, bpdc in the second st, alternate these until you reach the last 2 sts, fpdc in the second to last then dc in the last, sl st to ch2 to join, fo and weave in ends. (43/46/50)
