MATERIALS

Friends Wool:

2 skeins of color Artichoke (110)

Friends Cotton 8/4:

- 1 skein color White (01)
- 1 skein color Sunflower (24)
- 1 skein color Orange (30)
- 1 skein color Tomato (40)
- 1 skein color Lilac (63)
- 1 skein color Aqua (91)
- 1 skein color Pastel Green (100)
- 1 skein color Black (124)

Crochet hook 4.5 mm / US 7 Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2 Sewing pins Stuffing Darning needle Mini rubber bands for braids

YARN QUALITY

Friends Wool, Hobbii 100% wool 50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100 % cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

In dc, worked in rounds with Friends Wool and crochet hook 4.5 mm (US7)

14 dc x 11 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

SIZE

2-4 years (4-6 years) 6-9 years

MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 19.5" (20.5") 21.25" / 50 cm (52 cm) 54 cm Length (from neck to forehead): 13.4" (14") 15" / 34 cm (36 cm) 38 cm

PATTERN INFORMATION

Cotillon is a funny monster who likes to make funny faces and make his friends laugh.

Make your own hat and transform your little one into a funny monster for Halloween or for all the winter season!

Cotillon Hat is made with Friends Wool, a thick, soft and very elastic yarn which makes it perfect for a hat. The details are worked with Friends Cotton 8/4 yarn. And the little plus that does it all, both are available in a wide range of colours! Ask your kid and have fun with them choosing the colors for their monster hat.

The pattern is beginner-friendly as it uses basic stitches.

ABBREVIATIONS

st = stitch ch = chain sl st = slip stitch sc = single crochet hdc = half double crochet dc = double crochet inc = crochet 2 st in the same st dec = crochet 2 sts together mr = magic ring beg = beginning

INFO AND TIPS

The first part of the hat is worked in rounds, then we will add the earflaps in rows with some decreases and finish with a round of sc to have a neat border.

Finally, all the details are crocheted and sewn on the hat.

Some pictures are available to show you how to make an invisible join.

Ch3 and ch2 at the beginning of the row/round count as a st.

Ch1 at the beginning of the row/round does not count as a st.

To change color, start the last sc of the round with the current color but make the last yarn over with the new color: insert hook, yarn over with current color, pull the loop through, yarn over with the new color and pull through the two loops on hook.

HAT

With Friends Wool yarn color Artichoke (110) and hook 4.5 mm (US7)

Start with a mr.



Round 1: Ch3, work 11 dc in the ring, join with sl st to top of ch3. Pull to close the ring and secure it. (12 sts)

Round 2: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, inc in each st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (24 sts)

Round 3: Ch3, *inc, 1 dc in the next st* repeat from * to * until 1 st left, inc in the last st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (36 sts)

Round 4: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in the next 2 sts, inc in the next st* repeat from * to * until 2 sts left, 1 dc in the next 2 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (48 sts)

Round 5: Ch3, 1 dc in the next 2 sts *inc, 1 dc in the next 3 sts* repeat from * to * until 1 st left, inc in the last st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (60 sts)

Size 2-4 years only:

Round 6: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in next 5 sts, (inc, 1 dc in next 6 sts) x 2, inc *. Repeat twice. Work 1 dc in next 5 sts, (inc, 1 dc in next 6 sts) x 2. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (69 sts)

Round 7: Ch3, 1 dc in each st around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (69 sts)

Size 4-6 years only:

Round 6: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in the next 4 sts, inc in the next st* repeat from * to * until 4 sts left, 1 dc in the next 4 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (72 sts)

Round 7: Ch3, 1 dc in each st around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (72 sts)

Size 6-9 years only:

Round 6: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in the next 4 sts, inc in the next st* repeat from * to * until 4 sts left, 1 dc in the next 4 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (72 sts)

Round 7: Ch3, 1 dc in next 7 sts, inc, 1 dc in next 8 sts, inc, *1 dc in next 17 sts, inc*. Repeat 3 times. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (77 sts)

For all sizes:

Rounds 8 to 14 (16) 18: Ch3, 1 dc in each st around. Fasten off. (69 (72) 77 sts, 7 (9) 11 rounds in total)

Try the hat on your child to check the circumference and the length, 2 rows will be added on the neck.

EARFLAPS

With Friends Wool yarn color Artichoke (110) and hook 4.5 mm (US7)

First Earflap

From the end of the round, count 22 (24) 26 sts to the right. The first st counted is the st at the right of the ch3. And join the yarn on the 22th (24th) 26th st.

Tip: Work over the yarn ends, here and at the end of the hat to avoid weaving ends.



From here you'll work back and forth in rows and ch2 instead of 3 to have a neat edge.

Row 1: Ch2, work 1 dc in the next 43 (47) 51 sts. Turn (44 (48) 52 sts)

Row 2: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in each st until 3 sts left. Work 1 dec and 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn (42 (46) 50 sts)

Row 3: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in the next 6 sts, 1 dec, 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn. (10 sts)

Row 4: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in the next 4 sts, 1 dec, 1dc on top of ch2. Turn. (8 sts)

Row 5: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in the next 2 sts, 1 dec, 1dc on top of ch2. Turn. (6 sts)

Row 6: Ch2, work 2 dec, 1dc on top of ch2. Fasten off. (4 sts) Weave in ends.

Second Earflap

With the right side facing you. Go to the start of Row 2, count 12 sts to the right and insert crochet in the 12th st.

Repeat Rows 3 to 6. **But make the very last yarn over with 2 strands held together of Friends Cotton yarn, color Tomato (40).** DO NOT fasten off and continue with *Border*.

Border

Continue to work with 2 strands of Friends Cotton, color Tomato (40), and hook 4.5 mm (US7)

Ch1 (does not count as 1st) and turn to work on the right side. Work 2 sc in the same st. Work 1 sc in the next 2 dc, 2 sc on top of ch2. (6 sts)

Work on the ends of the earflap rows. Crochet 2 sc around each dc and each ch2. (12 sc in total)

Work 1 sc in the next 24 sts. (24 sts)

Work on the ends of the earflap rows. Crochet 2 sc around each dc and each ch2. (12 sc in total)

Work 2 sc in top of dc. Work 1 sc in the next 2 dc, 2 sc on top of ch2. (6 sts)

Work on the ends of the earflap rows. Crochet 2 sc around each dc and each ch2. (8 sc in total)

Work 1 sc in the next 19 (22) 27 sts. (19 (22) 27 sts)

Work on the ends of the earflap rows. Crochet 2 sc around each dc and each ch2. (8 sc in total)

Join with sl st in the first st. (total: 95 (98) 103 sts) Weave in ends.



HORNS (make 2)

With Friends cotton yarn, colors 63, 40, 30, 24, 91, 100 and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2)

Start with the color **Lilac**

Make a mr

Round 1: ch1 (doesn't count as 1 st), 6 sc in the mr. Join with sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 2: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, *inc, 1 sc in the next st*. Repeat from * to * to the end. Join with sl st in first st (9 sts)

Round 3: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in each st around. Change to color **Tomato** (see INFO AND TIPS). Join with sl st in first st (9 sts)

Round 4: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in next st, *inc, 1 sc in next 2 sts*. Repeat from * to * to the end. Join with sl st in first st (12 sts)

Round 5: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in each st around. Join with sl st in first st (12 sts)

Round 6: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in next 2 sts, *inc, 1 sc in next 3 sts*. Repeat from * to * to the end. Change to color **Orange**. Join with sl st in first st (15 sts)

Round 7: Repeat Round 5. (15 sts)

Round 8: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in next 3 sts, *inc, 1 sc in next 4 sts*. Repeat from * to * to the end. Join with sl st in first st (18 sts)

Round 9: Repeat Round 3 but change to color **Sunflower** (18 sts)

Round 10: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, work 1 sc in next 6 sts, *inc, 1 sc in next st*. Repeat from * to * twice, inc in next st, work 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. Join with sl st in first st (21 sts)

Round 11: Repeat Round 5. (21 sts)

Round 12: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, work 1 sc in next 7 sts, *inc, 1 sc in next 2 sts*. Repeat from * to * twice, inc in next st, work 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. Change to color **Aqua**. Join with sl st in first st (24 sts)

Round 13: Repeat Round 5. (24 sts)

Round 14: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, work 1 sc in next 7 sts, *inc, 1 sc in next 3 sts*. Repeat from * to * twice, inc in next st, work 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. Join with sl st in first st (27 sts).

Round 15: Repeat Round 3 but change to color **Pastel Green** (27 sts)

Round 16: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, work 1 sc in next 8 sts, *inc, 1 sc in next 4 sts*. Repeat from * to * twice, inc in next st, work 1 sc in the last 6 sts. Join with sl st in first st (30 sts).

Rounds 17 and 18: Repeat Round 5. (30 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew to the hat. And stuff the horn. Repeat to make a second horn.



MOUTH

With 2 strands of Friends Cotton yarn held together, color Black (124) and hook 4.5 mm (US7)

Make 15 ch and fasten off. Cut one of the threads short enough and weave in, and cut the other one leaving a long tail to sew the mouth to the hat later.

TONGUE

With Friends Cotton yarn, color Tomato (40) and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2)

You will work the first row around a foundation chain. Ch8.

Row 1: Work 1 dc in the 3rd st from hook, 1 dc in next 2 ch, 1 hdc in next 2 ch, 4 sc in the last ch. Turn and work on the other side of the chain. Work 1 hdc in next 2 ch, 1 dc in next 3 ch.

Row 2: ch 1 (doesn't count as a st) and turn. Work 1 hdc in the next 3 sts. Work 1 sc in the next 2 sts, *1 sc in next st, inc in next st*. Repeat one more time. Work 1 sc in next 2 sts, 1 hdc in next 3 sts. Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew. Weave in the starting end.

EYES (make 3)

With Friends Cotton yarn, colors Black (124) and White (01) and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2).

Start with Black yarn, make a mr

Round 1: ch1 (does not count as a st), 6 sc in mr. Join with sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 2: ch1, inc in the same st, inc in each st around. Change to color White (see INFO AND TIPS), join with sl st in first st. Cut black yarn. (12 sts)

Round 3: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, *inc, 1 sc in the next st*. Repeat from * to * until there is 1st left. Inc in the last st. Join with sl st in first st (18 sts)

Round 4: ch1, inc in the same st, *1 sc in the next 2 sts, inc*. Repeat from * to * until there are 2 sts left. Work 1 sc in the next 2 sts and join with sl st in first st. (24 sts)

Round 5: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in the next 2 sts *inc, 1 sc in the next 3 sts*. Repeat from * to * until there is 1 st left. Inc in the last st. Instead of working the last sl st, cut the yarn leaving a long tail to sew and work an invisible join (see below) (30 sts)

How to work an invisible join:

After the last st, cut the yarn leaving a long tail to sew. And pull completely the yarn through the last st (images 1 and 2). Insert your crochet in the first st, from back to front (image 3) and pull the yarn through (image 4). Then insert the crochet into the last st from back to



front BUT in the back loop only (image 5) and pull through the yarn. Your join will be invisible and you will have a neat finish. (image 6)



Place the eyes.

ASSEMBLY

1st eye: With the forehead part front of you, from the start of the earflap, count 12 sts to find the middle of the forehead part. Go up counting 9 (10) 10 rows. Place the top of the first eye here and sew it in place.

2nd eye: From the st on the top of the first eye, count 7 sts to the left, go down 1 row. Place the top of the second eye here and sew it in place.

3rd eye: From the st on the top of the first eye, count 7 sts to the right, go down 1 row. Place the top of the second eye here and sew it in place.

Continue with the mouth.

From the bottom of the middle eye, count down 4 rows. Pin here the middle of the mouth. Pin both of the ends of the mouth, one row up from the centre point. The ends of the mouth must be placed just before the middle of the eye above it. If you are happy with the placement, sew the mouth using the strand you've let. Thread the yarn on your darning



needle and pass the needle through the center of each chain to sew, do not tighten too much to keep the volume of the mouth.

Continue with the tongue.

Sew the tongue to the right end of the mouth, below the mouth chains. Sew only the top of the tongue and approx. 0.50" (1 cm) on each side to allow the end of the tongue to lift.

Finish with horns.

With the right side facing you. Fold the right ear flap in two. It will create a line from the earflap bottom to the magic ring. We will sew the horns on this line. Place the horns on top of Rounds 5 to 7 with the curve upwards. The end and the middle of the horns' last round must be on the fold line. Pin them to keep in place and sew them with their yarn tails. Before closing them totally, add stuffing if necessary. It must be firm enough but pay attention that the stuffing doesn't go out.

Of course you are totally free, don't hesitate to place all of this where you want, to create your own funny monster!

BRAIDS

With Friends Wool yarn color Artichoke (110) and all the yarn you used for the horns (63, 40, 30, 24, 91, 100) and hook 4.5 mm (US7)

Cut strands of approx 40 cm in the following amount and yarns:

- 12 strands of Friends Wool yarn color Artichoke
- 4 strands of Friends Cotton 8/4 in each color: Sunflower, Orange, Tomato, Lilac, Aqua, Pastel Green

I divided the colors like this:

2 groups A with 2 Artichoke, 2 Lilac, 2 Tomato

2 groups B with 2 Artichoke, 2 Aqua, 2 Pastel Green

2 groups C with 2 Artichoke, 2 Orange, 2 Sunflower

Take 1 group A. With the hook insert the strands in the first st at the bottom of the first ear flap. Pull the strands to their middle and fold in half. Repeat in the next 2 sts with groups B and C. You have 3 groups of strands. With them, make a braid and use the mini rubber band to secure it.

Repeat for the other ear flap. Cut the strands to even out and weave in the remaining ends.

Well done! Your hat is ready!
