# **Tutti Frutti Lemon**

**Children's Vest**

### **MATERIALS**

### **Friends Extra Fine Merino**

2 (3) 3 (3) 3 skeins of color Rose (44)

1 skein of color Sunflower (24)

1 skein of color Sage (114)

1 skein of color White (01)

Knitting needles 3.5 mm (US 4), 4 mm (US 6)

Circular needles 3.5 mm (US 4) Yarn needle

# YARN QUALITY

Friends Extra Fine Merino, Hobbii 100% Wool

50 g (1.75 oz) = 165 m (180 yds)

### **GAUGE**

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 26 sts x 36 rows

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

st/s = stitch/es

k = knit

p = purl

CO = Cast On

BO = Bind Off

### SIZE

2 (4) 6 (8) 10 yrs

# **MEASUREMENTS**

Width:

31 (34) 37 (40) 43 cm / 12.2" (13.3") 14.5" (15.7") 16.9"

Length:

30 (33) 36 (40) 42 cm / 11.8" (12.9") 14.1" (15.7") 16.5"

### PATTERN INFORMATION

Add color and fun to your little one's outfit with this juicy vest!

It is perfect for spring as well as for cooler summer evenings.

The vest is easy to make, but you should have the basics of knitting intarsia patterns.

# **Pattern**







### **INFO AND TIPS**

The vest consists of two parts, front and back, sewn together at the end.

The strands should always be crossed on the wrong side and stretched enough to avoid holes.

Stitches used in the pattern:

- rib stitch: knit 2, purl 2
- stockinette stitch: knit on the right side, purl on the wrong side

### **BODY**

# **FRONT PIECE**

On the knitting needles 3.5 mm, CO 80 (88) 96 (104) 112 sts with yarn in color 44. Knit 8 (12) 12 (10) 10 rows in rib stitch.

Change to 4 mm needles, and work 10 (14) 20 (10) 10 rows in stockinette stitch. In the next row, start to insert the Lemon #1 pattern following the chart below.

All sections should be made of separate threads, crossing them on the wrong side of the piece to avoid holes.

Work:

**44 (54) 62 (60) 65** sts in color **44**, **7** sts in color **01**, **27 (27) 27 (37) 40** sts in **44**.

### SIZE 2 (4) 6 years

Continue with the Lemon #1 pattern for another 58 rows.

After finishing the lemon pattern, work with the background color 16 (16) 20 more rows. In the next row, start working the neckline, BO the middle 24 (28) 30 sts, then, on both sides, in every other row BO: 3, 2, 1 st/s. After finishing the neckline, work the remaining sts on the shoulders through 16 (17) 18 more rows. BO the remaining sts. Fasten off.

### SIZE 8 (10) years

Continue with the Lemon #1 pattern, after finishing it, work 2 more rows with the background color.

In the next row, start working the Lemon #2 pattern.



Work:

27 (32) sts in color 44, 9 sts in color 01, 68 (71) sts in 44.

Continue with the Lemon #2 pattern for another 36 rows.

After finishing it, work with the background color 8 (10) more rows.

In the next row, start working the neckline, BO the middle 30 sts, then, on both sides, in every other row BO: 4, 3, 2 sts. After finishing the neckline, work the remaining sts on the shoulders through 10 (15) more rows. BO the remaining sts. Fasten off.

### **BACK PIECE**

Work it through just like the front piece.

If you want, you can make the back of the vest plain, without the lemon motif.

### **FINISHING**

Sew shoulders with mattress stitch on the wrong side.

On the circular needles 3.5 mm pick up sts around the formed head opening, and work 6 (6) 8 (8) 8 rows in rib stitch. Fasten off.

On the circular needles 3.5 pick up 70 (70) 80 (140) 140 sts around the armhole, and work 6 (all sizes) rows in rib stitch. Fasten off.

Repeat on the other side.

Sew the sides of the vest and weave all ends.


Using a needle and white yarn, embroider the center of the lemons.
