MATERIALS

1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/8 color 114
1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/8 color 108

Crochet hook 4 mm / US G-6
Tapestry needle
Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/8**, Hobbii
100 % Cotton
50 g / 1.75 oz = 75 m / 82 yds

GAUGE

15 sts x 18 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

MR = magic ring
ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
inc = increase
dec = decrease

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 25 / 9.8"
Length: 45 / 17.7"

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Gemini bag is a *beginner-friendly* crochet project. It is designed with a charming duality, representing the essence of the Gemini zodiac sign. When the two twin pieces are brought together, they create a seamless and cohesive bag. The duality of the Gemini bag goes beyond its structure. It portrays the versatile nature of the Gemini personality, allowing you to style it in multiple ways. You only need a 4 mm hook and two colors of yarn, your choice!

INFO AND TIPS

You can make the strap longer by repeating row 23 and 24 at the end of the body piece.

BODY (MAKE 2)

MR

Row 1: Ch 3, dc 6

Row 2: ch3, turn, dc in the first stitch (under the ch 3), inc 6 (you must make the last inc in the third chain of row 1)

Row 3: ch 3, turn, dc in the first stitch (under the ch 3), dc , (inc, dc) x6

Row 4: ch 3, turn, dc in the first stitch (under the ch 3), dc 2, (inc, dc 2) x6

Row 5: ch 3, turn, dc in the first stitch (under the ch 3), dc 3, (inc, dc 3) x6

Row 6: ch 3, turn, dc in the first stitch (under the ch 3), dc 4, inc, dc 4, make 3 dc in the next stitch, dc 13, make 3 dc in the next stitch, dc 4, inc, dc 4, inc

Row 7: ch 3, turn, dc in the first stitch (under the ch 3), dc 5, inc, dc 5, inc, dc, inc, dc 13, inc, dc, inc, dc 5, inc, dc 5, inc

Row 8: ch 3, turn, dc in the first stitch (under the ch 3), dc 6, inc, dc 6, inc, dc, inc, dc, inc, dc 13, inc, dc, inc, dc, inc, dc 6, inc, dc 6, inc

Row 9: ch 3, turn, dc in the first stitch (under the ch 3), dc 7, inc, dc 7, inc, dc 2, inc, dc 2, inc, dc 15, inc, dc 2, inc, dc 2, inc, dc 7, inc, dc 7, inc

Row 10: ch 1, sc 36 on the flat part of your project. We will now work on the height and the strap of the bag.

Row 11: ch 3, turn, dc 36

Row 12: ch 1, turn, sc 36

Row 13: ch 3, turn, dc 16, dec

Row 14: ch 1, turn, skip first stitch, sc 16

Row 15: ch 3, turn, dc 14, dec

Row 16: ch 1, turn, skip first stitch, sc 14

Row 17: ch 3, turn, dc 12, dec

Row 18: ch 1, turn, skip first stitch, sc 12

Row 19: ch 3, turn, dc 10, dec

Row 20: ch 1, turn, skip first stitch, sc 10

Row 21: ch 3, turn, dc 8, dec

Row 22: ch 1, turn, sc 9

Row 23: ch 3, turn, dc 9

Repeat row 22 and 23 until you get to row 46. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

ASSEMBLE

Block both of your pieces by pinning your project on a blocking surface. To help your stitches set, mist your project with water and let it dry overnight.

With a tapestry needle, sew the end of both straps together. Align both of your pieces one on top of the other with stitch markers and make sure they are even.

To sew both pieces together I like to do the “Mattress stitch”, this makes an invisible seam. The process involves inserting the crochet hook under both loops of the edge stitches of each piece and pulling the yarn through, alternating between the two pieces.

Turn your work inside out and your Gemini bag is ready!
