## MATERIALS

Col. A: 1 (1, 2, 2, 2, 2) skein(s) of Kind
Feather, col. Camel (23)
Col. B: 1 (1, 1, 2, 2, 2) skeins of Kind
Feather, col. Light Green (21)
Col. C: 1 (1, 1, 1,1, 1 ) skein of Kind Feather, col. Light Pink (10)
Col. D: 1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 2) skein(s) of Kind Feather, col. Dark Green (22)
Col. E: 1 (1,1,1,1,1) skein of Kind Feather, col. Lavender (12)

Crochet hook 6 mm (US J/10)

## YARN QUALITY

## (63) Kind Feather, Hobbii

100\% Premium Acrylic
$100 \mathrm{~g}=235 \mathrm{~m}$

## GAUGE

See size chart

## ABBREVIATIONS

sl st = slip stitch
ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
sc2tog = 2 sc crochet together (insert your hook in next st, yarn over, pull through, insert your hook in next st, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 3 loops)

## SIZE

$S(M, L, X L, X X L, X X X L)$

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: $80(88,98,104,112,120) \mathrm{cm} / 15.7$
(17.3", 18.9", 20.5", 22", 23.6")

Length (approx.): 38 (42, 46, 48, 50, 52) cm / 15" (16.5", 18", 18.9", 19.7", 20.5")

## PATTERN INFORMATION

The Woodstock crop top is made from 5 pentagons joined together. The fit is tight and the length is cropped. Extra length can easily be added. Play around with your favorite colors to create a personal look.
The pattern is suitable for the intermediate crocheter.

## INFO AND TIPS

## How to find your size

Measure the fullest part of your chest, subtract 8 and divide by $4=$ Pentagon size. If you are between sizes, size down for a more fitted look or up for a looser fit.

## Size chart

## PENTAGON PATTERN

Crochet 5 in total

## All sizes

With color E ch-5, join with sl st to the 1st ch
Round 1 (col. E): ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc into the circle, ch-1, * 3 dc in the circle, ch-1 **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 2 (col. E): sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3, cut off the yarn

Round 3 (col. B): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next space, 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next space **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 4 (col. D): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 2 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 2 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 5 (col. C): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 3 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 3 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 6 (col. B): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 4 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 4 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

From here on follow the description according to the size you are making:

## Size S

Round 7 (col. A): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Size S proceed to JOINING

## Size M

Round 7 (col. A): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 8 (col. A): sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 6 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 6 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Size M proceed to JOINING

## Size L

Round 7 (col. D): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch $-1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 8 (col. A): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 6 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 6 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 9 (col. A): sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 7 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch $-1,3$ dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 7 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-

Size L proceed to JOINING

## Size XL

Round 7 (col. D): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 8 (col. C): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 6 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch $-1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the same space, 3 dc in next 6 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 9 (col. A): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 7 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch $-1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the same space, 3 dc in next 7 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 9 (col. A): sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 8 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch $-1,3$ dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 8 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Size XL proceed to JOINING

## Size XXL

Round 7 (col. D): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 8 (col. C): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 6 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 6 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 9 (col. B): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 7 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 7 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 10 (col. A): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 8 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 8 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 11 (col. A): sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 9 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 9 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Size XXL proceed to JOINING

## Size XXXL

Round 7 (col. D): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 5 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 8 (col. C): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 6 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 6 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 9 (col. B): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 7 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 7 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 10 (col. D): sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 8 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 8 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 11 (col. A): Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 9 spaces, 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 9 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 12 (col. A): sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-1 space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 10 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch- 1 space, ch-1, 3 dc in the same space, 3 dc in next 10 spaces **, repeat from * to ** 3 times, join with sl st to top of ch-3

## JOINING

## Back piece

(col. A) Lay 2 pentagons together with wrong sides out and slip stitch through both corners (from the bottom) Insert your hook into the next stitch through both pentagons, and slip stitch through them. Repeat until the end of the row. Fasten off.

Place a third pentagon on top of the two you just joined (see photo) and slip stitch it together with the two, starting from one of the corners.


## Front piece

(col. A) Lay 2 pentagons together with wrong sides out and slip stitch through both corners (from the bottom). Insert your hook into the next stitch through both pentagons, and slip stitch through them. Repeat until the end of the row. Fasten off.

## Joining of back and front

(col. A) Lay the back and front on top of eachother with wrong sides out. Slip stitch the sides together.

## SHOULDER STRAPS

Connect yarn col. A to the top of the front pentagon and crochet sc in the dc before ch-1 space, sc in the ch-1 space, sc in next dc (3 sc):

Work $23(27,31,35,39,43)$ rows or until desired length. Try the top on to find the right length.

Connect the strap to the back part by sl sts.
Crochet the 2nd shoulder strap in the same way.

## NECKLINE, ARMHOLES

Round 1 (col. A): connect the yarn to any dc of the neckline (or armholes), ch-1 (don't count as a stitch), sc in each st around, join with sl st to the 1st sc
Round 2-3 (col. A): ch-1 (doesn't count as a stitch), * sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ in next 2 sc **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to the 1st sc

## BOTTOM

NOTE: the number of spaces must be a multiple of 2

Round 1 (col. A): connect the yarn to any space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, 3 dc in each space around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 2-6 (col. A): sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, 3 dc in each space around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

NB: For a longer fit repeat round 2 until desired length is reached. Be aware that you may need more yarn for a longer top.

Round 7 (col. B): change the color of the yarn to any space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, 3 dc in each space around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 8 (col. C): change the color of the yarn to any space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, 3 dc in each space around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 9 (col. D): change the color of the yarn to any space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, 3 dc in each space around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 10 (col. B): change the color of the yarn to any space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, 3 dc in each space around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 11 (col. E): change the color of the yarn to any space, ch-3 (counts as a stitch), 2 dc in the same space, 3 dc in each space around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 12 (col. E): sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next space, ch-1 (doesn't count as a stitch), sc in the same space, 5 dc in next space, * sc in next space, 5 dc in next space **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to the 1st sc
