MATERIALS


2 skeins of Friends Kid Silk colour 02
2 skeins of Friends Kid Silk colour 31
2 skeins of Friends Kid Silk colour 47
1 skein of Friends Wheel colour 04
1 skein of Friends Wheel colour 17
1 skein of Friends Wheel colour 54


Crochet hook 4 mm (US G/6)

Yarn needle

Scissors

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Kid Silk**, Hobbii
72% Mohair, 25% Silk, 3% Wool
25 g (0.9 oz) = 200 m (218 yds)

 **Friends Wheel**, Hobbii
55 % Cotton, 45% Acrylic
100 g (3.5 oz) = 400 m (437 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 16 sts x 14 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

tr = treble crochet

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 28 cm / 11"

Length: 200 cm / 78.7"

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Valencia scarf will make you feel the joy and warmth of this Mediterranean city.

The scarf is made by crocheting a long rectangle. Then, a wavy border is added to make it more special.

The design represents the element "fire". It is inspired by the beautiful night of the Cremá in las Fallas, a traditional festivity in Valencia.

During that night, beautiful and huge sculptures made of combustible materials are burned down. The streets of Valencia see all different colours and feel the joy of the festivity through fire.

INFO AND TIPS

The Valencia scarf consists of one panel: a long rectangle that is crocheted back and forth. Once finished, a wavy border is added on both ends.

The main rectangle and the edging are worked with two strands of yarn held together: one strand of Friends Wheel and one strand of Friends Kid Silk.

The scarf is crocheted using three colour combinations. Each colour combination is achieved by working with one strand of Friends Wheel and one strand of Friends Kid Silk held together. These are the combinations:

- Colour A: Friends Wheel 04 (Cream) and Friends Kid Silk 02 (Off White)
- Colour B: Friends Wheel 54 (Pink Berry Smoothie) and Friends Kid Silk 47 (Pink)
- Colour C: Friends Wheel 17 (Cognac) and Friends Kid Silk 31 (Pumpkin)

The scarf is mostly crocheted using a repetition of single crochet and double crochet. When working in the long rectangle, the main piece of the scarf, turning chains count as the first stitch in each row from row 2. It can be a good idea to place a stitch marker in the turning chain in each row to remember crocheting in it at the end of the following row.

The border is worked using treble crochet and single crochet to create the waves.

Instructions to make the stitches:

- Single crochet: insert the hook in the stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop. Yarn over and pull through two loops on the hook.
- Double crochet: yarn over, insert the hook in the stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop. Yarn over and pull through two loops on the hook. Yarn over and pull through the two last loops on the hook.
- Treble crochet: yarn over twice, insert the hook in the stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop. Yarn over and pull through two loops on the hook. Yarn over and pull through two

loops on the hook. Yarn over once again and pull through the last two loops on the hook.

GAUGE

The gauge is 10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 16 sts x 14 rows.



To test your gauge, crochet a swatch of 23 stitches x 20 rows

Ch 24

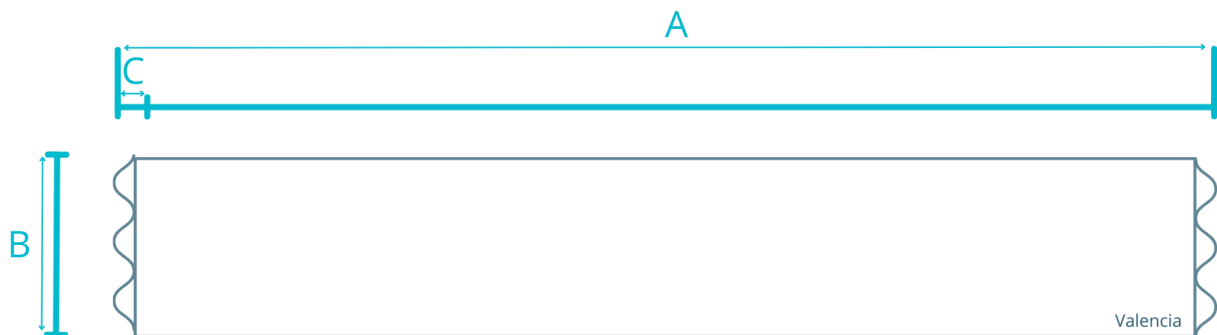
Row 1: 1 sc in the second ch from the hook, 22 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1 and turn (count as 1 st). 1 dc. [Skip 1 st. (1 sc, 1 dc) in next st] 10 times. Skip 1 st. 1 sc.

Repeat row 2 until row 20.

Measure a 10 cm / 4" square in the centre of the swatch. You should have 16 sts x 14 rows.

MEASUREMENTS



		One size
A	Width	28 cm 11"
B	Length (Border included)	200 cm 78.7"
C	Border	2.5 cm 1"

SCARF RECTANGLE



Crochet back and forth. Start crocheting with **Colour A**.

Ch 46

Row 1: 1 sc in the second ch from the hook, 44 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1 and turn (count as 1 sc). 1 dc. [Skip 1 st. (1 sc, 1 dc) in next st] 21 times. Skip 1 st. 1 sc.

Repeat row 2 until row 31. Change to **Colour B**.

Row 32: Ch 1 and turn (count as 1 st). 1 dc. [Skip 1 st, (1 sc, 1 dc) in next st] 21 times. Skip 1 st. 1 sc.

Repeat row 32 until row 61. Change to **Colour C**.

Row 62: Ch 1 and turn (count as 1 st). 1 dc. [Skip 1 st, (1 sc, 1 dc) in next st] 21 times. Skip 1 st. 1 sc.

Repeat row 62 until row 91. Change to **Colour A**.

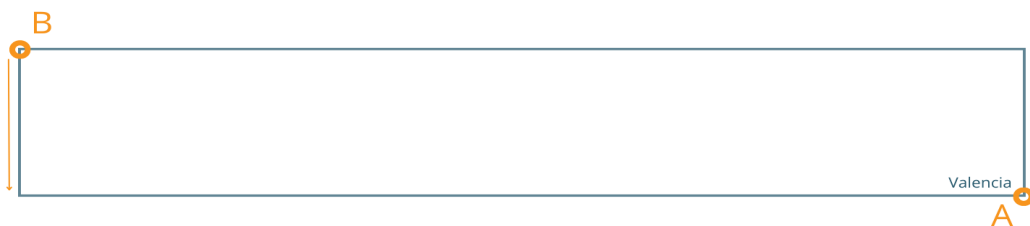
Repeat rows 2 to 91 until row 271. Do not forget to change the colour every 30 rows, that is when you finish rows 31, 61 and 91. *Note that you finish with colour C.* Do not fasten off at the end of row 271. Continue in "Border" section.

Have a look at the following chart to see the colour stripes.

Row number	1-31	32-61	62-91	92-121	122-151	152-181	182-211	212-241	242-271
Colour	A	B	C	A	B	C	A	B	C

Note: if you prefer a longer or shorter scarf, work following the repetitions and colour sequence indicated until you get the desired length.

BORDER



Border at the end of the scarf

Continue where you finished (A). Work with **colour C**.

Row 1: ch 1 and turn (does not count as a sc). 45 sc.

Row 2: ch 1 and turn (does not count as a sc). [1 sc, skip 1 st, (5 tr) in next st, skip 1 st] 11 times. 1 sc. Fasten off.

Border at the beginning of the scarf

Work with **colour A**. Insert the yarn in the corner of the opposite end of the rectangle (B), where you started the ch at the very beginning of the pattern. Ch 1 (does not count as a sc).

Row 1: 45 sc.

Row 2: ch 1 and turn (does not count as a sc). [1 sc, skip 1 st, (5 tr) in next st, skip 1 st] 11 times. 1 sc. Fasten off.
