



CROCHET PATTERN

Trio

Basket with 3 compartments

MATERIALS

2 skeins of Bungee Mini, color 06

Crochet hook I-9 / 5.5 mm

Basket bottom with multiple compartments -
14.4 in x 5.2 in / 36.7 cm x 13.3 cm

Large darning needle with blunt tip

YARN QUALITY

 **Bungee Mini**, Hobbii

42% Cotton, 58% Polyester

200 g (7.1 oz) = 62 m (66 yds)

GAUGE

8 sts x 7 rnds in hdc = 4 x 4 in / 10 x 10 cm

ABBREVIATIONS

ch: chain

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

hdc: half double crochet

rnd: round

beg: beginning

SIZE

Length: 14.4 in / 36.7 cm

Width: 5.2 in / 13.3 cm

Height: approx. 3.1 in / 8 cm

PATTERN INFORMATION

First crochet the two dividers. Then crochet 1 round of single crochets around the edge. The basket is crocheted in a spiral by working half double crochets. Finally, the dividers are sewn to the sides of the basket.

INFO

See images and instructions at the end of the pattern.

Start by working the two dividers.

Then work single crochets through the holes in the edge of the bottom.

Continue around in a spiral working half double crochets forming a simple chain pattern on the outside.

Sew the dividers to the basket.

If necessary, cut/remove a bit of the white filling before weaving in the ends.

PATTERN

Dividers

Hold the yarn behind the bottom, pull the yarn through the hole where the divider meets the edge (1 loop on the hook), pull the yarn through the next hole (2 loops on the hook) and pull it through the first one = 1 loop on the hook.

See images 1-11 for instructions.

1st row: Work the following in each hole. Yarn over and pull through = last st on the row.

Work back into the stitches.

Ch 1.

2nd row: 1 sc in every st = 10 sts.

Turn each row with a ch 1.

Crochet sc until the work measures approx. 3.1 in / 8 cm.

Weave in ends.

Work the other divider in the same way.

Basket sides

Start in a hole where the divider meets the edge = beg of rnd.

Hold the yarn behind the bottom, pull the yarn through the hole and work 1 sc. Work 1 sc in each hole while working 2 sc in each corner = 76 stitches.

See images 12-17 for instructions.

1st rnd: Work 1 hdc in the first st, work 1 hdc in every st but only in the back loop.
 2nd rnd: Work 1 hdc in every st forming a simple chain pattern on the outside of the basket.
 Continue working in a spiral with hdc until the work is approx. 2.8 in / 7 cm in height.
 Next rnd: Work until 3 sts before the beg of the rnd, work 2 sc, 1sl st.
 Weave in ends.

Sew the dividers to the basket edges.

Weave in ends with a large, blunt needle.






If necessary, cut/remove a bit of the white filling before weaving in the ends.






Images and instructions


First, the two dividers are worked (photos 1-11), then you work in a spiral until the desired height is achieved.

		
<p>1) Pull the yarn through the outermost hole of the divider. The working yarn is behind the work.</p>	<p>2) Pull the working yarn through the next hole.</p>	<p>3) and pull it through the loop on the hook = 1 slip stitch.</p>
		
<p>4) Continue like this along the row.</p>	<p>5) Yarn over, pull it through and ch 1.</p>	<p>6) Place the hook under the first stitch.</p>

		
<p>7) Work 1 single crochet.</p>	<p>8) Work 1 sc in every stitch.</p>	<p>9) Ch 1 and turn.</p>
		
<p>10) Work until the desired height.</p>	<p>11) Work the other divider in the same way.</p>	<p>12) Turn the bottom upside down to work the edge. Pull the yarn through.</p>
		
<p>13) Work 1 sc.</p>	<p>14) Work 1 sc in every hole.</p>	<p>15) Work 2 sc in all corners.</p>



16) Finish the round.



17) Work 1 hdc in the first st.



18) Continue the round working hdc.
