

**CROCHET PATTERN**

## **MATERIALS**

Yarn A: 1 skein of Ribbon colour 51
Yarn B: 1 skein of Ribbon colour 2

Crochet hook 6 mm (US H/9)

# **YARN QUALITY**

**Ribbon**, Hobbii 100 % Cotton 250 g (8.8 oz) = 125 m (137 yds)

# **GAUGE**

 $10 \text{ cm} \times 10 \text{ cm} (4'' \times 4'') = 11 \text{ dc} \times 6 \text{ rows}$ 

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
sl st = slip stitch
dc = double crochet
hdc = half double crochet
inc = increase, 2 sts in the same st

#### SIZE

One size

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 20 cm / 7.9"

Height: 19 cm / 7.5" without handles

# **Pattern**







#### **INFO AND TIPS**

Keep tension tight and even throughout to keep sides rigid. If you want a bigger basket, repeat rounds until desired size.

# **BASE**

Work in the round.

**Round 1:** Using yarn A create a magic circle

Ch 2, 12 dc into the circle, sl st to first dc to join

Secure magic circle (12 dc)

**Round 2:** Ch 2, inc in each stitch around, sl st to first dc to join (24 dc)

**Round 3:** Ch 2, \*inc, 1 dc\* repeat \*\* to end, sl st to first dc to join (36 dc)

**Round 4:** Ch 2, \*inc, 2 dc\* repeat \*\* to end, sl st to first dc to join (48 dc)

**Round 5:** Ch 2, \*inc, 3 dc\* repeat \*\* to end, sl st to first dc to join (60 dc)

#### **SIDES**

Continue in the round. Carry the yarn that is not in use up each row. If you want a taller basket, repeat rounds until desired size.

**Round 1:** Using yarn B. Ch 2, dc in same stitch and dc 3rd loop only to end, sl st to first dc to join (60 dc)

**Round 2:** Ch 2, dc in same stitch and dc to end. Now change colour, put hook through dc and yarn over using yarn A, pull through both loops (60 dc)



**Round 3:** Continue in yarn A. Ch 2, dc in same stitch and dc to end, sl st to first dc to join (60 dc)

**Round 4:** Ch 2, dc in same stitch and dc to end. Now change colour, put hook through dc and yarn over using yarn B, pull through both loops (60 dc)

**Round 5:** Continue in yarn B. Ch 2, dc in same stitch and dc to end, sl st to first dc to join (60 dc)

**Rounds 6-10:** Repeat rounds 2-5 until round 10. Finishing on round 2.

# **HANDLES**

**Round 1:** Continue in yarn A. Ch 2, hdc in same stitch and hdc until end, sl st to first hdc to join (60 hdc)

**Round 2:** Ch 2, hdc in same stitch, 2 hdc, \*ch 14 and skip 14 sts, hdc in next st\*, 16 hdc, repeat \*\*, 12 hdc and sl st to first hdc. (34 hdc)

**Round 3:** Ch 1, sc in same st, 2 sc, \*14 sc evenly over ch\*, 16 sc, repeat \*\*, 13 sc and sl st to first sc. Tie off and sew in the ends.
