Puki

Kids Sweater

MATERIALS

Portobello

2 (3) 5 (7) skeins of color Light Purple (68)

1 (1) 1 (1) skein of color Nougat (09)

1 (1) 1 (1) skein of color Wild Berry (56)

Knitting needles 4.5 mm (US 7)

Circular needles 4 mm (US 6)

Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Portobello**, Hobbii

60% Cotton, 28% Acrylic, 12% Wool

50 g (1.75 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 21 sts x 32 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

st/sts = stitch/es

k = knit

p = purl

CO = cast on

BO = bind off

SIZE

2 yrs (4 yrs) 6 yrs (8 yrs)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 33 (37) 42 (45) cm / 12.9" (14.5") 16.5"

Length: 32 (36) 40 (45) cm / 12.5" (14.1") 15.7"

Sleeve length: 25 (27) 32 (36) / 9.8" (10.6") 12.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Super cute and adorable little sweater, with a loose fit. The sweater is made in separate parts - a back piece, a front piece and two sleeves.

The parts are sewed together at the end and the neck edge is added.

The mouse motive is made with a diagram.

This is a great pattern to start with if you are new to intarsia and diagram knitting.

INFO AND TIPS

The sweater is made of separate parts sewn together at the end.

When changing the colors, cross the threads on the wrong side of the piece.

Stitches used in the pattern:

- rib stitch- k2, p2,
- stockinette stitch- purl in odd rows, knit in even rows.

BODY

FRONT PIECE

With 4 mm circular needles and col. 68 CO 60 (70) 80 (87) sts.

Work 5 (7) 9 (12) rows in rib stitch k2, p2. In the next, last row of the rib, increase evenly 8 stitches (all sizes).

Change to 4,5 mm needles and work 6 (10) 12 (14) rows in stockinette stitch.

In the next row start to work the mouse pattern:

Work the first 20 (26) 32 (38) sts in col. 68, then 5 sts in 09 and to the end of the row in col. 68.

Continue to work following the mouse pattern.

When you finish the mouse, work with the background color 40 (46) 56 (68) more rows.

In the next row, start to work the neckline. BO the middle 15 (20) 20 (25) sts, then on both sides of the neckline, in every other row 3 sts, 2 sts, and 1 st. BO the remaining sts on the shoulders in the 103rd (115th) 129th (144th) row counting from the beginning of the work.

BACK PIECE

Make the back the same way as the front but without the mouse pattern.

Start to work the neckline in the 45th (51st) 61st (71st) row. BO the remaining sts on the shoulders in the 103rd (115th) 129th (144th) row counting from the beginning of the work.

SLEEVES

With 4 mm needles CO 30 (34) 38 (42) sts in col. 68.

Work 6 (8) 10 (12) rows in rib stitch k2, p2. In the next last row of the rib, increase evenly 6 stitches (all sizes).

When you finish the rib, change to 4,5 mm needles and start to work in stockinette stitch increasing 1 st on both sides of the sleeve in every 5th row. Work this way 74 (78) 92 (102) rows of stockinette stitch, BO all the stitches.

FINISHING

Sew the front and back pieces together on the shoulders.

With circular needles 4 mm pick up sts around the head opening and work 4 (6) 6 (8) rows in rib stitch, BO sts. Sew the sleeves to the sweater and then sew the sides of the sleeves and of the sweater.

Finish the mouse by embroidering the tail with a stalk stitch and the paws with a chain stitch. Embroider the whiskers and eyes.
