# Musu

## Sweater

**Design: Knit Gang** | Hobbii Design

## MATERIALS

### Friends Wool


4 (5) 5 (6) skeins of Chocolate (12)  
4 (5) 5 (6) skeins of Hint of Pink (50)  
2 (3) 3 (4) skeins of Cornflower (83)


### Friends Kid Silk

2 (2) 3 (4) skeins of Chocolate (12)  
2 (2) 3 (4) skeins of Hint of Pink (50)  
1 (1) 2 (3) skeins of Cornflower (83)

Knitting needles 5 mm (US 9) and 6 mm (US 10)  
Circular needles 5 mm (US 9)  
Tapestry needle for sewing

## YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii  
100% Wool  
50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

 **Friends Kid Silk**, Hobbii  
72% Mohair, 25% Silk, 3% Wool  
25 g (0.9 oz) = 200 m (218 yds)

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 16 sts x 23 rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit  
p = purl  
yo = yarn over  
bs = bobble stitch  
CO = cast on  
BO = bind off  
inc = increase

## SIZE

S (M) L (XL)

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 58 (63) 68 (73) cm / 22.8 (24.8) 26.7 (28.8)"  
Length: 48 (50) 55 (60) cm / 18.8" (19.6) 21.6 (23.6)"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Absolutely gorgeous, soft, loose sweater in a slightly retro style.

Thanks to the yarn used, it is very squishy and warm, and because of its design, it goes perfectly with both pants and skirts.

The Musu sweater is knitted in four separate pieces. A front, back and two sleeves. The pieces are worked back and forth in stockinette stitch and are sewn together in the end. You pick up stitches for the rib edge in the neck opening.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

The sweater is made from one strand of Friends Wool and one strand of Friends Kid Silk held together.

Stitches used in the pattern:

**Rib stitch:** k2, p2.

**Stockinette stitch:** k on the right side, p on the wrong side.

**Bobble stitch:**

make 5 sts from 1 st (k, yo, k, yo, k), turn your work

purl these 5 sts, turn your work

knit these 5 sts, turn your work

purl these 5 sts, turn your work

knit these 5 sts together.

## FRONT PIECE

With 5 mm knitting needles CO 94 (102) 110 (118) sts in col. 12. Work 10 rows in rib stitch.

Change to 6 mm needles and work 26 (26) 32 (38) rows in stockinette stitch.

In the next row, you will insert the col. 83. Work 42 (50) 58 (66) sts in col. 12 and all the remaining sts to the end of the row in col. 83.

You will continue joining colors for the next 44 rows (all sizes), that is until the bobble pattern is finished. Change col. 12 to col. 50 in the 49<sup>th</sup> (49<sup>th</sup>) 53<sup>rd</sup> (64<sup>th</sup>) row counting from the beginning of the stockinette stitch. After completing the bobble pattern in col. 83, continue to the end in col. 50.

In the 31<sup>st</sup> (33<sup>rd</sup>) 39<sup>th</sup> (49<sup>th</sup>) row of col. 50, BO 26 (30) 30 (30) sts for the neckline, then BO 4 x 1 st in every other row. Continue working the shoulder sts to the 55<sup>th</sup> (57<sup>th</sup>) 63<sup>rd</sup> (69<sup>th</sup>) row of col. 50.

BO sts on the shoulders.

## BACK PIECE

Work the back piece symmetrically to the front, so that the bobble pattern in col. 83 is on the same side.

BO sts for the neckline in the 53rd (55<sup>th</sup>) 61<sup>st</sup> (67<sup>st</sup>) row. Continue working the shoulder sts to the 55<sup>th</sup> (57<sup>th</sup>) 63<sup>rd</sup> (69<sup>th</sup>) row of col. 50.

BO sts on the shoulders.

## SLEEVES

With the 5 mm needles CO 38 (42) 46 (48) sts with col. 12. Work 12 rows with rib stitch.

Change to 6 mm needles and work 4 rows in stockinette stitch. In the next row inc 1st on both sides, then to the end of the sleeve, inc on each side 1st in each 6th row.

Work 43 (45) 50 (55) rows in col. 12, then 28 (30) 30 (30) rows in col. 50.

Make a second sleeve in the same way.

## FINISHING

Sew the shoulders together with a mattress stitch. With circular needles 5 mm pick up all sts around the head opening. Work 8 rows in rib stitch. Sew the sleeves to the sweater, and then the sides of the sweater and of the sleeves. Secure all cut ends.
