MATERIALS

Hobbii Rainbow Sock Wool 4-ply

1 skein of colour 23 (Colour 1) 1 skein of colour 3 (Colour 2)

Circular needle 2.5 mm (US 1.5), 80 cm (31.5") or Double pointed needles 2.5 mm (US 1.5)

YARN QUALITY

Rainbow Sock Wool 4-ply, Hobbii
 75 % Wool, 25 % Polyamide
 50g (1.75 oz) = 210 m (229 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 36 sts x 44 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit
P = Purl
SSK = Slip two stitches and knit together
K2TOG = Knit two stitches together
M1 = make 1 (increase)

SIZE

EU 36/37 (38/39, 40/41, 42/43), called size 1 (2, 3, 4) in the pattern

MEASUREMENTS

Foot circumference: (7) 8 (9) 10" / (18) 20 (23) 25.5 cm

Socks should be worn with 1-2 inches / 2-4 cm of negative ease. Take your foot measurement at its widest point and select the size that fits best. If there is stitch count that doesn't give the required fit you can always go up or down a needle size if you prefer socks more snug.

PATTERN INFORMATION

This is the perfect Sock pattern to get you into sock knitting. This pattern is easily customisable to fit your feet. You can adjust the foot length and the leg length to get the best fit. With Hobbii's range of colours there are endless possibilities.

The sock is knitted from top to toe with a small rib at the top and an afterthought heel.

INFO AND TIPS

This pattern is knit from the top down so you can try the socks on as you go to get the perfect fit.

CUFF

Rib edge

In colour 1, cast on (48) 56 (64) 72 sts on double pointed needles or circular needles in the magic loop method, place a stitch marker to mark the beginning of the round. Arrange stitches so you have (24) 28 (32) 36 on each needle if you use circular needles and (12) 14 (16) 18 sts on each of the four needles if you use double pointed needles.

Knit in 1x1 rib until the piece measures 2.5cm / 1 inch from cast on. If you would prefer a longer edge knit as many rounds as desired.

Decrease/increase for the following sizes 2 and 3. For sizes 1 and 4 continue to knit chart A.

Size 2: *K1, K2tog, Knit 25* repeat from * to *, you will have 54 stitches on your needles. Continue to knit chart A.

Size 3: *K1, M1, Knit 30* repeat from * to *, you will have 66 stitches on your needles. Continue to knit chart A.

For sizes 2 and 3 once you have knit chart A continue as follows.

Size 2: *K1, M1, Knit 25* repeat from * to *, you will have 56 stitches on your needles.

Size 3: *K1, K2tog, Knit 30* repeat from * to *, you will have 64 stitches on your needles.


Continue to knit until desired leg length or 2 inches/5 cm less of leg length as the heel will measure 2 inches/5 cm when complete.




With scrap yarn knit across (24) 28 (32) 36 then turn work and slip stitches back onto right needle. Pick up colour 2 yarn again and knit back across scrap yarn and continue to knit in round.

Knit until 5.5 inches/14cm shorter than desired length. This measurement allows you to take into account the afterthought heel measurement and the toe.

Knit chart B.





TOE

Break colour 2 and knit in colour 1 for the toe.

Round 1: Knit

Round 2: *K1, SSK knit to 3 sts before end of needle (before end of 2nd needle if you work with DPN), K2TOG, K1* repeat from * to * on other needle.

Repeat rounds 1-2 until (8) 10 (10) 10 stitches remain on each needle ((4) 5 (5) 5 sts on each needle if you work with DPN). Close toe with Kitchener stitch and weave in ends.

HEEL

Remove scrap yarn, be careful when you do this so you don't drop any stitches. On each needle pick up the loops that are free from scrap yarn. You should have (24) 28 (32) 36 on each needle. Use colour 1.

Round 1: Knit

Round 2: *K1, SSK knit to 3 sts before end of needle (before end of 2nd needle if you work with DPN), K2TOG, K1* repeat from * to * on other needle.

Repeat rounds 1-2 until (8) 10 (10) 10 stitches remain on each needle ((4) 5 (5) 5 sts on each needle if you work with DPN). Close heel with Kitchener stitch and weave in ends.



FINISHING

Make sure to weave in all ends and gently block socks. This will remove any ridges that have appeared from knitting magic loop. If you have a little hole in each corner where you picked up the afterthought heel, just sew it closed with a piece of the heel colour.
