

## Simple Lines Alpaca - Shawl

## Materials:

Wheel of Alpaca
Crochet hook 5.5 mm

## Buy yarn and supplies here:

Measurements: Approx. $188 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82 \mathrm{~cm}$ ( $74^{\prime \prime} \times 32^{\prime \prime}$ )

## Gauge:

16 stitches x 9 rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}(4$ " $\times 4$ ")
Usage: 1 ball of yarn

## Abbreviations:

ch: chain
MR: magic ring
s: stitch
sc: single crochet
dc: double crochet
tr: triple crochet
ch-sp: chain space

## Note:

The 4 chain stitches at the beginning of each row count as 1 tr .
Pattern: A visual guide can be found at the end of the pattern:

1. Start by making a magic ring. Chain 4 . Crochet 4 dc , chain $2,4 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 tr in the MR.
2. Turn by chaining 4 . Crochet 2 dc in the first stitch. Crochet 1 dc in the next 4 stitches. In the ch-sp, crochet 2 dc , chain $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$. Crochet 1 dc in the next 4 stitches. In the last stitch, crochet 2 dc and 1 tr .
3. Turn your work by chaining 4. Crochet 2 dc in the first stitch. Crochet 1 dc in the next 8 stitches. In the ch-sp, crochet 2dc, chain 2, 2dc. Crochet 1 dc in the next 8 stitches. In the last stitch crochet 2 dc and 1 tr..
4. Turn by chaining 4. Crochet 2 dc in the first stitch. Crochet 1 dc in the next 12 stitches. In the ch-sp, crochet 2 dc , chain $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$. Crochet 1 dc in the next 12 stitches. In the last stitch crochet 2 dc and 1 tr .
5. Turn by chaining 4. Crochet 2 dc in the first stitch. Crochet 1 dc in the next 16 stitches. In the ch-sp crochet 2dc, chain 2, 2dc. Crochet 1 dc in the next 16 stitches. In the last stitch crochet 2 dc and 1 tr.
6. Repeat the instructions until you have 54 rows in total, or until you reach the desired length.


## Finishing rows:

Turn your work by chaining 1. Crochet sc all the way along the sides of the shawl. In the ch-sp, crochet 2 sc . Cut the yarn and weave in the end.


## Visual guide:

## Row 1



1. Start by making a MR. Chain 4. Crochet 4 dc , chain $2,4 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 tr in the MR.

## Row 2



1. Turn by chaining 4. Crochet 2 dc in the first stitch. Here, the hook marks the first stitch.

2. Like this.

3. Crochet 1 dc in the next 4 stitches.

4. Like this

5. In the last stitch crochet 2 dc and 1 tr .

6. In the ch-sp, crochet 2 dc , chain $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$.

7. Crochet 1 dc in the next 4 stitches.

8. Like this.

## Row 3



1. Turn your work by chaining 4. Crochet 2 dc in the first stitch. Here, the hook marks the first stitch.

2. Crochet 1 dc in the next 8 stitches.

3. Crochet 1 dc in the next 8 stitches.

4. Like this.

5. In the ch-sp crochet 2 dc , chain $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$.

6. In the last stitch, crochet 2 dc and 1 tr .

7. Like this.

Row 4


1. Turn your work by chaining 4 . Crochet 2 dc in the first stitch. Crochet 1 dc in the next 12 stitches. In the ch-sp crochet 2dc, chain $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$. Crochet 1 dc in the next 12 stitches. In the last stitch crochet 2 dc and 1 tr .

Row 5


1. Turn your work by chaining 4 . Crochet 2 dc in the first stitch. Crochet 1 dc in the next 16 stitches. In the ch-sp crochet 2dc, chain 2, 2dc. Crochet 1 dc in the next 16 stitches. In the last stitch crochet 2 dc and 1 tr.

## Row 6 and onward



1. Now, repeat the method as described in the pattern.
