# Jack

## Hat

Design: Libère tes mailles | Hobbii Design

## MATERIALS

### Friends Wool:

2 skeins of color Pumpkin (31)

### Friends Cotton 8/4:

1 skein color Jungle Green (111)

1 skein color Black (124)

Crochet hook 4.5 mm / US 7

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2

Scissors

Sewing pins

Stuffing

Darning needle

## YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii

100% wool

50 gr (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii

100 % cotton

50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

## GAUGE

In dc, worked in rounds with Friends Wool and crochet hook 4.5 mm (US7)

14 dc x 11 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

## SIZE

**2-4 years (4-6 years) 6-9 years**

## MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: **19.3 (20) 21.25" / 49 (51) 54 cm**

Length (from neck to forehead):

**13.4 (14) 15" / 34 (36) 38 cm**

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Transform your little one into a funny monster for Halloween or for all the winter season!

Jack Hat is made with Friends Wool, a thick, soft and very elastic yarn which makes it perfect for a hat. The details are worked with friends cotton 8/4 yarn.

The pattern is beginner-friendly.

## ABBREVIATIONS

st = stitch  
ch = chain  
sl st = slip stitch  
sc = single crochet  
dc = double crochet  
fpdc = front post double crochet  
bpdc = back post double crochet  
dc3tog = crochet 3 double crochet together  
blo = back loop only  
inc = crochet 2 sts in the same st  
dec = crochet 2 sts together  
mr = magic ring  
beg = beginning  
yo = yarn over

## INFO AND TIPS

The first part of the hat is worked in rounds, then we will add the earflaps in rows with some decreases and finish with a round of sc to have a neat border. Finally, all the details are crocheted and sewn on the hat.

Ch3 and ch2 at the beginning of the row count as 1 st.  
Ch1 does not count as a st.

## HAT

With Friends Wool yarn color Pumpkin and 4.5 mm hook (US7)

Start with a mr

**Round 1:** Ch3, work 11 dc in the ring, join with sl st to top of ch3. Pull to close the ring and secure it. (12 sts)

**Round 2:** Ch3, \*1 dc in next st, 1 fpdc around the same st, inc in next st\* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st left. Work 1 dc in next st, 1 fpdc around the same st, work 1 dc in the same st where you work the ch3. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (24 sts)

**Round 3:** Ch3, 1 dc in next st, \*1 dc in next st, 1 fpdc around the same st, inc, 1 dc in next 2 sts\* repeat from \* to \* until 2 sts left. Work 1 dc in next st, 1 fpdc around the same st, inc. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (36 sts)

**Round 4:** Ch3, 1 dc in next 2 sts, \*1 dc in next st, 1 fpdc around the same st, inc, 1 dc in next 4 sts\* repeat from \* to \* until 3 sts left. Work 1 dc in next st, 1 fpdc around the same st, inc, 1 dc in next st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (48 sts)

**Round 5:** Ch3, 1 dc in next 3 sts, \*1 dc in next st, 1 fpdc around the same st, inc, 1 dc in next 6 sts\* repeat from \* to \* until 4 sts left. Work 1 dc in next st, 1 fpdc around the same st, inc, 1 dc in next 2 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (60 sts)

#### Size 2-4 years only:

**Round 6:** Ch3, 1 dc in next 4 sts, \*1 fpdc in next st, inc, 1 dc in next 8 sts\* repeat from \* to \* x2. \*1 dc in next st, 1 fpdc around the same st, inc, 1 dc in next 8 sts\* repeat from \* to \* x3, 1 fpdc in next st, inc, 1 dc in next 3 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (69 sts)

#### Size 4-6 years and Size 6-9 years only:

**Round 6:** Ch3, 1 dc in next 4 sts, \*1 dc in next st, 1 fpdc around the same st, inc, 1 dc in next 8 sts\* repeat from \* to \* until 5 sts left. Work 1 dc in next st, 1 fpdc around the same st, inc, 1 dc in next 3 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (72 sts)

#### Size 6-9 years only:

**Round 7:** Ch3, 1 dc in next 5 sts, \*1 fpdc in next st, inc, 1 dc in next 10 sts\* repeat from \* to \* x2. Work \*1 fpdc in next st, 1 dc in next 11 sts\* repeat from \* to \* x2. Work 1 fpdc in next st, inc, 1 dc in next 10 sts, 1 fpdc, inc, 1 dc in next 4 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3 (76 sts)

#### For all sizes:

**Rounds 7 (7) 8 to 14 (16) 18:** Ch3, work 1 dc in each dc and 1 fpbc in each fpdc from previous round. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. Repeat for **8 (10) 11** rounds in total (**69 (72) 76** sts).

Try the hat on your child to check the circumference and the length, 2 rows will be added on the neck.

## EARFLAPS

### First Earflap

From the end of the round, count **22 (24) 25** sts to the right. The first st counted is the st at the right of the ch3. And join Friends Wool yarn on the **22th (24th) 26th** st.

**Tip:** Work over the yarn ends, here and at the end of the hat to avoid weaving ends.

From here you'll work back and forth in rows and ch2 instead of 3 to have a neat edge.

**Row 1:** Ch2, work dc in dc and fpdc in fpdc in the next **43 (48) 49** sts. Turn (**44 (49) 50** sts)

**Row 2:** Ch2, work 1 dec, dc in dc and bpdc in fpdc until 3 sts left. Work 1 dec and 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn (**42 (47) 50** sts)

**Row 3:** Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in the next **1 (2) 1** st(s), 1 fpdc in next st, 1 dc in each st until 3 sts left, 1 dec, 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn. (10 sts)

**Row 4:** Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in the next **3 (2) 3** st, 1 bpdc in next st, 1 dc in the next **0 (1) 0** st, 1 dec, 1dc on top of ch2. Turn. (8 sts)

**Row 5:** Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 fpdc in next st **0 (1) 0** st, 1 dc in the next **2 (1) 2** sts, 1 dec, 1dc on top of ch2. Turn. (6 sts)

**Row 6:** Ch2, work 2 dec, 1dc on top of ch2. Fasten off. (4 sts) Weave in ends.

## Second Earflap

With the right side facing you. Go to the start of Row 2 and insert crochet in the first ch2. Turn to work on the wrong side.

Repeat Rows 3 to 6. **BUT** work fpdc instead of bpdc and bpdc instead of fpdc.

DO NOT fasten off and continue with **Border**.

## Border

Ch1 (does not count as 1st) and work on the right side. Sc all around the hat, work 2 sc in each earflaps' top corners, and 2 sc around each dc and ch2 on the earflaps' sides, and 1 sc in each st. Be sure to don't make too much or not enough sc to avoid ripple or shrink. Weave in ends.

## MOUTH

With Friends cotton yarn, color Black and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2)

Ch39

Work 2 dc in 3rd st from hook, \*1 dc in next 4 sts, dc3tog, 1 dc in next 4 sts, 3 dc in next st\* Repeat from \* to \* twice, 1 dc in next 4 sts, dc3tog, 1 dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in last st. Fasten off, cut the thread leaving a long tail to sew.

## EYES (make 2)

With Friends cotton yarn, color Black and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2).

Ch 8



**Row 1:** ch1 (doesn't count as 1 st), work 1 sc in 2nd st from hook and 1 sc in each ch. (7 sts)

**Row 2:** ch1, turn. Dec, 1 sc in next 3 sts, dec (5 sts)

**Row 3:** ch1, turn. Work 1 sc in each st. (5 sts)

**Row 4:** ch1, turn. Dec, 1 sc in next st, dec (3 sts)

**Row 5:** ch1, turn. Work 1 sc in each st. (3 sts)

**Row 6:** ch 1, turn. \*Insert hook in next st, yo, pull through\* repeat 3 times in total. You now have 4 loops on hook. Yo, pull through all the loops on the hook.

**Border:** do not turn, you will work around the triangle. Work 1 sc in each end row, 2 sc in each corner and 1 sc in each ch from the base. Join with sl st in first st. Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a long tail to sew.

Repeat to make a second eye.

## STEM

With Friends cotton yarn, color Jungle Green and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2).

Make a mr

**Round 1:** ch1, 6 sc in the ring. Join with sl st in 1st st. (6 sts)

**Round 2:** ch1, inc in each st. Join with sl st in 1st st. (12 sts)

**Round 3:** ch1, sc blo in each st around. Join with sl st in 1st st. (12 sts)

**Round 4 to 7:** ch1, sc in each st around. Join with sl st in 1st st. (12 sts)

**Round 8:** ch1, \*1 sc in next st, inc in next st\* repeat from \* to \* around. Join with sl st in 1st st. (18 sts)

**Round 9:** ch1, \*1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st\* repeat from \* to \* around. Join with sl st in 1st st. (24 sts)

**Round 10:** ch1, \*1 sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st\* repeat from \* to \* around. Join with sl st in 1st st. (30 sts)

**Round 11:** ch1, \*1 sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st\* repeat from \* to \* around. Join with sl st in 1st st. (36 sts) Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a long tail to sew.

## CURLS

With Friends cotton yarn, color Jungle Green and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2).

### Curl 1

Ch26.

Start in second st from hook, work 3 sc in each ch. Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a long tail to sew.

### **Curl 2**

Ch 17.

Start in second st from hook, work 4 dc in each ch. Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a long tail to sew.

## **ASSEMBLY**

### **Place the eyes:**

With the forehead part front of you. You will see that you have 2 vertical lines of fpdc. Place the top of the eyes on each fpdc round 7, the bottom must 3 rounds below. Try to center the triangles with the fpdc lines. Pin them and sew.

### **Place the mouth:**

Pin the mouth accentuating the zigzag effect. Try to be symmetrical with the help of the fpdc lines. The top of the mouth is 2 rounds below the eyes, and the bottom is 3 rounds below the top of the mouth.

### **Place the stem:**

Stuff the stem and sew it on top of the hat. Begin to sew the stem around round 7 of the stem. Add stuffing before closing the hole. Sew again around the last round of the stem. Sew the curls on round 7 of the stem.
