Zombinou

Hat

MATERIALS

Friends Wool:

1 skein of color Black (124)

1 skein of color Sage (114)

Friends Cotton 8/4:

1 skein of color 01 (White)

1 skein of color 124 (Black)

Crochet hook 4.5 mm / US 7 Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2 Scissors Sewing pins Stuffing Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Friends Wool, Hobbii 100% wool 50 gr (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100 % cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

In dc, worked in rounds with Friends Wool and crochet hook 4.5 mm (US7)
14 dc x 11 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

SIZE

2-4 years (4-6 years) 6-9 years

MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 19.3 (20) 21.25" / 49 (51) 54 cm Length (from neck to forehead): 13.4 (14) 15" / 34 (36) 38 cm

PATTERN INFORMATION

Transform your little one into a funny monster for Halloween or for all the winter season!

Zombinou Hat is made with Friends Wool, a thick, soft and very elastic yarn which makes it perfect for a hat. The details are worked with friends cotton 8/4 yarn. And the little plus that does it all, both are available in a wide range of colours! Ask your kid and have fun with him choosing the colors for his monster hat.

The pattern is beginner-friendly.

ABBREVIATIONS

st = stitch
ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
blo = back loop only
inc = crochet 2 sts in the same st
dec = crochet 2 sts together
mr = magic ring
beg = beginning
Ldc = long double crochet
VLdc = very long double crochet
yo = yarn over

INFO AND TIPS

The first part of the hat is worked in rounds, then we will add the earflaps in rows with some decreases and finish with a round of sc to have a neat border. Finally, all the details are crocheted and sewn on the hat.


Ch3 and ch2 at the beginning of the row count as 1 st. Ch1 does not count as a st.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Ldc = a long double crochet is a regular dc but instead of insert you hook in the dc of the previous round, you will insert the hook in the stitch 1 round below

VLdc = a very long double crochet is a regular dc but instead of insert you hook in the dc of the previous round, you will insert the hook in the stitch 2 rounds below





HAT

With Friends Wool yarn color Black and 4.5 mm hook (US7)

Start with a mr

Round 1: Ch3, work 11 dc in the ring, join with sl st to top of ch3. Pull to close the ring and secure it. (12 sts)

Round 2: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, inc in each sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (24 sts)

Round 3: Ch3, *inc, 1 dc in next st* repeat from * to * until 1 st left, inc in the last st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (36 sts)

Round 4: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in the next 2 sts, inc in next st* repeat from * to * until 2 sts left, 1 dc in the next 2 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (48 sts)

Round 5: Ch3, 1 dc in the next 2 sts *inc, 1 dc in the next 3 sts* repeat from * to * until 1 st left, inc in the last st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (60 sts)

Size 2-4 years only:

Round 6: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in next 5 sts, (inc, 1 dc in next 6 sts) x 2, inc *. Repeat twice. Work 1 dc in next 5 sts, (inc, 1 dc in next 6 sts) x 2. **Change to color Sage.** Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (69 sts)

Size 4-6 years only:

Round 6: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in the next 4 sts, inc in next st* repeat from * to * until 4 sts left, 1 dc in the next 4 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (72 sts)

Rounds 7-8: Ch3, 1 dc in each sts around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. **Change to color Sage** at the end of round 8. (72 sts, 2 rounds)

Size 6-9 years only:



Round 6: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in the next 4 sts, inc in next st* repeat from * to * until 4 sts left, 1 dc in the next 4 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (72 sts)

Round 7: Ch3, 1 dc in next 7 sts, inc, 1 dc in next 8 sts, inc, *1 dc in next 17 sts, inc*. Repeat 3 times. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (77 sts)

Rounds 8-9: Ch3, 1 dc in each sts around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. **Change to color Sage** at the end of round 9. (77 sts, 2 rounds)

For all sizes:

Round 7 (9) 10: Ch3, 1 dc blo in the next 22 23 26 sts, 1 Ldc in next st, 1 VLdc in next st, 1 dc blo in next 3 sts, 1 Ldc in next st, 1 dc blo in next 3 sts, 1 VLdc in next st, 1 Ldc in next st, 1 dc blo in next 2 sts, 1 Ldc in next 2 sts, 1 dc blo in next 3 sts, 1 Ldc in next st, 1 VLdc in next st, 1 dc blo in next 2 sts, 1 Ldc in next st, 1 VLdc in next st, 1 dc blo in the next 22 24 26 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3 (69 (72) 77 sts)

Rounds 8 (10) 11 to 14 (16) 18: Ch3, 1 dc in each sts around. Fasten off. (69 (72) 77 sts, 7 (7) 7 rounds in total)

Try the hat on your child to check the circumference and the length, 2 rows will be added on the neck.

EARFLAPS

First Earflap

From the end of the round, count **22** (**24**) **25** sts to the right. The first st counted is the st at the right of the ch3. And join Friends Wool yarn on the **22nd** (**24th**) **26th** st.

Tip: Work over the yarn ends, here and at the end of the hat to avoid weaving ends.

From here you'll work back and forth in rows and ch2 instead of 3 to have a neat edge.

Row 1: Ch2, work 1 dc in the next **43 (47) 51** sts. Turn (**44 (48) 52** sts)

Row 2: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in each st until 3 sts left. Work 1 dec and 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn (42 (46) 50 sts)

Row 3: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in the next 6 sts, 1 dec, 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn. (10 sts)

Row 4: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in the next 4 sts, 1 dec, 1dc on top of ch2. Turn. (8 sts)

Row 5: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in the next 2 sts, 1 dec, 1dc on top of ch2. Turn. (6 sts)

Row 6: Ch2, work 2 dec, 1dc on top of ch2. Fasten off. (4 sts) Weave in ends.

Second Earflap

With the right side facing you. Go to the start of Row 2, count 12 to the right and insert crochet in the 12th st.



Repeat Rows 3 to 6. DO NOT fasten off and continue with Border.

Border

Ch1 (does not count as 1st) and turn to work on the right side. Sc all around the hat, work 2 sc in each earflaps' top corners, and 2 sc around each dc and ch2 on the earflaps' sides, and 1 sc in each st. Be sure to don't make too much or not enough sc to avoid ripple or shrink. Weave in ends.

MOUTH

With Friends cotton yarn, color Black and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2)

Make 35 ch and fasten off. Cut the thread leaving a long tail to sew the mouth to the hat.

EYES (make 2)

With Friends Cotton yarn, colors Black and White and hook 2.5 mm (US C/2).

With Black yarn, make a mr

Round 1: ch1 (does not count as a st), 6 sc in mr. Join with sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 2: ch1, inc in the same st, inc in each st around. Make the very last yo of the last st with color White, join with sl st in first st. Cut black yarn. (12 sts)

Round 3: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, *inc, 1 sc in next st*. Repeat from * to * until there is 1st left. Inc in the last st. Join with sl st in first st (18 sts)

Round 4: ch1, inc in the same st, *1 sc in the next 2 sts, inc*. Repeat from * to * until there are 2 sts left. Work 1 sc in the next 2 sts and join with sl st in first st. (24 sts)

Fasten off for the first eye but continue for the second one.

Round 5: ch1, 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in the next 2 sts *inc, 1 sc in the next 3 sts*. Repeat from * to * until there is 1 st left. Inc in the last st. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail to sew and work an invisible join (30 sts)

ASSEMBLY

Place the eyes:

1st eye: With the forehead part front of you, from the start of the right earflap, count 9 sts to the left. Go up counting 7 rows including the border. Place the top of the small eye here and pin it.

2nd eye: With the forehead part front of you, from the start of the left earflap, count 9 sts to the right. Go up counting 8 rows including the border. Place the top of the big eye here and pin it. If you are happy with the placement, sew them in place.



Place the mouth:

With the forehead part front of you, from the start of the right earflap, count 6 sts to the left. Pin the first end of the mouth here. From the start of the left earflap, count 6 sts to the right and pin the second end of the mouth here. Form waves with the mouth, pin to hold the mouth in place and sew it when you are happy with its shape.

Scars:

With 2 strands of Friends cotton yarn color Black and your yarn needle. Sew two scars on the face where you want. I sew a slanted line and then sew 2 or 3 perpendicular lines to the first one.



Of course you are totally free, don't hesitate to place all of this where you want, to create your own funny monster.
