Scarf

## MATERIALS

3 skeins of Diablo Print, color
Peach/Caramel/Pearl (01)
2 skeins of Peacock, color Dark Beige (03)
6 skeins of Friends Cotton 8/8, color Beige (05)

Crochet hook 6 mm

## YARN QUALITY

(a) Diablo Print, Hobbii Diablo Print Lace 40\% Acrylic, 30\% Mohair, 30\% Polyamide, $25 \mathrm{~g}=225 \mathrm{~m}$ (246 yds)
(c5) Peacock, Hobbii
100\% Polyester, $100 \mathrm{~g}=65 \mathrm{~m}$ (71 yds)
(a3) Friends Cotton 8/8, Hobbii
100\% Cotton,
$50 \mathrm{~g}=75 \mathrm{~m}$ (82 yds)

## GAUGE

$27 \mathrm{~cm} \times 27 \mathrm{~cm}$ or $10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}=$ square

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 27 cm / 10.5"
Length: $200 \mathrm{~cm} / 78.75^{\prime \prime}$

Introducing the "Teddy's Hug - Scarf" - a cozy crochet creation designed for warmth and comfort. ## sl st = slip stitch

ch $=$ chain
sc = single crochet
$\mathrm{dc}=$ double crochet
hdc = half double crochet
tc = triple crochet
puff st = puff stitch

## INFO AND TIPS

Before you start mix one thread and Friends Cotton 8/8 and one thread of Diablo Print

## SQUARE PATTERN:

Start with 6 chains, join with slip stitch to the first chain

Round 1 (mix): Ch 3 (counts as a dc), 2 dc into the circle, ch 3, * 3 dc into the circle, ch 3 **, rep from * to ** four times, join with sl st to top of ch 3.6 ch- 3 spaces

Round 2 (mix): SI st in next 2 dc, sl st in next ch-3 space, ch 1, puff st in same space, ch 2, puff st in same space, ch 2, * puff st in next ch-3 space, ch 2, puff st in same space, ch 2 **, rep from * to ** four times, join with sl st to top of the first puff st

Round 3 (mix): Sl st in next ch-2 space, ch 3 (counts as a dc), 2 dc in same space, ch 2, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2 **, rep from * to ** ten times, join with sl st to top of ch 3

Round 4 (mix): SI st in next 2 dc, sl st in next ch-2 space, ch 1, puff st in same space, ch 2, puff st in same space, ch 2 , * puff st in next ch-2 space, ch 2 , puff st in same space, ch 2 **, rep from * to ** ten times, join with sl st to top of the first puff st

Round 5 (mix): SI st in next ch-2 space, ch 3 (counts as a dc), 2 dc in same space, ch 1 , * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1 **, rep from * to ** twenty two times, join with sl st to top of ch 3

Don't cut the yarn, just pull up a long loop to keep your stitches from unraveling

Round 6 (col. 03): Connect Peacock yarn to any ch-1 space be sl st, ch 4, sc in next ch-1 space, ch 3, * sc in next ch-1 space, ch 3 **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to the first ch. Fasten off. 24 ch-3 spaces

Round 7 (mix): Insert your hook in the pulled loop and sl st to the closer ch-3 space, ch 4 (counts as a tc), 2 tc in same space, ch 2, 3 tc in same space, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-3 space, ch 1, 3 hdc in next ch-3 space, ch 1,3 sc in next ch-3 space, ch 1,3 hdc in next ch-3 space, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-3 space, ch 1, * 3 tc in next ch-3 space, ch 2,3 tc in same space, ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-3 space, ch 1, 3 hdc in next ch-3 space, ch 1, 3 sc in next ch-3 space, ch 1, 3 hdc in
next ch-3 space, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-3 space, ch 1 **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 4

Round 8 (mix): Sl st in next two tc, sl st in next ch-2 space, ch 3 (counts as a dc), 2 dc in same space, ch 2, 3 dc in same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) rep six times, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2,3 dc in same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) rep six times **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Make 7 squares in total.

## JOINING

Lay two squares with the wrong sides facing each other. With Peacock yarn sl st through 2 corners, * ch 3, sc through next 2 ch-1 space **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the row, ch 3 , sc in through the second corner. Join all the squares in the same way.


Connect Peacock yarn to any ch-1 space, ch 4, * sc in next ch-space, ch 3 **, repeat from * to ** around, join with sl st to the first ch. Fasten off.
