# **MATERIALS**

1 skein of Silly Socks Disco color 04 – **Yarn** 

1 skein of Silly Socks Disco color 06 – **Yarn** 

1 skein of Silly Socks Disco color 05 – **Yarn C** 

Straight needle 3.75 mm (US 5) Straight needle 2.75 mm (US 2) Stitch holder 2 stitch markers

# **YARN QUALITY**

**Silly Socks Disco**, Hobbii 75% Wool, 25% Polyamide 100 g (3.5 oz) = 400 m (437 yds)

# **GAUGE**

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 26 sts x 35 rows

#### SIZE

Child/S/M

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Height: 11.5/14/16 cm – 4.53/5.51/6.3"

Width: 9/11/12 cm - 3.54/4.33/4.72" with the thumb

# **PATTERN INFORMATION**

Lovely Halloween mitts to finish up a scary costume.

These lovely mitts are knitted flat all the way with two strands of yarn, the web is stitched over the top and the spiders are knitted separately and sewn to the mitts.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

K = knit

P = Purl

St(s) = Stitch(es)

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

M = Marker

PM = Place marker

SM = Slide marker

RM = Remove marker

M1 = Make one stitch using the left needle and pick up the yarn before the next stitch from the front and knit it into the back

Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together

# **LEFT MITT**

C/on 34/38/42 sts on 3.75 mm (US 5) with 2 strands of yarn A

Row 1 - (K2, P2) repeat to the last 2 sts, K2

Row 2 - (P2, K2) repeat to the last 2 sts, P2

Repeat the last 2 rows 3/4/5 times

Next row - K row

Next row - P row

Next row - K13/15/17, PM, K5 PM, K16/18/20

Next row - P row and SM

Next row - K to the M, SM, M1, K up to the M, M1, SM, K to the end of the row

Next row - P row and SM

Next row - Kf&b, K to the last st and SM, Kf&b

Next row - P row and SM

Repeat the last 4 rows 2/3/4 times (46/54/62 sts)



Next row – K to the M, SM, M1, K up to the M, M1, SM, K to the end of the row (48/56/64 sts) Next row – P row and SM

Next row – K to the M, RM, c/on 2 sts, move all the sts between the two M on the St holder (that will be the thumb), RM, c/on 2 sts (tighten together the sts at this point to avoid a gap), K to the end of the row (39/45/51 sts)

Next row - P row

Next row - K row

Repeat the last 2 rows 5/7/8 times

Next row - P row

C/off loosely all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

#### **Thumb**

Rejoin the 13/15/17sts from the st holder for the thumb

Next row - P row

Next row - K row

Repeat the last 2 rows 0/1/2 times

Next row - P row

C/off loosely all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

# **RIGHT MITT**

C/on 34/38/42 sts on 3.75 mm (US 5) with 2 strands of yarn A

Row 1 – (K2, P2) repeat to the last 2 sts, K2

Row 2 - (P2, K2) repeat to the last 2 sts, P2

Repeat the last 2 rows 3/4/5 times

Next row - K row

Next row - P row

Next row - K16/18/20, PM, K5 PM, K13/15/17

Next row - P row and SM

Next row - K to the M, SM, M1, K up to the M, M1, SM, K to the end of the row

Next row - P row and SM

Next row – Kf&b, K to the last st and SM, Kf&b

Next row - P row and SM

Repeat the last 4 rows 2/3/4 times (46/54/62 sts)

Next row – K to the M, SM, M1, K up to the M, M1, SM, K to the end of the row (48/56/64 sts)



Next row - P row and SM

Next row – K to the M, c/on 2 sts, RM, move all the sts between the two M on the St holder (that will be the thumb), RM, c/on 2 sts (tighten together the sts at this point to avoid a gap), K to the end of the row (39/45/51 sts)

Next row - P row

Next row - K row

Repeat the last 2 rows 5/7/8 times

Next row - P row

C/off loosely all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

#### **Thumb**

Rejoin the 13/15/17sts from the st holder for the thumb

Next row - P row

Next row - K row

Repeat the last 2 rows 0/1/2 times

Next row - P row

C/off loosely all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

# SPIDER (MAKE 2)

C/on 3 sts on 2.75 mm (US 2) with one strand of yarn B

# **Body**

Row 1 – Kf&b, K to the last st, Kf&b (5 sts)

Row 2 - Prow

Repeat the last 2 rows once (7 sts)

Row 5 – K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, K2tog (5 sts)

Row 6 - P row

Repeat the last 2 rows once (3 sts)

#### Head

Row 9 - Kf&b, K1, Kf&b (5 sts)

Row 10 – P row

Row 11 - K2tog, K1, K2tog (3 sts)

Thread through all 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure



# **FINISHING UP**

Sew the two sides of the mitts together as well as the thumb side edges. Sew the spiders on each glove where you want them and then add the legs by stitching 8 lines for each spider.

With yarn C create a chain stitch from the spider running out of the mitts as per the picture.

Weave in all ends
