## MATERIALS

4 (4) 5 (5) 6 (6) skeins of Portobello color 68 1 (1) 1 (1) 2 (2) skein(s) of Peacock color 04

Circular needles 4.5mm (US 7) Stitch holders Stitch markers Measuring tape Pair of scissors Yarn needle

# **YARN QUALITY**

Portobello, Hobbii
60 % Cotton, 28 % Acrylic, 12 % Wool
50 g / 1.75 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

Peacock, Hobbii
 100 % Polyester
 100 g/ 3.5 oz = 65 m / 71 yds

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 19 sts x 27 rows

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

K = Knit MM = Millimetres P = Purl RS = Right side St(s). = Stitch(es) WS = Wrong side SIZE

2y (3-4y) 5-6y (7-8y) 9-10y (11-12y)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 32 (34) 36 (38) 40 (44) cm / 13" (13") 14" (15") 16" (17") Length: 37 (39) 41 (45) 47 (53) cm / 15" (15") 16" (18") 19" (21")

#### **PATTERN INFORMATION**

This slipover is worked bottom-up, back and forth with some colour changes. The front piece and the back piece are worked separately. After that, both pieces are sewed together. Then, some stitches are picked up and worked in the round to form the armholes and the neckline.

#### **Colour distribution**

Before starting it is important to select the colours you will be using for this project. Please find below the description of each colour use: *Colour 1* is the main colour. *Colour 2* is used only for the spots.

## 2x2 Rib stitch (back and forth + in the round)

\*Knit 2, purl 2\* and repeat from \* to \* through the round.

#### Edge stitches (working 2x2 Rib stitch)

Odd rows: slip first stitch knitwise and purl last stitch; Even rows: slip first stitch knitwise and purl last stitch.

#### Edge stitches (working stockinette stitch)

Odd rows: slip first stitch knitwise and knit last stitch; Even rows: slip first stitch purlwise and purl last stitch.

#### Knit 2 together or K2tog

Instead of knitting a single stitch, knit 2 stitches together.

## SKP

Slip 1 knitwise, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over.

#### Stockinette stitch (back and forth)

Knit across on the right side and purl across on the wrong side.



# TIPS

## **Colour change**

While knitting the spot with the colour 2, cross your main colour yarn every 2-3 stitches to avoid thread tension issues.

## Knitting up (avoiding holes for the armpit part)

Knit up the double of stitches indicated in the pattern and K2tog those stitches. E.g.: if the pattern says to knit up 5 sts, knit up 10 sts instead, and knit 2 sts together over those 10 sts. After knitting 2 together, you get only 5 sts remaining.

# **FRONT PIECE**

## Bottom

Start by using *colour 1*. Cast on 62 (66) 68 (72) 76 (84) stitches with your 4.5mm (US 7) needles and work 2x2 rib stitch for 8 cm (3")back and forth. AT THE SAME TIME work the edge stitches as per tip on Edge stitches - 2x2 Rib stitch.

Once the piece measures 8 cm (3"), work stockinette stitch back and forth as follows: knit 11 (3) 4 (6) 8 (2) sts, work Graphic A 2 (3) 3 (3) 3 (4) times and knit 11 (3) 4 (6) 8 (2) sts. On the wrong side, purl across and change colour as per Graphic A. AT THE SAME TIME work the edge stitches as per tip on Edge stitches - stockinette stitch.

## Armholes

Once the piece is 11 (11) 12 (13) 13 (14) cm / 4.3" (4.3") 4.7" (5") 5" (5.5") long, bind off 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) stitch 2 (2) 1 (2) 2 (2) times every second row on each side of the piece [Total = 58 (62) 66 (68) 72 (80) sts].

Then, work stockinette stitch back and forth as follows: knit 9 (1) 3 (4) 6 (0) sts, work Graphic A 2 (3) 3 (3) 3 (4) times and knit 9 (1) 3 (4) 6 (0) sts. Continue knitting and doing the Graphic A repetitions until the piece measures 32 (34) 36 (40) 42 (48) cm / 12.5" (13.4") 14" (15.7") 16.5" (18.9"). Ensure to stop knitting on a row 16 or 32 to keep the dot pattern.

## Neck

Once the piece is 32 (34) 36 (40) 42 (48) cm / 12.5" (13.4") 14" (15.7") 16.5" (18.9") long, knit 2 rows. Then, on the next row, place the middle 14 (16) 16 (18) 20 (24) stitches on a cable for the neck and finish each shoulder separately [Total = 22 (23) 25 (25) 26 (28) sts for each shoulder].

## Shoulders

Work the 22 (23) 25 (25) 26 (28) sts of the first shoulder back and forth using stockinette stitch for 5 cm (2"). AT THE SAME TIME, bind off as follows only on the neck side: 2 (2) 2 (2) 2 (2) stitches 2 (1) 2 (1) 2 (2) times, 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (0) stitches 2 (3) 3 (3) 2 (0) times. Once the shoulder is 5 cm (2") long, bind off the 16 (18) 18 (20) 20 (24) sts. Work the second shoulder in the same way.



Once you get the two shoulders done, knit up 10 (12) 12 (14) 14 (14) sts on each side of the neck and place them on the same cable as the 14 (16) 16 (18) 20 (24) stitches put previously on hold [Total = 34 (40) 40 (46) 48 (52) sts].

# **BACK PIECE**

#### Bottom

Using *colour 1*, cast on 62 (66) 68 (72) 76 (84) stitches with your 4.5mm needles and work 2x2 rib stitch for 8 cm (3"), back and forth. AT THE SAME TIME work the edge stitches as per tip on Edge stitches - 2x2 Rib stitch.

Then, work the stockinette stitch back and forth. AT THE SAME TIME work the edge stitches as per tip on Edge stitches - stockinette stitch.

#### Armhole

Once the piece is 11 (11) 12 (13) 13 (14) cm long, bind off 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) stitch 2 (2) 1 (2) 2 (2) times every second row on each side of the piece [Total = 58 (62) 66 (68) 72 (80) sts]. Then, continue to work using stockinette stitch back and forth.

#### Neck

Proceed as per Neck - Front part.

## Shoulders

Proceed as per Shoulders - Front part.

# NECK

Sew the shoulders parts from the front piece together with those of the back piece. Work together the 34 (40) 40 (46) 48 (52) sts left on both cables [Total = 68 (80) 80 (92) 96 (104) sts] using 2x2 rib stitch in the round for 3 cm (1.2").

# ARMHOLES

Sew each side of the bottom part from the front piece together with those of the back piece for the first 11 (11) 12 (13) 13 (14) cm / 4.3'' (4.3'') 4.7'' (5'') 5'' (5.5'').


Knit up 58 (62) 64 (70) 76 (86) sts and work 2x2 rib stitch in the round for 3cm (1.2"). Then cast off the 58 (62) 64 (70) 76 (86) sts. Work the second armhole in the same way.
