# Avalon

## Cardigan

Design: Au Bout du Pré | Hobbii Design




## MATERIALS

A: 4/4/5/5/6 skeins of Diablo color 20  
B: 1 skein of Glitter Deluxe 30g color 18121

Straight needle 5 mm (US 8)  
Stitch holder

## YARN QUALITY

 **Diablo**, Hobbii  
40% Acrylic, 30% Mohair, 30% Polyamide  
25 g (0.9 oz) = 225 m (246 yds)

**Glitter Deluxe 30g**, Hobbii  
100% Polyester  
30 g (1.1 oz) = 1800/2100m (1950/2300 yds)

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 18 sts x 34 rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit  
P = Purl  
St(s) = Stitch(es)  
C/on = Cast on  
C/off = Cast off  
K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together

## SIZE

S/M/L/XL/XXL

## MEASUREMENTS

**Length:** 43/45/47/49/51 cm -  
16.93"/17.72"/18.50"/19.29"/20.08"

**Width:** 45/49/51/53/56 cm -  
17.72"/19.29"/20.08"/20.87"/22.05"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This lovely, light cardigan knitted in garter stitch, will keep you warm and elegant. Quick to make and easy to wear with a nice golden touch.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

The cardigan is knitted flat in garter sts with ribbed hem and cuffs. The front and back are knitted in one piece and the sleeves are separate. The front edge and collar are added at the end. The neckline, hem and cuffs are knitted with yarn A and B held together. Main body and sleeves are knitted with yarn A only.

## BODY

C/on 84/88/92/96/100 sts with yarn A and B together

### Back

Row 1 – (K2, P2) repeat to the end of the row

Knit Row 1 a total of 10 times

Use yarn A only

K until your work measure 40/42/44/46/48 cm – 15.75"/16.54"/17.32"/18.11"/18.90"

### Neck opening

K27/29/29/32/32, place the rest 57/59/63/64/68 sts on a stitch holder

K27/29/29/32/32 sts

### Shape the collar

K27/29/29/32/32 c/on 15/17/17/18/18 (42/46/46/50/50 sts)

### Front right

\*\*K until your cardigan front measure 36/38/40/42/44 cm -

14.17"/14.96"/15.75"/16.54"/17.32" as per the back (count the ridges to make sure as the yarn is quite stretchy)

Use yarn A and B together

Row 1: (K2, P2) repeat to the last 2 sts, K2



Row 2: (P2, K2) repeat to the last 2 sts, P2  
Repeat Row 1 and 2 a total of 4 times

Use yarn A only

C/off loosely all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure \*\*  
(To make sure the c/off is not too tight you could use a bigger needle)

Rejoin the other sts from the stitch holder with yarn A only but leave the 30/30/34/32/36 sts in the middle for the neck on the stitch holder.

### **Front left**

#### Shape the collar

Attach yarn and K27/29/29/32/32 from the shoulder towards the neckline, c/on 15/17/17/18/18 (42/46/46/50/50 sts)  
Repeat from \*\* to \*\* for the front left side.

### **SLEEVE (MAKE 2)**

C/on 68/68/72/76/80 sts with yarn A only

Rows 1 - 10: K all sts  
Row 11: K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, K2tog  
Repeat Rows 1-11 a total of 13/13/13/14/14 times (42/42/46/48/52 sts)

Continue working straight until your sleeve measure 48/50/51/52/53 cm – 18.9"/19.69"/20.08"/20.47"/20.87"

Use yarn A and B together

Row 1: (K2, P2) repeat to the last 2 sts, K2  
Row 2: (P2, K2) repeat to the last 2 sts, P2  
Repeat Row 1 and 2 a total of 4 times

C/off loosely all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

### **EDGE**

The front edges and the collar are worked as follows with yarn A and B together:  
(Make sure to pick up sts at regular interval so your edge will not curl)

#### **Left edge**

Row 1 – Pick up sts all along the front left edge up to the end of the collar  
Rows 2 to 4 – K 3 rows

C/off loosely all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

**Right edge**

Repeat as per the left edge

**Neck and collar**

Row 1 – Pick up sts around the front right collar starting above the picked up right front edge, then K 30/30/34/32/36 sts from the sts holder at the neck, then pick up sts around the other side of the front left collar up to the end of the left front picked up edge.

Rows 2 to 4 – K 3 rows

C/off loosely all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

**FINISHING UP**

Align the middle of the c/on sleeves to the shoulder and sew along.  
Also sew the sleeves and the side seams under the arms.

Weave in all ends
