MATERIALS

1 skein Friends Extra Fine Merino, col. 104
1 skein Friends Extra Fine Merino, col. 109

Circular Needles 6 mm (US 10), 60 cm / 23.6 in
or Single Pointed Needles 6 mm (US 10)

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Extra Fine Merino**, Hobbii

100% Wool

50 g (1.75 oz) = 165 m (180 yds)

GAUGE

22 sts x 20 rows = 10 x 10 cm (4 x 4 inches)
rib stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)

CO = cast on

k = knit

p = purl

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 12 cm / 4.7 inches

Length: 80 cm / 31.5 inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

Monet is a soft and colorful scarf for children. There is plenty of opportunity to play with the color combinations and make a completely unique scarf. The scarf is worked in rib stitch with 2 threads held together. You can easily make the scarf wider by adding stitches or longer by working more rows. Remember to buy extra yarn if the scarf needs to be larger. The pattern is beginner-friendly.

Pattern



SCARF

The first stitch of every row is a selvage stitch, which you will slip without knitting. Slip the stitch by inserting the needle through the back loop of the stitch with yarn in front. For the best result, slightly pull the working yarn when slipping the stitch.

CO 24 sts with two threads held together on needles size 6 mm (US 10).

Row 1: Selvage st. Work *k1, p1* until there is 1 st left on the needle. k1.

Row 2: Selvage st. Work *k1, p1* until there is 1 st left on the needle. k1.

Repeat these 2 rows until the scarf measures 70 cm / 27.6 inches or desired length.
Weave in the ends.
