1 skein color Sunflower 24
1 skein color Orange 30
2 skeins color Purple Rain 70
1 skein color Sapphire 85
1 skein color Black 124

## Glitter Deluxe

1 skein color Cobalt blue 18130

Crochet hook 2 mm
Stuffing

## YARN QUALITY

(10) Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii

100\% Cotton
$50 \mathrm{~g}=160$ meters
Glitter Deluxe 30g, Go Handmade
100\% Cotton
30 g = approx. 1800-2100 meters

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx. 21 cm long

## ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)
$\mathrm{mr}=$ magic ring
$\mathrm{sc}=$ single crochet
ch = chain
dc = double crochet
inc = increase: 2 sts in same st
dec = decrease: 2 sts together
sl st = slip stitch
blo = back loop only
flo = front loop only
rnd(s) = round(s)

## BODY

Start with Purple Rain
ch 13, you will work around the chain - start in 2 nd st from hook

1st rnd: inc, $10 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in same st, 11 sc [26]
2nd rnd: inc $\times 2,10 \mathrm{sc}$, inc $\times 3,10 \mathrm{sc}$, inc [32]
3rd rnd: $(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 2,10 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 3,1 \mathrm{sc}$, inc [38]
4th rnd: 1 sc , inc, 2 sc , inc, 12 sc , (inc, 2 sc ) $\times 2$, inc, 12 sc , inc, 1 sc [44]
5th rnd: $(3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 2,13 \mathrm{sc}$, (inc, 3 sc ) $\times 2$, inc, 13 sc , inc [50]
6th rnd: inc, 7 sc , inc, 16 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 16 sc [54]
7th rnd: $(4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 2,16 \mathrm{sc}$, (inc, 4 sc$) \times 2$, inc, 16 sc , inc [60]
8th rnd: (3 sc, inc) x $2,25 \mathrm{sc}$, inc, 3 sc , inc, 22 sc [64]
9th rnd: (inc, 5 sc ) $\times 2$, inc, 19 sc , (inc, 5 sc ) $\times 2$, inc, 19 [70]
10th rnd: (6 sc, inc) $\times 2$, 20 sc (inc, 6 sc ) $\times 2$, inc, 20 sc , inc [76]
11th rnd: 5 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 30 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 25 sc [80]
12th rnd: 6 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 31 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 25 sc [84]

13rd-34th rnd: 1 sc in each st [84]
35th rnd: ( $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 6 \mathrm{sc}$ ) $\times 6$ [78]
36th rnd: 1 sc in each st [78]
37th rnd: (11 sc, dec) x 6 [72]
38th-39th rnd: 1 sc in each st [72]
40th rnd: (5 sc, dec, 5 sc ) x 6 [66]
41st rnd: 1 sc in each st [66]
42nd rnd: (9 sc, dec) x 6 [60]
43rd-44th rnd: 1 sc in each st [60]
45th rnd: (4 sc, dec, 4 sc ) 6 [54]
46th rnd: 1 sc in each st [54]
47th rnd: (7 sc, dec) x 6 [48]
48th-49th rnd: 1 sc in each st [48]
50th rnd: (3 sc, dec, 3 sc ) $\times 6$ [42]
51st rnd: 1 sc in each st [42]
52nd rnd: (5 sc, dec) x 6 [36]
53rd-54th rnd: 1 sc in each st [36]
Stuff the body
55th rnd: $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 2 \mathrm{sc}) \times 6$ [30]
56th rnd: 1 sc in each st [30]
57th rnd: (3 sc, dec) x 6 [24]
58th rnd: 1 sc in each st [24]
59th rnd: (1 sc, dec, 1 sc ) 6 [18]
Stuff the body more
60th rnd: (1 sc, dec) x 6 [12]
61st rnd: (dec) x 6 [6]
Do not cut the yarn, now the tail starts
62nd rnd: (inc) x 6 [12]
63rd rnd: (1 sc, inc) $\times 6$ [18]
64th rnd: 1 sc in each st [18]
65th rnd: ( 1 sc, inc, 1 sc ) $\times 6$ [24]
66th rnd: $(3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6$ [30]
67th rnd: 1 sc in each st [30]
68th rnd: (2 sc, inc, 2 sc) x 6 [36]

69th rnd: (5 sc, inc) $\times 6$ [42]
70th rnd: 1 sc in each st [42]
71st rnd: (3 sc, inc, 3 sc ) $\times 6$ [48]
72nd rnd: (7 sc, inc) x 6 [54]
73rd rnd: 1 sc in each st [54]
74th rnd: (4 sc, inc, 4 sc ) $\times 5,4 \mathrm{sc}$, inc, 1 sc [57] next rnd starts here
Change to Sapphire and Glitter Deluxe together
75th rnd: (9 sc, inc) $\times 6$ [66]
76th rnd: 1 sc in each st [66]
77th rnd: (5 sc, inc, 5 sc ) x 6 [72]
78th rnd: ( $11 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}$ ) $\times 6$ [78]
Crochet the tail together with 38 sc , which makes the edge of the tail, ch 1 and turn
5 dc in 2 nd st from hook, skip 1 st, 1 sc in next st, skip $1 \mathrm{st}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, repeat through row, fasten off with sl st in last st, weave end

## FINS, MAKE TWO

Start with Purple Rain
1st rnd: Start with 6 sc in a mr [6] move the tail to the front, as it will be used for joining 2nd rnd: (inc) x 6 [12]

3rd rnd: (1 sc, inc) $\times 6$ [18]
4th rnd: 1 sc in each st [18]
5th rnd: (1 sc, inc, 1 sc ) $\times 6$ [24]
6th-7th rnd: 1 sc in each st [24]
8th rnd: (3 sc, inc) x 6 [30]
9th-10th rnd: 1 sc in each st [30]
11th rnd: (2 sc, inc, 2 sc) 6 [36]
12th-18th rnd: 1 sc in each st [36]
Change to Sapphire and Glitter Deluxe together
19th-22nd rnd: 1 sc in each st [36]
Crochet each fin closed with 17 sc, which makes the edge of each fin, ch 1 and turn
5 dc in 2 nd st from hook, skip $1 \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, skip $1 \mathrm{st}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, repeat through row, fasten off with sl st in last st, weave end

## LANTERN

Start with Sunflower
1st rnd: Start with 6 sc in a mr [6]
2nd rnd: (inc) x 6 [12]
3rd rnd: 1 sc in each st [12]
4th rnd: (1 sc, inc) 6 times [18]
5th-8th rnd: 1 sc in each st [18]
9th rnd: (1 sc, dec) x 6 [12]
Change to Purple Rain
10th rnd: 1 sc in each st in blo [12] stuff as you go, though not too tightly, as the lantern needs to be able to hang

11th-59th rnd: 1 sc in each st [12] fasten off with sl st in next st, leave yarn for joining

Join the yarn (Purple Rain) in a st in flo from 9th rnd
1st rnd: (inc) $\times 6$ [12]
2nd-3rd rnd: 1 sc in each st [12] fasten off with sl st in next st, weave end

## TEETH

Made with White
ch 6 , start in 2 nd ch from hook, every row is turned with 1 ch
1st row: 5 sc [5]
2nd row: dec, 3 sc [4]
3rd row: dec, 2 sc [3]
4th row: dec, 1 sc [2]
5th row: dec [1] fasten off and weave, now make an additional 5 teeth

Join the yarn (White) in first st of the chain-row and make 5 sc , now continue to next tooth with 5 sc , continue until all 6 teeth are joined with a total of 30 sc , fasten off and leave yarn for joining.

## EYES, MAKE TWO

Start with Black
1st rnd: Start with 6 sc in a mr [6]

2nd rnd: (inc) $\times 6$ [12] finish the rnd with sl st in blo of next st and change to Orange at the same time

3rd rnd: start in same st as sl st of last rnd (ch 1, inc (made with sl st)) $\times 6$ in blo [18]
Change to White
4th rnd: ( 1 sc , inc, 1 sc ) $\times 6$ in blo [24]
5th rnd: 1 sc in each st in blo [24]
6th rnd: 1 sc in each st [24] fasten off with sl st in next st, you can stitch a dot in the eye with the tail if you want, weave end

Now the outer part of the eye is made with Purple Rain.
ch 25 and gather in a ring with a sc, this st counts as first st of next rnd
1st rnd: $(4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 5=30$ sts
2nd-6th rnd: 1 sc in each st, fasten off with sl st in next st and leave a long tail for joining and to sewing the two pieces together. Fold the outer part of the eye and place the inner part inside, sew the two pieces together.

## JOINING

Join the teeth to the bottom of the body, so there are 3 teeth on each side of the chain-row of the body

Join the eyes on each side of the fish between rnds 15 and 24
Join the fins to each side of the body between rnds 30 and 34
Join the lantern to the top of the body between rnds 24 and 28
