### **MATERIALS**

**Kind Feather** 

1 skein of each colour: 01, 07, 22

Crochet hook 5 mm (US H/8)
Tape Measure
Scissors
Darning Needle
Stitch Markers
Pom Pom maker size 65 mm for toddler & child and size 85 mm for adults

# YARN QUALITY

(3) **Kind Feather,** Hobbii 100% Premium Acrylic 100g (3.5 oz) = 235m (257 yds)

### **GAUGE**

10 cm x 4 cm (4" x 1.5") = 14 sts x 6 rows See info under INFO AND TIPS

#### SIZE

toddler (child, small, medium, large)

# **MEASUREMENTS**

**Height: 19**(20.5, 21.5, 23, 25.5)cm /

7.5(8, 8.5, 9, 10)"

**Circumference:** (48(52, 56, 58, 61)cm /

(19(20.5, 22, 22.75, 24)"

# PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern features short rows to give the perfect fit and reduce the bulk you normally find at the crown of beanies.

The beanie is designed to have a folded brim to give extra warmth for your ears.

Finish off the beanie with a multicoloured pompom to make it extra festive.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

bo = bobble

PM = place marker

Mst = Marked stitch

\*...\* = repeat between

{...} = end stitch count

# **INFO AND TIPS**


# **Gauge swatch**

Ch 19 + 1 for turning,

Row 1: Sc in each st across, ch 1, turn

**Row 2:** \*sc 1, bo 1\* 9 times, sc in last st, ch 1, turn Repeat rows 1 & 2 until you have 5 bobble rows.

You should have 7 bobbles across to 10cm and 3 bobble rows to 4cm.



- follow size according to your size toddler(child, small, medium, large)
- place markers when suggested
- do not fasten off each colour once worked, carry the yarn up on the wrong side of the work and secure it in place by working over the yarn on the next stitch with the new colour, as seen in the picture below





# **Special Stitches**

**Bo -** \*yarn over, insert hook into stitch, yarn over and pull through stitch, yarn over and pull through 2 loops on the hook\* repeat twice, yarn over, pull through two loops, yarn over, pull through remaining two loops.

**Bo2** - \*yarn over, insert hook into stitch, yarn over and pull through stitch, yarn over and pull through 2 loops on the hook\* repeat 3 times, \*yarn over, pull through two loops\* repeat twice, yarn over, pull through remaining two loops.

# **BEANIE**

Using White, ch 36(40, 44, 47, 50), includes turning ch,

**Row 1 [RS]:** working in the back bumps of the chs, sc 27(29, 31, 33, 37), sc-blo 8(10, 12, 13, 13),

{**35**(**39**, **43**, **46**, **50**) sts}

**Row 2 [WS]:** ch 1, turn, sc-blo 8(10, 12, 13, 13), \*sc 1, bo 1\* 13(14, 15, 16, 18) times, sc 1, PM in last st.

**{35(39, 43, 46, 50) sts}** 

**Row 3 [RS]:** ch 1, turn, make sure the marker is on the RS **(R3.1)**, sk MSt, sc **26**(28, 30, 32, 36) (PM in first st **(R3.2)**), sc-blo **8**(10, 12, 13, 13), **{34**(38, 42, 45, 49) sts}





**Row 4 [WS]:** ch 1, turn, sc-blo 8(10, 12, 13, 13) and change to colour red on last st **(R4.1)**, \*sc 1, bo 1\* 12(13, 14, 15, 17) times, sc 1, PM in last st, {33(37, 41, 44, 48) sts}



**Row 5 [RS]:** ch 1, turn, make sure the marker is on the RS **(R3.1)**, sk MSt, sc **24**(26, 28, 30, 34) (PM in first st) and change colour to white on last st, sc-blo **8**(10, 12, 13, 13), **{32**(36, 40, 43, 47) sts}



**Row 6 [WS]:** ch 1, turn, sc-blo 8(10, 12, 13, 13) and change to colour green on last st, \*sc 1, bo 1\* 11(12, 13, 14, 16) times, sc 1, PM in last st, {31(35, 39, 42, 46) sts}

**Row 7 [RS]:** ch 1, turn, make sure the marker is on the RS **(R3.1)**, sk MSt, sc **22**(24, 26, 28, 32) (PM in first st) and change colour to white on last st, sc-blo **8**(10, 12, 13, 13), **{30**(34, 38, 41, 45) sts}

**Row 8 [WS]:** ch 1, turn, sc-blo 8(10, 12, 13, 13), \*sc 1, bo 1\* 10(11, 12, 13, 15) times, sc 1, \*bo2 in 1st Mst, sc 1 in next MSt\* 3 times , PM in last st, **{35(39, 43, 46, 50) sts}** 

Repeat rows 3 - 8 a total of 9(10, 11, 12, 13), times, omitting row 8 on the last repeat. You should have 9(10, 11, 12, 13) bobble rows of each colour.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for seaming the sides together.

# **SEAMING THE BEANIE**

Working on the RS - using the mattress stitch, seam the first and last row of the beanie together working through the marked sts too. Weave in the tail.

### **CLOSING THE CROWN**

Working on the RS - using white, attach yarn at the crown close to the seam,

**Round 1:** ch 1, evenly place 18(20, 22, 24, 26) sc around the crown, slst to join, **Round 2:** ch 1, dec around, slst to join. Fasten off and use the tail end to weave in and out the sts to cinch the hole closed.

### **POMPOM**

Using a pompom maker and using all three colours held together, make the pompom. Once made, trim the pompom to shape to make it perfectly round and attach to the crown of the beanie using the tails from securing the pompom.
