



KNITTING PATTERN

MATERIALS

3 skeins of Friends Wool color 110 – Yarn A 1 skein of Friends Wool color 40 – Yarn B

Straight needle 6 mm (US 10) Crochet hook 3.5 mm (US E-4) Stitch holder

YARN QUALITY

Friends Wool, Hobbii 100% Wool 50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 18 sts x 35 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knitP = Purl

St(s) = Stitch(es)

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

Dec c/off = (Decrease cast off) K2tog from the back of the loop then slip the stitch back to the left needle, repeat to the end of the row

Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 26 cm / 10.24" Width: 33 cm / 12.99"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This lovely vest is a great way for your small child to dress up for Christmas.

The adorable vest is a very easy and quick knit all in one piece. The edging is added at the end, the ties and the pockets are made separately.

At the end you crochet the edges.

Pattern







VEST

The vest is knitted in one piece starting at the bottom of the back. C/on 60 sts with yarn A and 6 mm (US 10) needle

The back:

Row 1 – K row

Repeat the first row until your vest measure 26 cm / 10.24"

Neck opening:

Next row - K20, Dec c/off 20, K20

Work only on the last 20 sts and leave the other 20 sts on a stitch holder

Shape the collar:

Next row - K to the last st, Kf&b (21 sts)

Next row - Kf&b, K to the end of the row (22 sts)

Repeat the last two rows 4 times (30 sts)

Front right:

Next row - K row

Repeat the last row until your vest front measure 26 cm / 10.24" as per the back from the start of the collar shaping

Dec c/off all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure Rejoin the other 20 sts from the stitch holder

Shape the collar:

Next row – Kf&b, K to the end of the row (21 sts)

Next row – K to the last st, Kf&b (22 sts)

Repeat the last two rows 4 times (30 sts)



Front left:

Next row - K row

Repeat the last row until your vest front measure 26 cm / 10.24" as per the back from the start of the collar shaping (make sure it also match your other front side)

Dec c/off all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

POCKET (MAKE 2)

C/on 3 sts with yarn A and 6 mm (US 10) needle

Row 1 – Kf&b, K to the st, Kf&b (5 sts) Repeat the first row 7 times (19 sts)

Row 9 – K row Repeat the last row 19 times

Change to yarn B Row 29 – K row Repeat the last row 2 times

Row 32 – (K4, c/off1) x 3, K4 (16 sts)

You are now going to work on 4 sets of 4 sts: Row 33 – K4, TURN, (K2tog) x 2, TURN, K2tog C/off the last st, cut the yarn and make secure

Repeat row 33 for the other 3 sets of 4 sts as above

EDGE

With yarn A and 3.5 mm (US E-4) crochet hook

Start at the bottom of the right front edge, pick up 2 sts, (c/off 1, pick up 1 st) repeat until you have gone around the neck and down the left front edge on the other side.

Make sure to pick up sts at a regular interval so your edge will not curl.

TIE (MAKE 2)

C/on 3 sts with yarn B and 6 mm (US 10) needle

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 - Move all the sts back on the left needle and K the row

Repeat those 2 rows until your lcord measure 22 cm / 8.66".



You are now going to work the end flat as follow:

Next row – $(Kf&b) \times 3 (6 sts)$

Next row - P row

Next row – Kf&b, K4, Kf&b (8 sts)

Next row - P row

Next row - K row

Next row - P row

Next row - K row

Next row – P row

Next row - K2tog, K4, K2tog (6 sts)

Next row - P row

Next row - K2tog, K2, K2tog (4 sts)

Thread through all 4 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

FINISHING UP

Sew the side seams under the arms for 14 cm / 5.51" from the bottom and leave a gap for the arm holes.

Thread through the flat end part of the ties to curl them into a ball and finish by fixing them in place. Attach the other sides of the ties to the inside of the collar.

Turn the top edge (yarn B) of the pockets down and sew them in place all along the edge. Finish by sewing the pockets to the vest and make sure they are symmetrical, around 6 sts in and about 6 rows up from the edges.

Weave in all ends
